
ORDER WITHDRAWING TRANSFER APPLICATION 8056

Pursuant to ORS 540.523, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 8177 submitted by

The first right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 2676. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 250. The date of priority is 1878.

The right allows the use of BUTTER CREEK, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 1.9 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized points of diversion: McCARTY AND THOMSON DITCHES, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season, January 1 to September 1, of each year.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.



2. The former places of use shall not be irrigated as part of these water rights during the 1999, 2000, 2001, 2002, and 2003 irrigation seasons.
3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2003 irrigation season.
4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
5. The use of the remaining water rights described by Certificates 2676, 67877, 2675, 74795, 68349, 38847, 38876, 67878, and Permit 46499 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 2676, 67877, 2675, 74795, 68349, 38847, 38876, 67878, and Permit 46499.

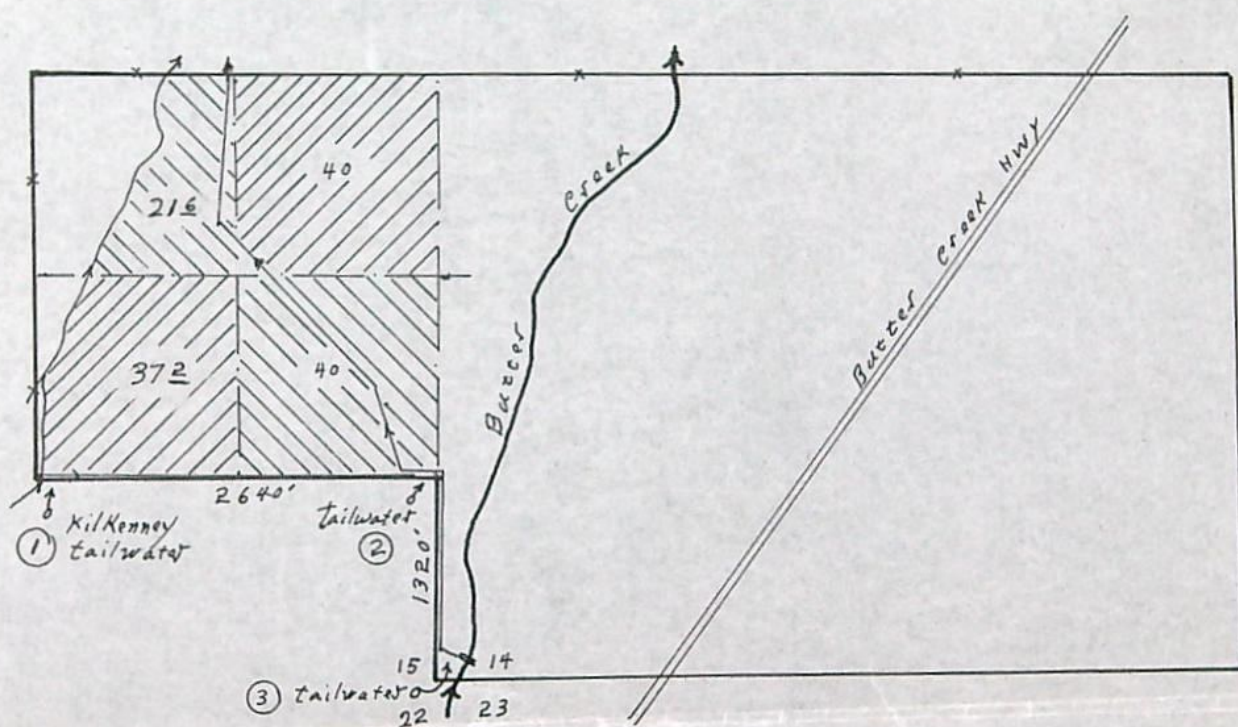

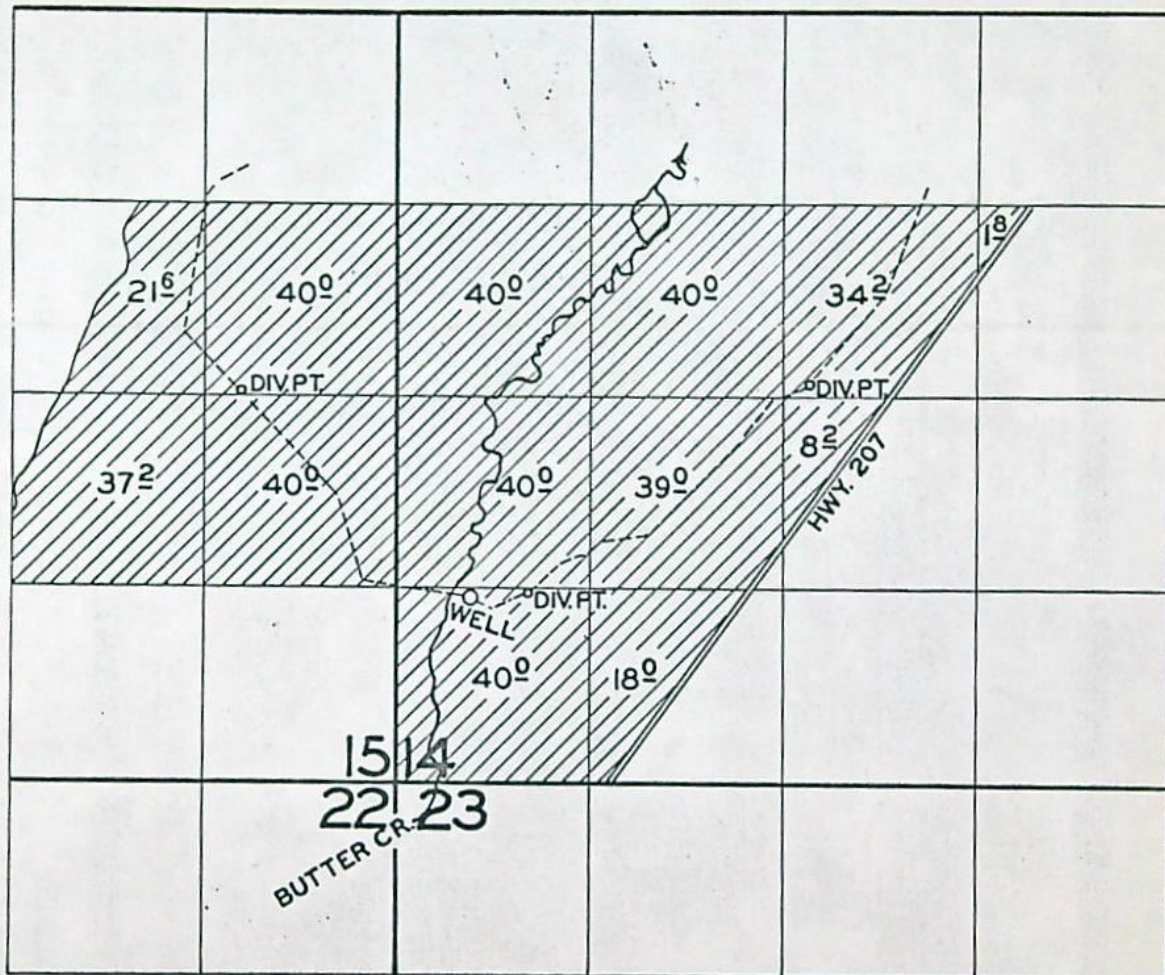



This will acknowledge receipt of your application for permit to appropriate 20.0 cubic feet of water per second from Mike Kilkenney's tail-water for the irrigation of 140.0 acres, a map, and the fee of \$32.50 for which our receipt No. 13619 is enclosed. Your application has been filed and numbered 45873.

If the source of water is the excess water from irrigation above your land and this water is gathered by you for use on the land described, it would be more accurately described in item No. 1 on the application as being waste water.

Is the ditch used to gather this water wholly within your property lines? If it is not, we will require documentary evidence of your right to the use of the ditch for the purpose requested.

Item No. 4 on the application and the map indicate this water is diverted at three specific points. If the water flows into the ditch in well defined natural drainage ways, these should be shown on the map.

Your application designates 23.2 acres of irrigation in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 36.8 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15. 

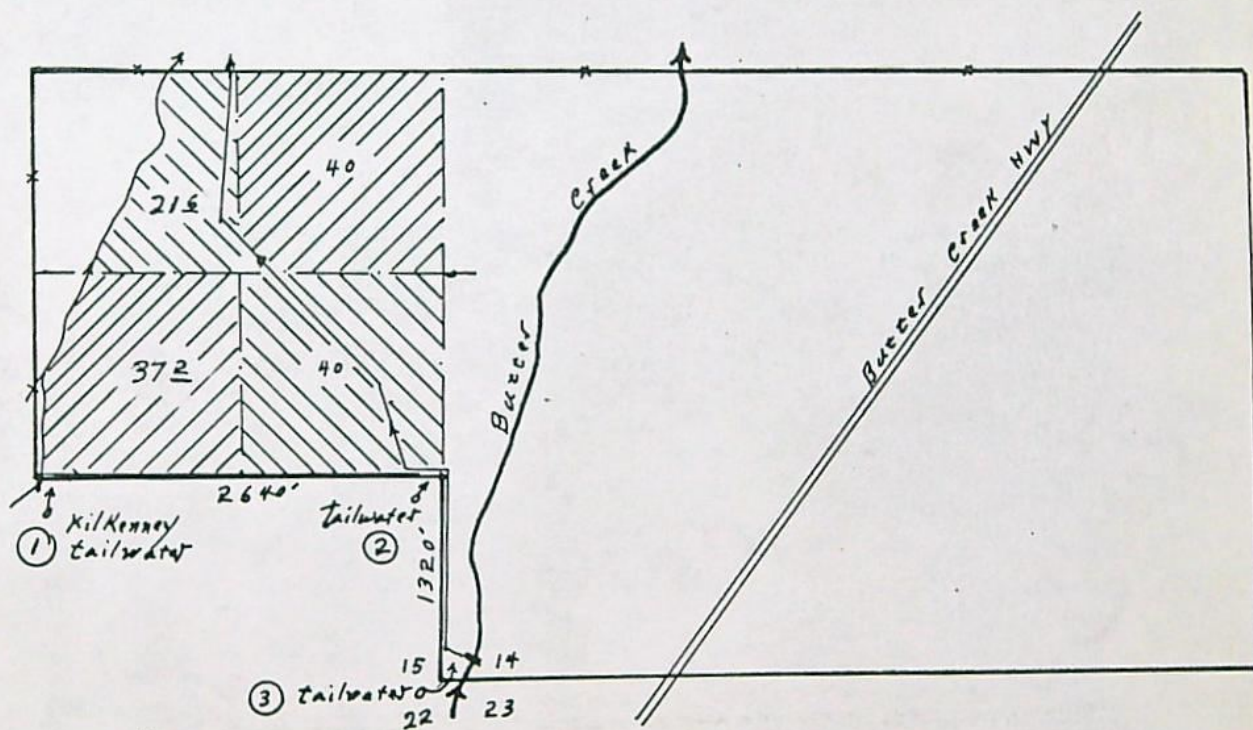

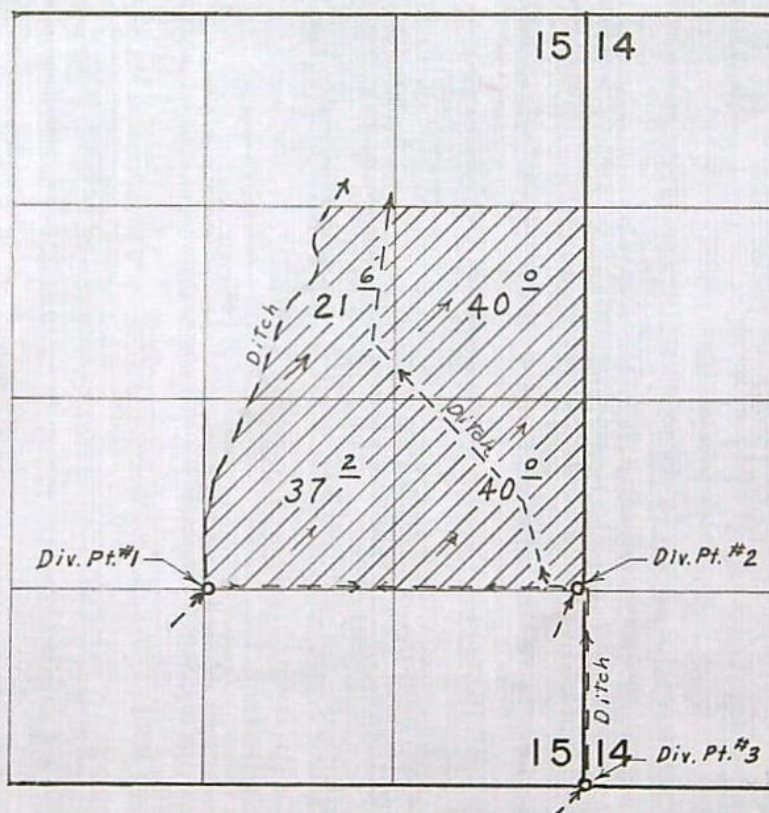
