Please excuse the oversight.

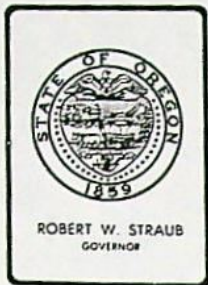

MINIMUM POOL AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 18 day of SEPTEMBER, 1968 by and between Ereno's Men's Store Inc., an Oregon Corporation and Charles Ereno ~~and~~, a single man _____ husband and wife, and J. M. Ereno and Loretta Ereno husband and wife, herein-after referred to as FIRST PARTY and the STATE OF OREGON acting by and through its GAME COMMISSION hereinafter referred to as SECOND PARTY;

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS the First Party is planning to construct an irrigation reservoir on Willow Creek in Harney County, Oregon within the following described premises:

Township 23 South, Range 29 East, Willamette Meridian

Section 11, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$;
Section 13, W $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; and
Section 14, N $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

WHEREAS the First Party has applied to the State Engineer under Application No. R-43085, Permit No. R-5084 and Application No. 43921, Permit No. 32934 for an irrigation storage right and use of 1953.0 acre feet, more or less, respectively located for storage within the above described premises and for use within Section 1, Township 24 South, Range 29 East, Willamette Meridian.

WHEREAS the First Party has applied to the Bureau of Land Management of the United States Department of the Interior for a right of way for reservoir purposes under Application OR 2396 on the above described premises.

WHEREAS the First Party due to emergency created by the extremely dry season of 1968 has drilled a well on the said premises to provide water for dam construction and said well has a flow of thirty (30) gallons per minute more or less and is bored to a depth of 295 feet, more or less, and has a pump and delivery pipe installed, and has incurred costs totalling an estimated \$7,500 more or less for said well, pump, pipe and distribution costs, etc.

WHEREAS the Second Party desires to obtain a perpetual minimum pool of 250 acre feet in said irrigation reservoir above the irrigation outlet for the purposes of fishery management, public angling and public recreation and

WHEREAS the Second Party is willing to pay the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) to the First Party for said perpetual minimum pool of 250 acre feet and an additional sum to offset the cost of said well, casing, pump and delivery pipe but not in excess of \$2,400 providing its requirements for funding, fishery management, public angling and public recreation are satisfied and

WHEREAS the First Party is willing to grant said perpetual minimum pool of 250 acre feet to the Second Party for the respective sums of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) for said 250 acre foot minimum pool together with appropriate rights thereto and Twenty Four Hundred Dollars (\$2,400) to offset the cost of the well plus installation of the casing, pump and of the delivery pipe from pump to ground surface.

NOW THEREFORE, the premises being in general stated, the parties hereto agree on the following:

1. The First Party will provide the engineering plans for said irrigation reservoir prepared by competent engineering personnel and submit the plans to the Second Party for approval.

2. The plans of the First Party do not provide for a raised outlet facility at the level of the 250 acre foot minimum pool but do provide for concrete markers to be installed to mark said level. The irrigation outlet shall be closed by the First Party when the said top level of the 250 acre-foot is reached and if necessary said outlet shall be locked in a closed position, under control conditions acceptable to the Second Party. The First Party will cooperate with the Second Party in every way possible to assure that the 250 acre feet of water in the minimum pool will not be drained from said pool except as required by the State Engineer. Any refilling of said sump area that becomes necessary will be done before any water is stored for irrigation purposes.

3. The First Party agrees to cancel 250 acre feet from its Application No. R-43085 Permit No. R-5084 and Application No. 43921, Permit No. 32934 to the State Engineer such that the Second Party may apply to the State Engineer for a minimum pool of 250 acre feet above the irrigation outlet for said reservoir for fishery and recreational purposes. The First Party agrees that filling, refilling and replacement of losses from all causes including seepage and evaporation for said 250 acre foot minimum pool will be done before the irrigation rights of the First Party commence.

4. The First Party guarantees to the Second Party that its right of way from the Bureau of Land Management of the Department of the Interior on herein described premises shall not conflict with free public ingress, egress, and regress in perpetuity, to herein described reservoir and round the perimeter of said reservoir, at all water levels wherever said reservoir is located.

5. Necessary maintenance of the dam and facilities for the sum of One Hundred and no/hundredths Dollars (\$100.00) or less per year will be the responsibility of the First Party. For necessary maintenance in excess of One Hundred and no/hundredths Dollars (\$100.00) per year the cost will be equally divided between the First and Second Parties providing that the First Party and Second Party mutually agree in advance of the actual performance of the maintenance otherwise, the Second Party will not be obligated to participate in said maintenance.

6. The Second Party agrees to pay the total of Twenty Two Thousand Four Hundred and no/hundredths Dollars (\$22,400.00) to the First Party in consideration of the terms of this agreement according to the following schedule:

a. Prorated partial payments will be made by the Second Party as work progresses at the end of each calendar month or as soon as practical, on estimates made by the contractor of the First Party and approved by the Chief Engineer of the Second Party. In preparing estimates, the materials delivered on the site and preparatory work done may be taken into consideration.

b. Immediately following within thirty (30) days after completion by First Party and acceptance by the Chief Engineer of the Second Party and upon presentation of properly executed and duly certified voucher thereof, then the balance due the First Party will be paid by the Second Party.

7. It is hereby mutually agreed that the First Party and the Second Party will cooperate in every way possible to cause the State Marine Board to establish a boat speed regulation on herein described reservoir to provide that no boat shall exceed the speed of ten (10) miles per hour.

8. The First Party and Second Party agree that angling shall have priority over other recreational uses on herein described reservoir.

9. If it becomes necessary due to natural causes to riprap the dam on herein described premises the cost shall be shared equally by the First and Second Parties, otherwise the First Party is not responsible for said riprap.

10. Any reference to "First Party" herein shall also apply to the heirs and assigns of said First Party and any reference to "Second Party" herein shall also apply to the successors and assigns of said Second Party.

11. The Second Party will assume control over access to the reservoir and related facilities.

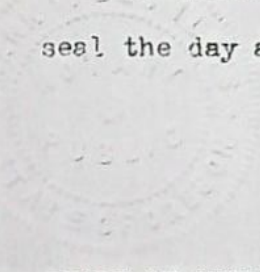

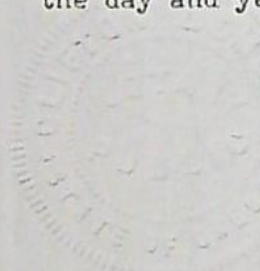
