





We have done some work on the storage area every year except one since completion of the reservoir. The local branch of the Fish and Game Department has participated in the work every year and their records will verify that the work has been done.

Although the reservoir has been leaking, we have been using the water for about 30 days on approximately 200 acres each year. We are showing some improvement in storage.

This year we have dug numerous test holes above and below the dam site. We dug a keyway 300'long, 22'deep to a rock or clay base. We then filled this with a clay mix and packed it in layers with a sheepsfoot. The cost of this work was \$6800.00. The work was done under the supervision of Mr. Beale, the County Watermaster.

The extent of the benefit will not be known until Spring 1983.






Under his recent permit covering use of water from Willow Creek and Willow Creek Reservoir, they were examined this date accompanied by Jess Ereno, Al Petska of my office, Al Leonard from the USGS and Merle Clark, watermaster, and Jim Hanley, private engineer for Mr. Ereno. The possibility of placing a grout curtain in the order of 40 feet deep under his diversion dam for the prupose of bringing any water which might be flowing beneath the surface in the stream to the surface was discussed. .

Mr. Leonard advised that while some water would undoubtedly be brought to the surface, he doubted it would be any significant amount or anywhere near the quantity necessary for the irrigation of 300 acres. He thought that while the grout curtain might be established, it would probably force most of the water into the rock structure surrounding the area of the stream channel, rather than bringing it to the surface and that in all probability water movin g downstream from the higher elevation was passing through either in the fault zone or a relatively broad area significantly larger than could be reached with a grout cutoff wall. In his opinion the basic rock structure would be quite permeable and support ground water movement; and that the probability of obtaining water through a deep well up to 400 feet would be appreciably more likely. He suggested that it be placed somewhere in the head of the valley in the order of half way between the ranch house and the diversion dam.

We subsequently examined the damsite and Mr. Leonard confirmed Mr. Petska's and my previous opinion that a grout curtain might shut off portions of water leaking through the immediate left abutment. It is doubtful if this would cut off anywhere near all of the leakage. My comment was that it would be probably less than 40% of the leakage involved and the primary loss of water would be from the reservoir basin prior to reaching the dam., and should it be cut off there would still be a difficult problem delivering it down through the channel to the proposed area of use.




