

Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same *SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD* and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring T.R.B. 3/11/78

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family, and stock; being 0.005 c.f.s. for each use.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 17, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 19, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981

Info: Mr. Waite. System is in and used as applied. He says he also waters the flowers around the house when it is real dry. He says he also uses the water to wash out the ^{milking barn} barn and milking equip. He milks twice a day.

Source: A spring. Water seeps out of rocks and down into a 1200 gal. cyl. metal holding tank. Tank has an overflow pipe (1½" iron) at the top. Tank has a 4" drain at bottom of tank (is capped). A 2" black plastic line comes out of tank (at bottom) and goes under tracks through a culvert, under road, to house and barn, troughs. Line is buried across property.

Use: Domestic, one family, stock watering (6 troughs), cleaning of milking barn and milking equip, and watering of flowers on occasion.

Lift: Pressure was meas. @ 64 psi

Troughs- He has 6 troughs 330 gal each, all automatically kept full. He has a 6'x6'x4' deep cement tank that he pumps water out of to clean milking barn (pump - GE 1HP @ 3450 RPM)

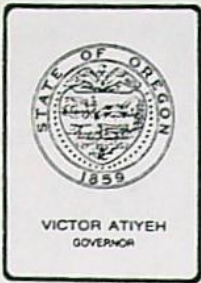

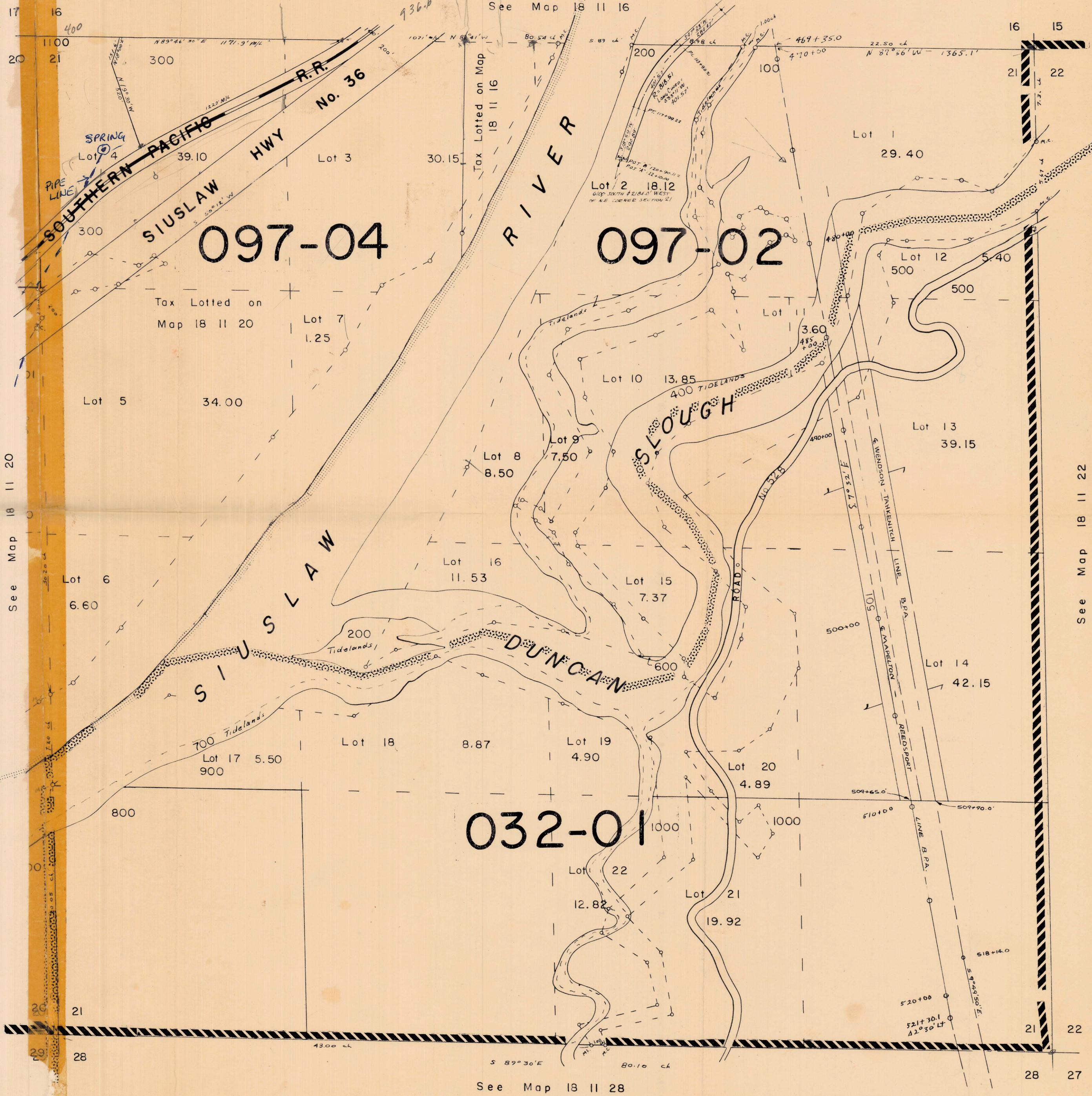

We have received your application for a permit to appropriate 0.01 cubic foot of water per second from a spring for domestic and livestock watering, a legal description, and the map. Application has been filed and assigned No. 56111.

The \$35.00 you previously submitted will be applied to this application. An additional recording fee of \$15.00 is required.

You neglected to return the spring description sheet that you had previously submitted.

Your map shows the farmstead as being located within two different 40 acre tracts. You should show the location of the house being serviced for domestic purposes and identify the areas where the stock water is delivered. If this is within two different 40 acre tracts, item No. 3 of your application should show this. If more than one house is being served for domestic purposes, this should be shown on the map and listed in the space provided at the bottom of item No. 6 of your application.
