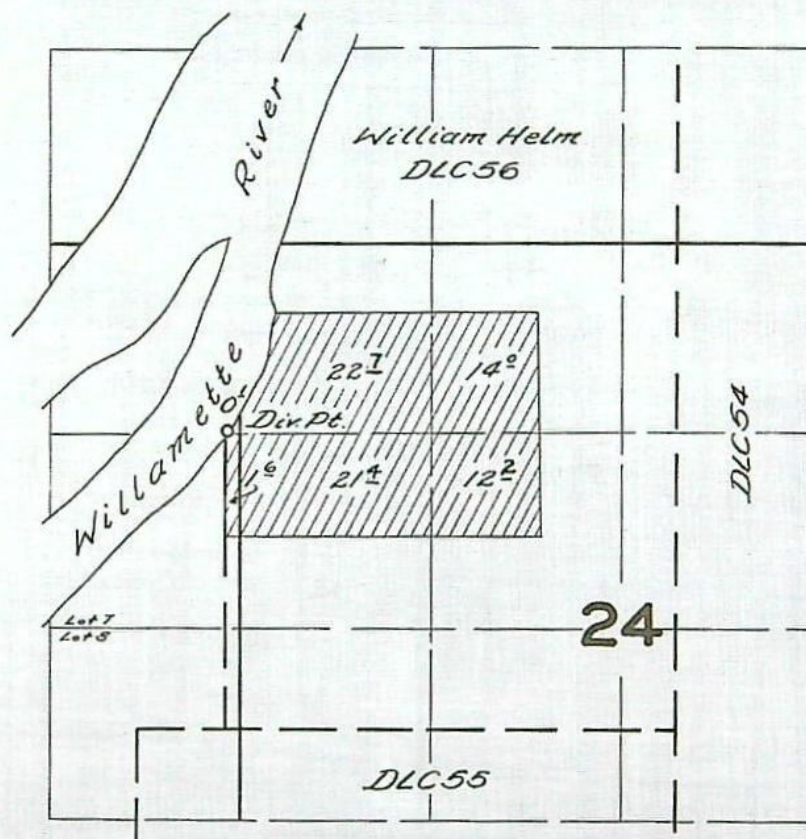

## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That NELLIE WIEDERKEHR

of Route 1, Box 107, Jefferson, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 72.0 acres,

under Permit No. 24450 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon, that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 3, 1956,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.90 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within W. Helm DLC #56, Section 23, Township 9 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Dear Mr. Wiederkehr:

This will acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to appropriate 0.9 cubic feet of water per second from the Willamette River to be used for the irrigation of 72 acres, the accompanying map, legal description, and fees in the amount of \$21.30, for which our receipt No. 8041 was handed to you when you were in this office.

Your application has been examined, given file No. 31000, and the following observations are noted.

Map: With reference to other surveys on file in this office it would appear that the 40 acre tracts are  $\frac{1}{4}$  of a mile off in their location as labeled.

Application-Item 4: Since the 40 acre tracts are mislabeled on the map it would appear that the point of diversion would be located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 23.


Item 8: It would appear that the 40 acre tracts within which the area to be irrigated are listed are in error.

Items 8-A & B: These items should also be completed.

For your convenience in the completion of the above mentioned discrepancies we are returning herewith your application and map, the application being endorsed so that in order to retain its date of priority it must be returned to this office on or before November 20, 1956.
