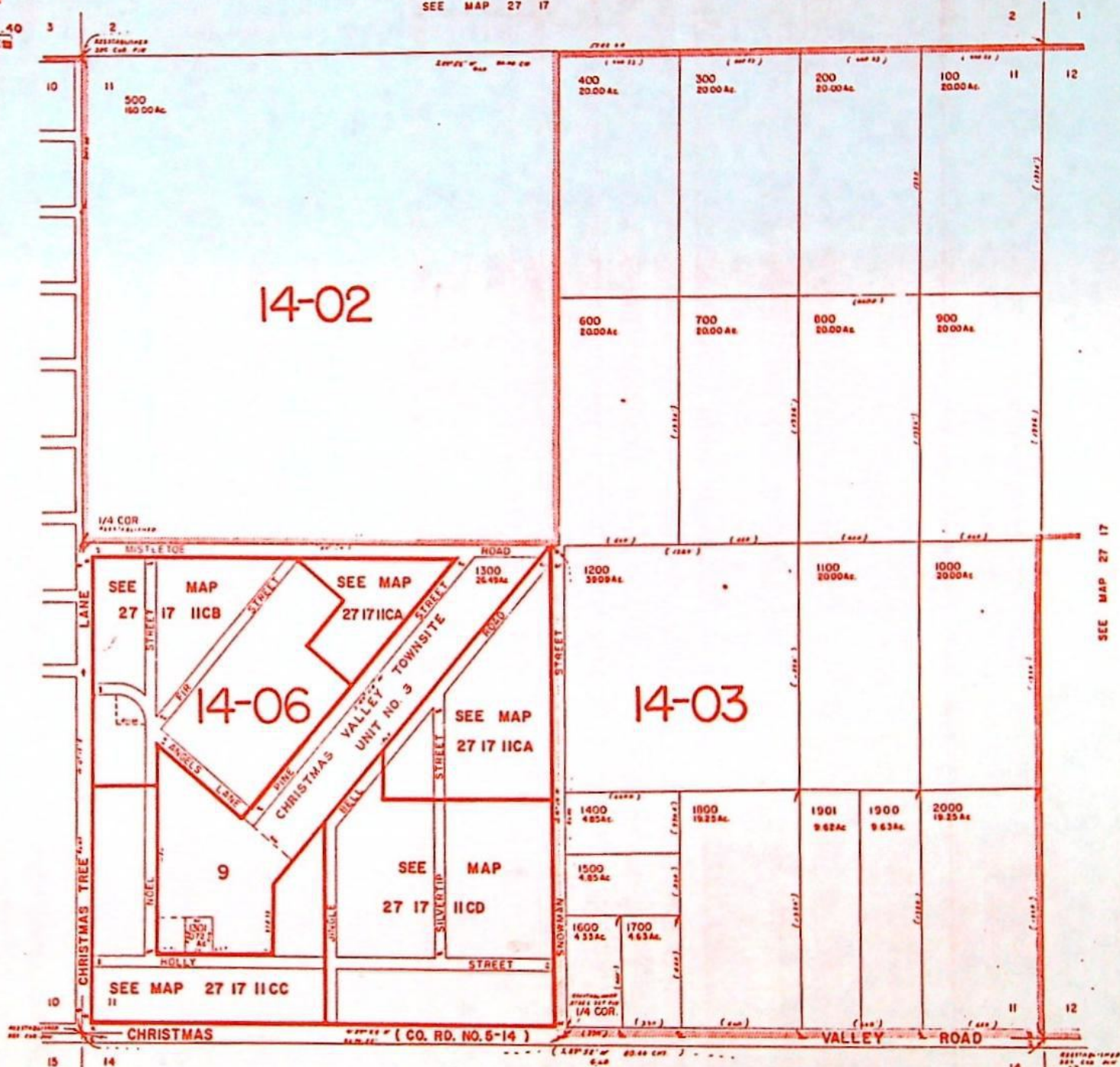

The start of the drilling operation or other means of constructing the well will be considered as beginning of construction. If no canal system or other permanent type of distribution works is employed, the acquisition and installation of all the machinery or equipment necessary for the project will be considered as completion of construction.

When complete application of water has been made, Form C should be submitted as the first step in proof of appropriation. When proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director has been made, the right will be confirmed by issuance of a certificate. The certificate will limit the right to the extent that water has been applied to beneficial use in accordance with the terms of the permit.

The permit requires that an access port or other installation be provided to allow the measurement of the water level within the well at any time. Sketches of suggested methods of installation are attached.

Your application for a permit to appropriate 0.25 cubic foot per second of water from a well for irrigation of 40.0 acres has been filed and for reference numbered G-11496. The map and fees of \$200 were also received. Our Receipt 48886 is enclosed.

The project described in the application is located within the main ground water reservoir in the Fort Rock Basin. By proclamation of the Water Resources Director entered March 26, 1984, no more applications for permits to appropriate water from the main ground water reservoir in the Fort Rock Basin will be approved or denied prior to the completion of the proceedings for the determination of the critical ground water area. It may be another year or so before any final determination of a critical ground water area occurs.

If, in fact, the ground water levels are declining or the available ground water supply in question is being or is about to be overdrawn, the Water Resources Director will be required to protect the ground water resources from over-appropriation. This would be accomplished by prohibiting the drilling of wells in the affected ground water reservoir, denying the approval of pending applications, and if necessary, controlling or shutting off the use from existing wells based on priority date until a stable ground water level is established.

Permit recording fees in the amount of \$160 will be needed, but we will not need these fees until such time that it is determined that we will be able to issue a permit.

We will also need the legal description of the property upon which the water will be used. This legal description is needed to verify the place of use and may be copied from the deed, title insurance policy or sales contract.

Further action on your application will be withheld pending the final determination of the matter regarding aforementioned proceedings.

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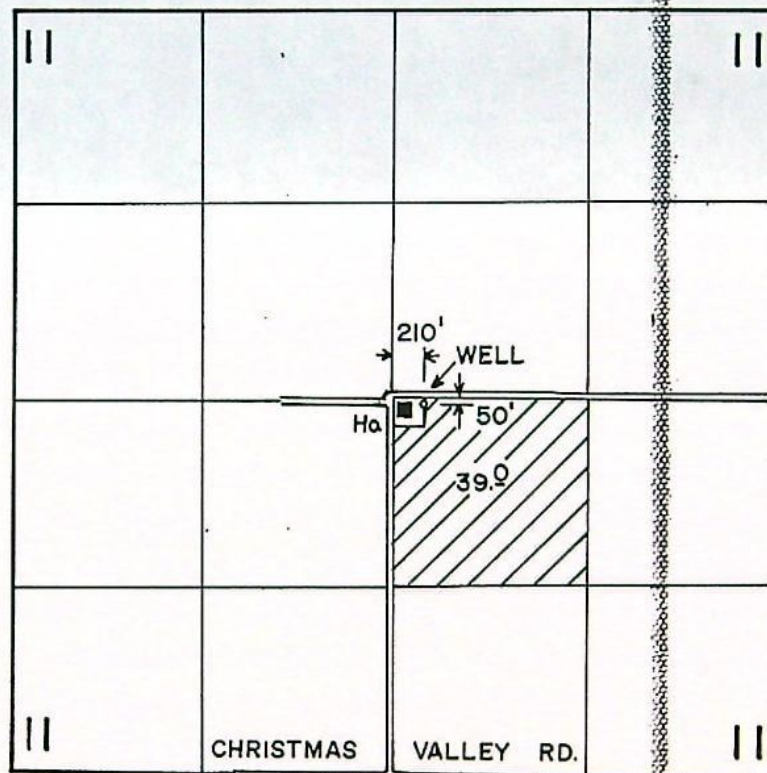
