



This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of January 3, relative to Permit No. 13140 in the name of Hugh H. White, et al.

In compliance with your request for information relative to the completion of the project covered by this permit, this will advise you that this right will remain in good standing as long as the terms of the permit are met. If the project is not completed and all of the land to be irrigated is not irrigated within the time limits as set forth in the permit, the State Engineer, as provided by law, may extend the time for completion upon a showing of due diligence by the permittees.

The only advantage in several appropriators filing one application is the saving in filing fees. One of the disadvantages connected with the filing of one application by several appropriators is that the appropriators cannot make proof separately and receive individual certificates of water right.

We agree with Mr. Pearce's statement as quoted by you, to the effect that proof may be made under a collective filing even though one permittee, through neglect, does not complete his part of the appropriation, but proof cannot be made until either the appropriation is entirely completed or until an application to the State Engineer for an extension of time is rejected because of lack of diligence.

When final proof is made under any permit, any use described in the permit and not covered by the proof is automatically aliminated from the water right and no party to a collective filing should lose his part of the right because he does not complete his part of the appropriation as soon as the other parties to the filing complete theirs, provided he has exercised the diligence required by law in connection with his contemplated appropriation.

According to the terms of your Application No. 17329, Permit No. 13140, which is for the appropriation of o.60 second-feet of water from Fast Fork Illinois River for irrigation, complete application of water was to have been made on or before October 1,1941. It appears from our records that you have failed to submit the notice of complete application, although a postcard, calling this matter to your attention, was mailed to you on October 14, 1941.

Section 116-435, O. C. L. A., provides: "whenever the time within which any appropriation under a permit should have been perfected shall have expired and the owner of such permit shall fail or refuse within the period of three months thereafter to submit to the State Engineer proof of the completion of such appropriation as required by Section 116-426, O. C. L. A., the State Engineer may, after 60 days' notice by registered mail, order the cancellation of such permit, * * *."

If you have complied with the terms of this permit, you should promptly submit the notice of complete application of water, after which we will take up with you the matter of final proof. If, however, you have abandoned your plan of development, we would appreciate your authority to cancel the permit, so that the permit may be cancelled without the necessity for following the legal procedure. 


