Your Application 68878 describing the proposed use of 0.01 cubic foot of water per second from a spring for domestic supplies for one family including up to one-half acre non-commercial lawn and garden; together with the description of spring sheet, deed copy, and a drawing; has been reviewed.

We will need some clarification on your application and a map meeting our requirements before the application can be considered for approval.

The point of diversion as located 270 feet North and 350 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 1 as presently noted in the first part of Item 2 would place the point within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of the section instead of the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 presently noted. Whichever is in error will need to be corrected.

If the water is to be used on the property described in the warranty deed submitted, it appears that the improper quarter-quarter section is designated in Item 3. The copy of the deed submitted describes the property as being the East 20 feet of the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 1 instead of the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 1 presently noted in Item 3.

The map submitted does not appear to be drawn to the scale of one inch equals 400 feet as noted. The map to support your application will need to be prepared to a standard even scale and properly show the location of the spring and house site to be supplied water with respect to the section lines and quarter-quarter lines in the vicinity. Pages 4 and 5 of the enclosed booklet relative to surface water applications briefly explains the requirements and types of maps that may be submitted. Unless you have had experience in preparing maps, it would be advisable to secure technical assistance in drawing the required map and making the necessary entries on the application.

I am returning your application and map for correction and completion. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its priority date it must be received in this office on or before December 15, 1986.

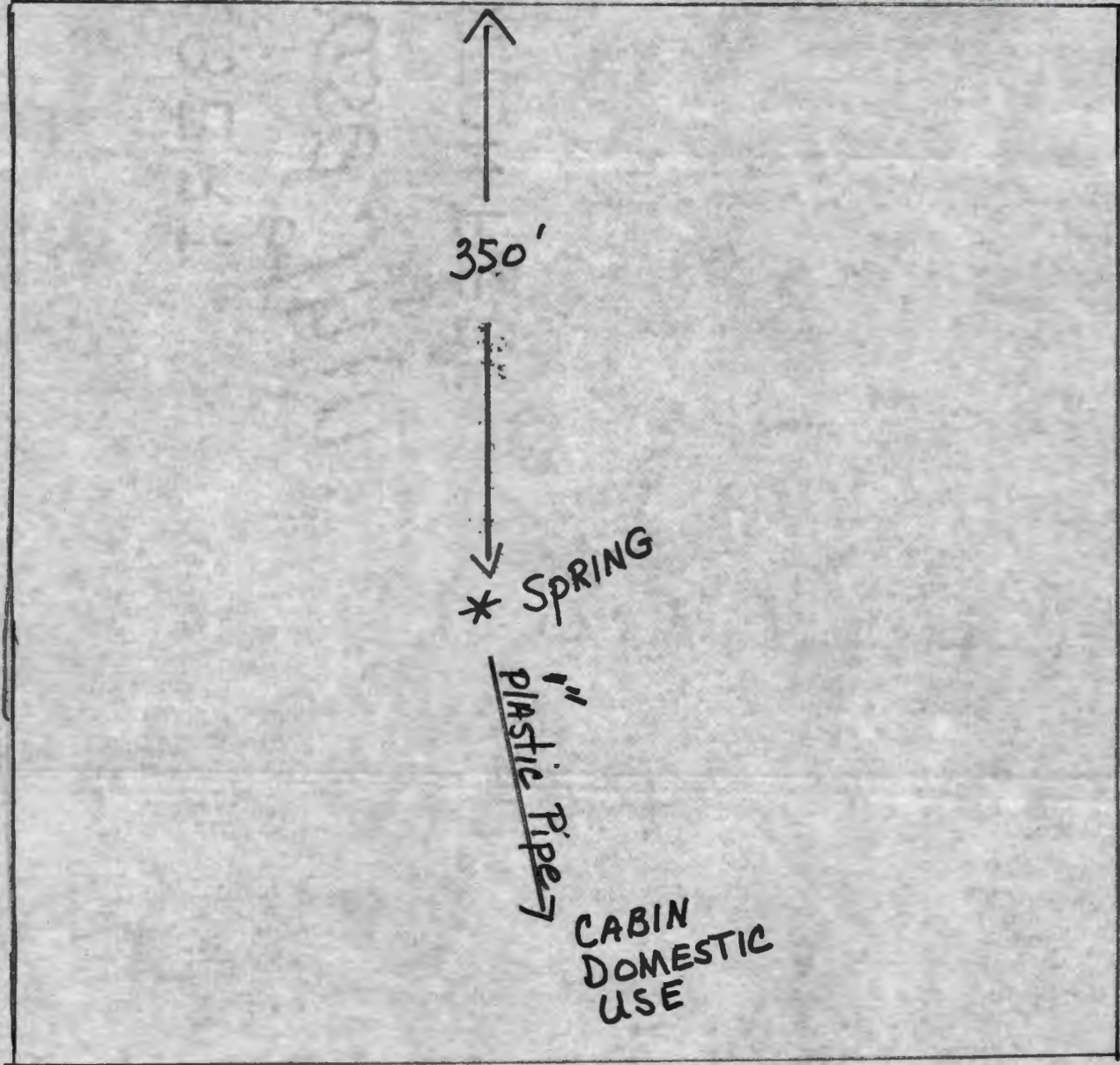

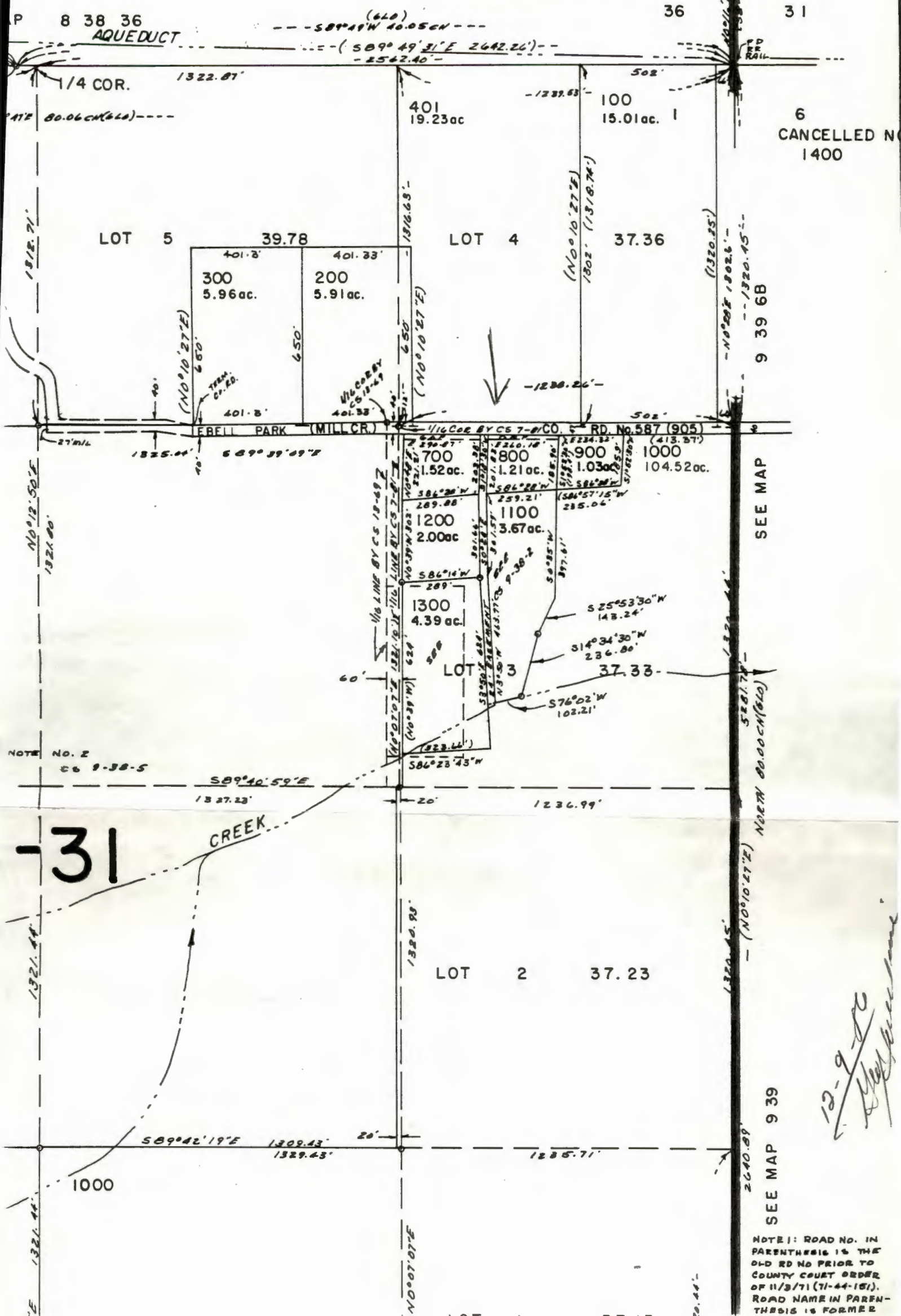

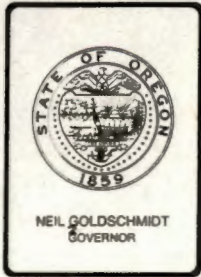
