22. Temporary Transfer Application T-14571 proposes to temporarily transfer water rights within the boundaries of Willow Creek District Improvement District. The district was notified of the proposed temporary transfer and consents to the proposed temporary water right Transfer application.

Temporary Transfer Review Criteria

- 23. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 24. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights are present.
- 25. The proposed changes would prevent the lands from which the water rights are removed during the period of the temporary transfer from receiving water under the transferred rights, as required by ORS 540.523(7).
- 26. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under ORS 540.523(5) if the Department later finds that the transfer is causing injury to any existing water right.

Conclusions of Law

The temporary changes in place of use under Certificates 94969, 96377, 94970, and Permits S-54980 and S-55268, and the change in places of use and points of diversion to serve the proposed places of use under Certificates 82489, 30021, and 94967 proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-14571 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.523 and OAR 690-380-8000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The temporary changes in place of use under Certificates 94969, 96377, 94970, and Permits S-54980 and S-55268, and the change in places of use and points of diversion to serve the proposed places of use under Certificates 82489, 30021, and 94967 proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-14571 are approved.
- 2. The former places of use **shall not** be irrigated as part of these water rights during the 2025 irrigation seasons.
- 3. The use shall revert to the authorized places of use at the end of the 2025 irrigation season. The authorization to use the proposed temporary points of diversion shall be terminated concurrently.
- 4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the changes cause injury to any existing water right.
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the proposed temporary points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.

- 6. A subsequent application for permanent transfer of Certificates 82489, 30021, 94969, 94967, 96377, and 94970 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
- 7. A subsequent application for permit amendments of Permits S-54980 and S-55268 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
- 8. The use of water at the temporary places of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 82489, 30021, 94969, 94967, 96377, 94970, and Permits S-54980 and S-55268.
- 9. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 10. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 11. The use of the remaining water rights described by Certificates 82489, 30021, 94969, 94967, 96377, 94970, and Permits S-54980 and S-55268 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 82489, 30021, 94969, 94967, 96377, 94970, and Permits S-54980 and S-55268.

Findings of Fact

- On November 27, 2023, FRANK TIEGS, LLC, filed an application to temporarily change the
 places of use under Certificates 94969, 96377, 94970, and Permits S-54980 and S-55268,
 and to change the places of use and points of diversion to serve the proposed places of use
 under Certificates 30021, 82489, and 94967, for a period of 1 year. The Department
 assigned the application number T-14363.
- Notice of the application for transfer was published on December 19, 2023, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000.
- On December 7, 2023, the Department contacted the agent for the applicant by phone regarding a deficiency in the application, specifically the applicant did not sign the application.
- 4. On December 15, 2023, the agent sent an amended application page with the applicant's signature, satisfying the deficiency.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- On February 1, and 5, 2024, the Department contacted the agent for the applicant regarding deficiencies in table 2 for Certificates 94967, 94969, and 96377 and Permits S-54980 and S-55268, specifically the "from" and "to" acres in Table 2 of Transfer Application T-14363 were incorrect.
- On February 5, 2024, the agent for the applicant submitted amended application pages and maps, satisfying the deficiencies.
- 7. The watermaster requires that the applicant secure the headgate located at the Willow Creek point of diversion, described in Finding of Fact 10 and completely block the flood ditch serving the north acres being transferred off. The from lands under Certificates 30021 and 82489, previously approved under Temporary District Transfer T-14215, continued receiving water during the 2023 season. Uncontrollable and un-metered flood ditch irrigation from Willow Creek was allowed to irrigate the off lands, resulting in enlargement of the rights. The headgate needs to be secured upstream from the reservoir and must be capable of regulating flow, as well as the flood ditch serving the off lands, must be completely blocked during the term of Temporary Transfer Application T-14363.
- 8. On March 21,2024, the Department contacted the agent for the applicant regarding deficiencies in the application, specifically the "from" maps for Certificate 82989, and Permits S-54980 and S-55268, do not include the portion of the water rights not proposed for transfer, the "from" lands described in table 2 for Permit S-55268 requests 0.6 more acres than are available in the NW NW of Section 35, T1S, R25E, WM, and the "to" lands for Permit S-54980 incorrectly describes the acres in the SE SE of Section 35, T1S, R25E, WM as 26.6 acres.

- 29. Temporary Transfer Application T-14363 proposes to temporarily transfer water rights within the boundaries of Willow Creek District Improvement Company. The district was notified of the proposed temporary transfer and did not provide any comments.
- 30. Temporary Transfer Application T-14363 proposes to temporarily transfer water rights served by a Bureau of Reclamation storage project. The Bureau was notified of the proposed temporary transfer and did not provide any comments.

Temporary Transfer Review Criteria

- 31. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 32. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights are present.
- 33. The proposed changes, as conditioned, would prevent the lands from which the water right is removed during the period of the temporary transfer from receiving water under the transferred rights, as required by ORS 540.523(7). The from lands under Certificates 30021 and 82489, previously approved under Temporary District Transfer T-14215, continued receiving water during the 2023 season. Uncontrollable and un-metered flood ditch irrigation from Willow Creek was allowed to irrigate the off lands, resulting in enlargement of the rights. The headgate needs to be secured upstream from the reservoir and must be capable of regulating flow, as well as the flood ditch serving the off lands, must be completely blocked during the term of Temporary Transfer Application T-14363.
- 34. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under ORS 540.523(5) if the Department later finds that the transfer is causing injury to any existing water right.

Conclusions of Law

The temporary changes in places of use and points of diversion to convey water to the temporary place of use proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-14363 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.523 and OAR 690-380-8000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- The temporary changes in places of use under Certificates 94969, 94970, 96377, and Permits S-54980 and S-55268 proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-14363 are approved.
- The temporary changes in places of use and change in points of diversion to convey water to the temporary place of use under Certificates 30021, 82489, and 94967, proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-14363 are approved.

- 3. The former places of use shall not be irrigated as part of these water right during the 2024 irrigation season.
- 4. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2024 irrigation season. The authorization to use the proposed temporary points of diversion shall be terminated concurrently.
- 5. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the changes cause injury to any existing water right.
- 6. The quantity of water diverted at the proposed temporary points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.
- 7. A subsequent application for permanent transfer of Certificates 30021, 82489, 94967, 94969, 94970, 96377, shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
- 8. A subsequent application for a permit amendment of Permits S-54980 and S-55268, shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of ORS 537.211. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a Permit Amendment.
- 9. The use of water at the temporary place of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 30021, 82489, 94967, 94969, 94970, 96377 and Permits S-54980 and S-55268.
- 10. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 11. The watermaster requires that the applicant secure the headgate located at the Willow Creek point of diversion, described in Finding of Fact 10 and completely block the flood ditch serving the north acres being transferred off. The from lands under Certificates 30021 and 82489, previously approved under Temporary District Transfer T-14215, continued receiving water during the 2023 season. Uncontrollable and un-metered flood ditch irrigation from Willow Creek was allowed to irrigate the off lands, resulting in enlargement of the rights. The headgate needs to be secured upstream from the reservoir and must be capable of regulating flow, as well as the flood ditch serving the off lands, must be completely blocked during the term of Temporary Transfer Application T-14363.

12. Water use measurement conditions:

- a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion.
- b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.

- c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 13. The use of the remaining water rights described by Certificates 30021, 82489, 94967, 94969, 94970, 96377 and Permits S-54980 and S-55268 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 30021, 82489, 94967, 94969, 94970, 96377 and Permits S-54980 and S-55268.

7. Certificate 96666 was issued to confirm an additional point of diversion as proposed in Transfer T-11699. Certificate 96666 superseded the entirety of Certificate 114. Certificate 114 was issued from a decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Morrow County dated December 4, 1910, which confirmed a total of 44.26 acres in the Findings and Determination for Water Division No. 2, Gilliam, and Morrow Counties, dated April 13, 1910. - 16. The Department finds that the district permanent transfer application was submitted according to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4000, contains the information required under OARs 690-385-4200 and OAR 690-385-2000, and includes maps meeting the requirements of OARs 690-385-4300 and 690-385-2200.
- 17. The Department finds that the proposed district permanent transfer meets all the criteria set forth in ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4000.
- 18. The water right is subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
- 19. The proposed change in places of use, as conditioned will not result in enlargement of the right as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(4).
- 20. The proposed change in place of use will not result in injury to other water rights as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(6).
- 21. Any other applicable requirements for district permanent water right transfers are met as required in OAR 690-385-4500.

Conclusion of Law

The proposed changes in place of use as proposed in Transfer Application T-14242 comply with and satisfy the requirements of ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4500.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The proposed changes in place of use, as conditioned, to the water right evidenced by Certificates 96666, 96673, 38861, 42435, and Permits S-54980 and S-55268 are approved.
- 2. The places of use from which the water rights are transferred off by Transfer T-14242 shall no longer be irrigated; Certificates 96666, 96673, 38861, and 42435, are cancelled.
- 3. Permits S-54980 and S-55268 are modified as described in Findings of Facts #11 & 12 and 13 & 14.
- 4. Water Use Measurement Conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 5. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before October 1, 2025. A Claim of Beneficial Use shall be submitted by WCDIC to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 6. After proof of completion, new certificates confirming the rights transferred from Certificates 96666, 96673, 38861, and 42435 will be issued. Any water right certificate issued to confirm changes to Certificates 96666 and 96673 under Transfer T-14242 are to remain in the name of the name of Willow Creek District Improvement Company.

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 537.147 establishes the process by which an application to use stored water exclusively may be submitted. Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapter 690, Divisions 310 and 340 implement the statute, and provide the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating applications to use stored water exclusively.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On March 8, 2018, Willow Creek District Improvement Company submitted an application for a water-use permit pursuant to ORS 537.147:

- 2. The required examination fees were paid and minimum application requirements were met.
- 3. The Department has determined that the proposed use is an authorized use under the water right permit, certificate, or decree that allows the storage of water.
- 4. The Department provided public notice of the application in the Department's weekly public notice on March 27, 2018. A 30-day comment period followed.

1. Water Use Measurement, Recording, and Reporting Condition:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a totalizing flow meter at each point of re-diversion. The permittee shall maintain the device in good working order.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the device; provided however, where any device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The permittee shall keep a complete record of the volume of water diverted each month, and shall submit a report which includes water-use measurements to the Department annually, or more frequently as may be required by the Director. 1. Water Use Measurement, Recording, and Reporting Condition:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a totalizing flow meter at each point of re-diversion. The permittee shall maintain the device in good working order.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the device; provided however, where any device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The permittee shall keep a complete record of the volume of water diverted each month, and shall submit a report which includes water-use measurements to the Department annually, or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water-use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.
- D. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative measuring and reporting procedures for review and approval.
- 2. The water user shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening and fish passage devices consistent with current Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) standards. Fish screening is to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion, while passage devices provide adequate upstream and downstream passage for fish. The required screen and passage devices are to be in place and functional, and approved in writing by ODFW prior to diversion of water. The water user may submit evidence in writing that ODFW has determined screens and/or passage devices are not necessary.
- 3. The use of water under this right is subject to the terms and conditions of contract No. 129E101776, or a satisfactory replacement, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the permittee, a copy of which must be on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.
- 4. Use of water under this permit shall be subject to applicable provisions of the articles of incorporation, bylaws, rules and regulations of the Willow Creek District Improvement Company.
- 5. The use of stored water under this permit may be used in place of any existing groundwater right for primary irrigation of the same land in order to conserve groundwater supplies.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

- 1. Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.
- 2. Where two or more water users agree among themselves as to the manner of rotation in the use of water and such agreement is placed in writing and filed by such water users with the watermaster, and such rotation system does not infringe upon such prior rights of any water user not a party to such rotation plan, the watermaster shall distribute the water according to such agreement.

- 3. This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.
- 4. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.
- 5. The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
- Construction of the water system shall begin within five years of the date of permit issuance. The
 deadline to begin construction may not be extended. This permit is subject to cancellation
 proceedings if the begin construction deadline is missed.
- 7. Complete application of the water shall be made within five years of the date of permit issuance. If beneficial use of permitted water has not been made before this date, the permittee may submit an application for extension of time, which may be approved based upon the merit of the application.
- 8. Within one year after making complete application of water, the permittee shall submit a claim of beneficial use, which includes a map and report, prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner.



Authority

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 537.147 establishes the process by which an application to use stored water exclusively may be submitted. Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapter 690, Divisions 310 and 340 implement the statute, and provide the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating applications to use stored water exclusively.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On March 8, 2018, Willow Creek District Improvement Company submitted an application for a water-use permit pursuant to ORS 537.147:

- 4. The Department provided public notice of the application in the Department's weekly public notice on March 27, 2018. A 30-day comment period followed.
- 5. The Department has not received public comments related to the possible issuance of the attached permit. Therefore, the Department has determined that no public interest issues as identified in ORS 537.170(8) have been raised.

1. Water Use Measurement, Recording, and Reporting Condition:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a totalizing flow meter at each point of re-diversion. The permittee shall maintain the device in good working order.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the device; provided however, where any device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The permittee shall keep a complete record of the volume of water diverted each month, and shall submit a report which includes water-use measurements to the Department annually, or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water-use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.
- D. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative measuring and reporting procedures for review and approval.
- 2. The water user shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening and fish passage devices consistent with current Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) standards. Fish screening is to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion, while passage devices provide adequate upstream and downstream passage for fish. The required screen and passage devices are to be in place and functional, and approved in writing by ODFW prior to diversion of water. The water user may submit evidence in writing that ODFW has determined screens and/or passage devices are not necessary.
- 3. The use of water under this right is subject to the terms and conditions of contract No. 129E101776, or a satisfactory replacement, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the permittee, a copy of which must be on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.
- 4. Use of water under this permit shall be subject to applicable provisions of the articles of incorporation, bylaws, rules and regulations of the Willow Creek District Improvement Company.
- 5. The use of stored water under this permit may be used in place of any existing groundwater right for primary irrigation of the same land in order to conserve groundwater supplies.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

- 1. Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.
- 2. Where two or more water users agree among themselves as to the manner of rotation in the use of water and such agreement is placed in writing and filed by such water users with the watermaster, and such rotation system does not infringe upon such prior rights of any water user not a party to such rotation plan, the watermaster shall distribute the water according to such agreement.

- 3. This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.
- 4. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.
- 5. The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.
- Construction of the water system shall begin within five years of the date of permit issuance. The
 deadline to begin construction may not be extended. This permit is subject to cancellation
 proceedings if the begin construction deadline is missed.
- 7. Complete application of the water shall be made within five years of the date of permit issuance. If beneficial use of permitted water has not been made before this date, the permittee may submit an application for extension of time, which may be approved based upon the merit of the application.
- 8. Within one year after making complete application of water, the permittee shall submit a claim of beneficial use, which includes a map and report, prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner.





Authority

Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 690-385-7400 describes the documentation the district must file with the Department in order to provide proof of use.

OAR 690-385-7600 provides in pertinent part that satisfactory proof shall be (a) a determination by the Department that application of water to beneficial use under the terms of the transfer final order was completed to the extent authorized, or (b) a determination by the Department that the application of water to a beneficial use under the terms of the transfer final order was completed to an extent less than authorized.

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 540.530(2)(a) and OAR 690-385-7600 authorize the Department to issue or modify a certificate of water right upon satisfactory proof of completion of the change or changes authorized by a final order approving a permanent district transfer.

Findings of Fact

- On October 18, 2017, the Department signed a final order, which was mailed on October 27, 2017, and recorded in Special Order Volume 107, Pages 5-12, approving Transfer Application T-12605 involving Certificates 82491 and 82490. The final order established October 1, 2018, as the date for completion of the authorized changes in place of use.
- On January 8, 2019 the Department received a Claim of Beneficial Use (CBU) and associated maps from the applicant for Transfer Application T-12605 satisfying the requirements for providing proof of use under OAR 690-385-7400 for Certificates 82491 and 82490.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 3. The Department reviewed the CBU and maps submitted by the applicant for Transfer Application T-12605.
- 4. The CBU did not contain a map of the point of diversion from the source. However, since the transfer involved the transfer of places of use only within an irrigation district and did not involve a change in the point of diversion, the existing maps on file with the Department are sufficient to identify the point of diversion from the source.
- 5. The proposed place of use for Certificate 82491 as approved the final order for Transfer Application T-12605, and as recorded in Special Order Volume 107, Pages 5-12 is shown in Table 1, below:

- 10. The reconfigured changes in place of use as documented in the CBU and associated maps_ are determined satisfactory because the reconfigured, completed uses are under the same water right holders, do not enlarge the rights and affect the same number of irrigated acres.
- 11. Based on the review of evidence submitted by the applicant, the Department finds that the application of water to beneficial use under the terms of the transfer final order for T-12605 involving Certificates 82491 and 82490 were completed to the extent authorized in the transfer as described in Table 2 and Table 4, above.

Conclusions of Law

1. The Applicant has submitted proof of use pursuant to OAR 690-385-7400.

- 3. The applicant has demonstrated proof of completion under T-12605 related to Certificates 82491 and 92490 to the satisfaction of the Department.
- 4. The Department is authorized to issue or modify certificates of water rights involved in transfer T-12605 consistent with this determination of satisfactory proof of completion.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

Water right Certificates 82491 and 82490 are modified as shown in Table 2 and Table 4, above. The Department will issue a superseding certificate describing these rights when it determines it is necessary for record keeping.
