Your Application G-18969 describing the proposed use of 3.23 cubic feet per second of water from 1 tile line with 4 branch lines for the supplemental irrigation of 258.7 acres, together with the map prepared on tracing paper, has been reviewed.

We will need additional information on the statement: "the buried tile line proposed under Permit G-8236 was not constructed" noted in the remarks section of your application. If there were no tile lines constructed under your earlier Permit G-8236, the permit should be canceled. However, if water was developed under the earlier Permit G-8236, the extent of such development should be explained.

Further action on your Application G-10969 will be withheld for a reasonable length of time pending receipt of your reply regarding the development of water under your earlier permit.
