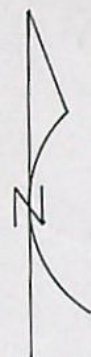

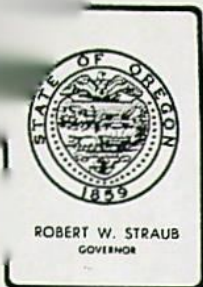

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the George Settlemeier D.L.C. which is the N.E. corner of the William M.
