



Acknowledged are your notices of beginning and completion of construction and of complete application of water in connection with permit No. G-6089.

I assume that these wells were drilled for an expansion of the present water system. Since any expansion to new houses would require construction of new distribution lines, the notice of completion of construction should not be submitted at this time nor should the notice of complete application of water.
