

Acknowledged is your notice of completion of econstruction in connection with water fight permit numbered G-4954. This permit describes the appropriation of 0.29 cubic foot per second of water from three wells for group domestic use of 61 families.

The time limit provided by the permit to complete construction of all the facilities necessary for making use of the water from the wells for group domestic for 6l families is October 1, 1973. According to the notice you have submitted, you have stated that construction work was completed on the second day of November, 1973, which is after the time limit of the permit.

In order to consider construction work complete in connection with a group domestic system, would require not only that each well be developed but also requires the installation of the pumps, all of the pipeline within the distribution system, and even the internal plumbing of each household. Under the provisions of the permit the time limit for completion of constuction of all the facilities to accomplish the authorized beneficial use of water will expire on October 1, 1973. In the case of group domestic purposes construction is considered to be not only the well but the entire distribution system including the internal plumbing within a household. 


