RE: Fish Screen and By-Pass Device Condition for Permit R-15649

To whom it may concern,

The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) is submitting this letter regarding the fish screen and by-pass device condition contained in permit **R-15649** in the name of <u>Flizabeth Harrison</u>. The permit allows the water user to submit evidence in writing that ODFW has determined fish screens and/or by-pass devices are not necessary.

After inspection of the diversion location on the <u>unnamed stream</u>, <u>tributary to Floras Creek</u>, ODFW has determined that the point of diversion is situated above current and historical distribution of native migratory fish species and, therefore, fish screens and/or by-pass devices are not necessary for <u>R-15649</u>.

Although ODFW has determined that fish screens and/or by-pass devices are not necessary, the permittee shall not stock fish in the reservoir without first obtaining a Fish Transport Permit issued by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW). As part of the Fish Transport Permit process, the permittee may be required to screen the inlet and outlet of the reservoir to ensure that fish cannot escape into public waters and/or to keep wild fish from entering the reservoir.
