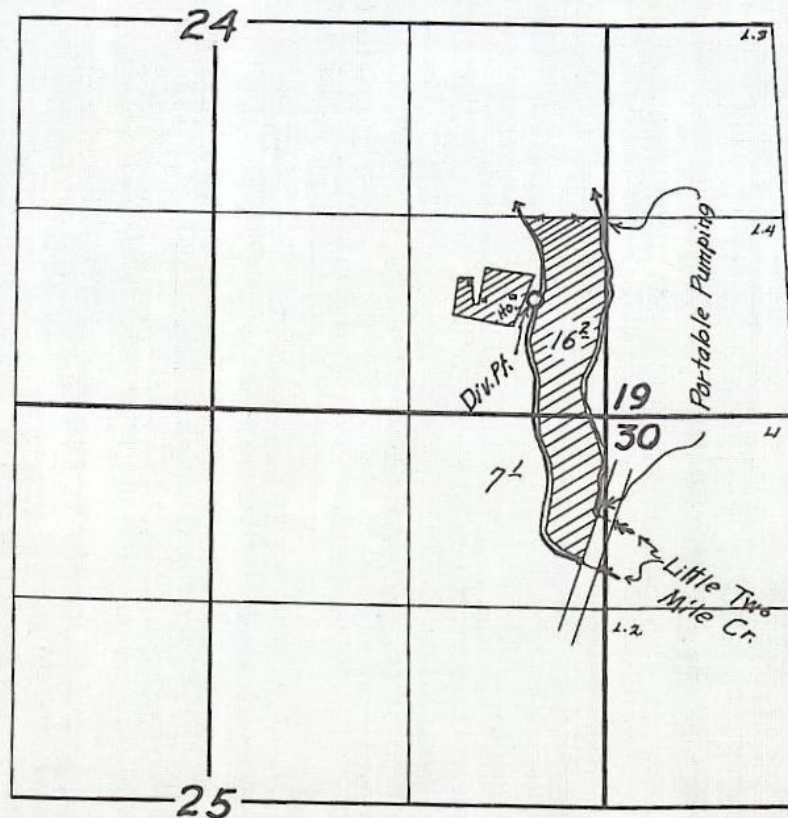

Dear Mr. Holme:

We are enclosing herewith for completion, final proof in connection with the incomplete water right represented by your Permit No. 16074 granting a right to the use of 0.29 cfs of the waters of Little Two Mile Creek for irrigation purposes.

The data contained in the proof, which is based on an inspection and survey of your project made by a representative of this department, defines the extent to which your water right has been completed within the terms of your Permit. 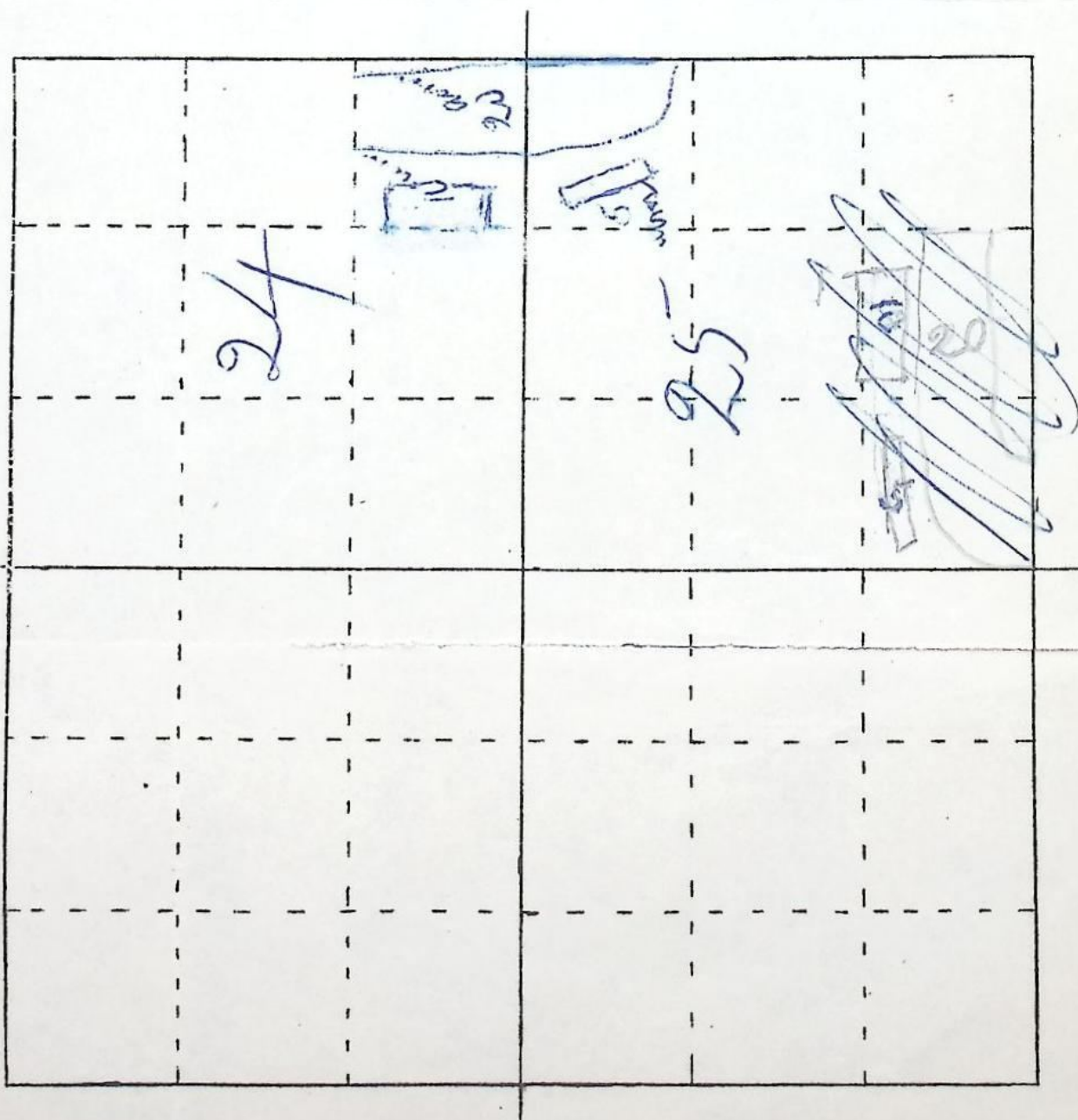
