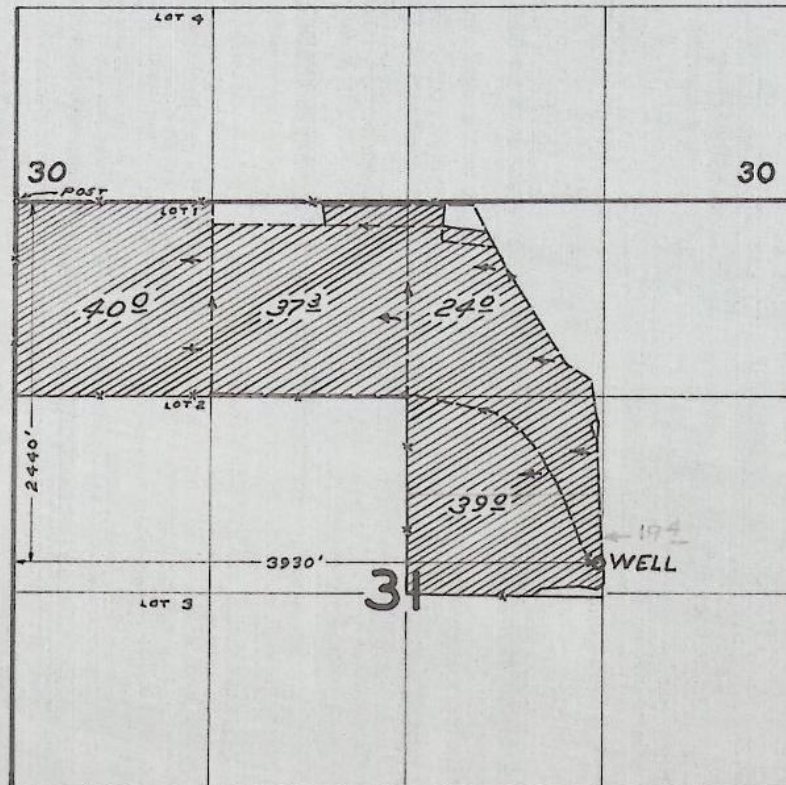

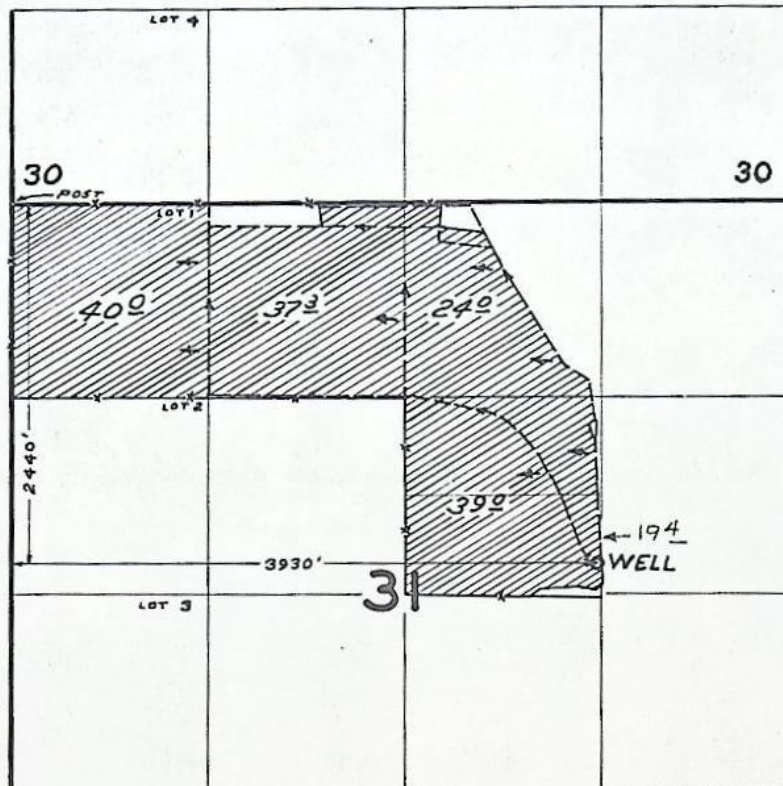

The Water Resources Department has reviewed the pump test results you submitted and rejected the test because:

- [X] Water-level measurements were not collected at the specified time intervals during the pumping phase of the test.
- [X] Water-level measurements were not collected at the specified time intervals during the recovery phase of the test. Measurements must be taken after the pump has been turned off to determine how the water level "recovers" from pumping.

In recording draw down during the test, please follow the schedule provided:

For the first ten minutes of pumping, water level readings must be no more than two minutes apart.

From ten to thirty minutes of pumping, readings must be no more than five minutes apart.

From thirty minutes to four hours of pumping, readings must be no more than fifteen minutes apart.

Please follow the schedule provided below in recording recovery data:

For the first ten minutes after pumping stops, water level readings must be no more than two minutes apart.

From ten to thirty minutes after pumping stops, readings must be no more than five minutes apart.

Dear Mr. Conn:

I am enclosing a certified true copy of permit No. G-3487 issued to Mrs. J. E. Calderwood as requested.

Applications G-4409 and G-4410 were filed May 27, 1968 by Don S. Orlando for a permit to appropriate 3000 gallons per minute from a well for irrigation of 744 acres and for a permit to appropriate 3000 gallons per minute from a well for supplemental irrigation of 300 acres. These applications were not complete and not accompanied by the required map so were returned to the applicant on June 19, 1968 for completion, and they have not yet been returned to us. If you wish, we will furnish copies when these applications are returned.

The only water well report we have for a well drilled in Sec. 31, T. 39 S., R. 36 E., except for the Calderwood well, is for Columbus Groves and is enclosed. No permit exists for appropriation of ground water from this well, but the report indicates this was drilled for domestic use.

C. D. Morris was issued permit No. G-1791 for the appropriation of water from a well in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Sec. 31, T. 39 S., R. 36 E. and this was assigned to James E. Calderwood. We do not have a water well report for this well.

There are no permits for appropriation of ground water for use in Secs. 25 and 36, T. 39 S., R. 35 E.

Our receipt No. 10731 for the \$10.00 you submitted is enclosed. The fee for the documents enclosed is \$3.00. If no other copies are required we will refund the balance of \$7.00.





This will acknowledge your letter of August 21 in reference to permit No. G-1791 in the name of C. D. Morris.

Our records show that permit No. G-1791 was issued on April 13, 1961 in approval of application No. G-1949 and granted the right to appropriate not to exceed 1.86 cubic feet per second from Morris well No. 1 for supplemental irrigation of 149 acres of land which already enjoyed a primary right from a different source.

Under the terms of the permit, as issued, the time limits for beginning and completion of construction and/or the purchase and installation of the facilities necessary to the proposed appropriation of water will expire on April 13, 1962 and October 1, 1962.

The time limit for complete application of water to beneficial use to the full extent intended will expire on October 1, 1963.

Our records show that the construction phase of the project was reported as having been completed prior to issuance of the permit. Therefore, the permit is in good standing until October 1, 1963, at which time you should have beneficially irrigated at least once all of the land intended to be covered under the permit.



Dear Mr. Morris:

Our records indicate that the project described in Permit No. G-37 was not completed within the time limits of the permit and the permit will therefore be cancelled as outlined in our registered letter.

You may refile an identical application and obtain a new permit with new time limits which should allow you sufficient time to complete the project. I have prepared an application copied from that filed by N. W. Starr and have attached a print of the map.

If you wish to file this application, you should examine it, sign it at the place indicated and return it to this office together with the fees in the amount of \$27.95. If there are any changes to be made in the number of acres, location of land irrigated or location of the well, it should be noted on this application before you return it.

A permit, if issued under this new application, would have a later priority date than did Permit No. G-37, but I do not believe this would have any practical effect on your use of water.

If this is not clear, do not hesitate to ask any questions you may have before you refile the application.

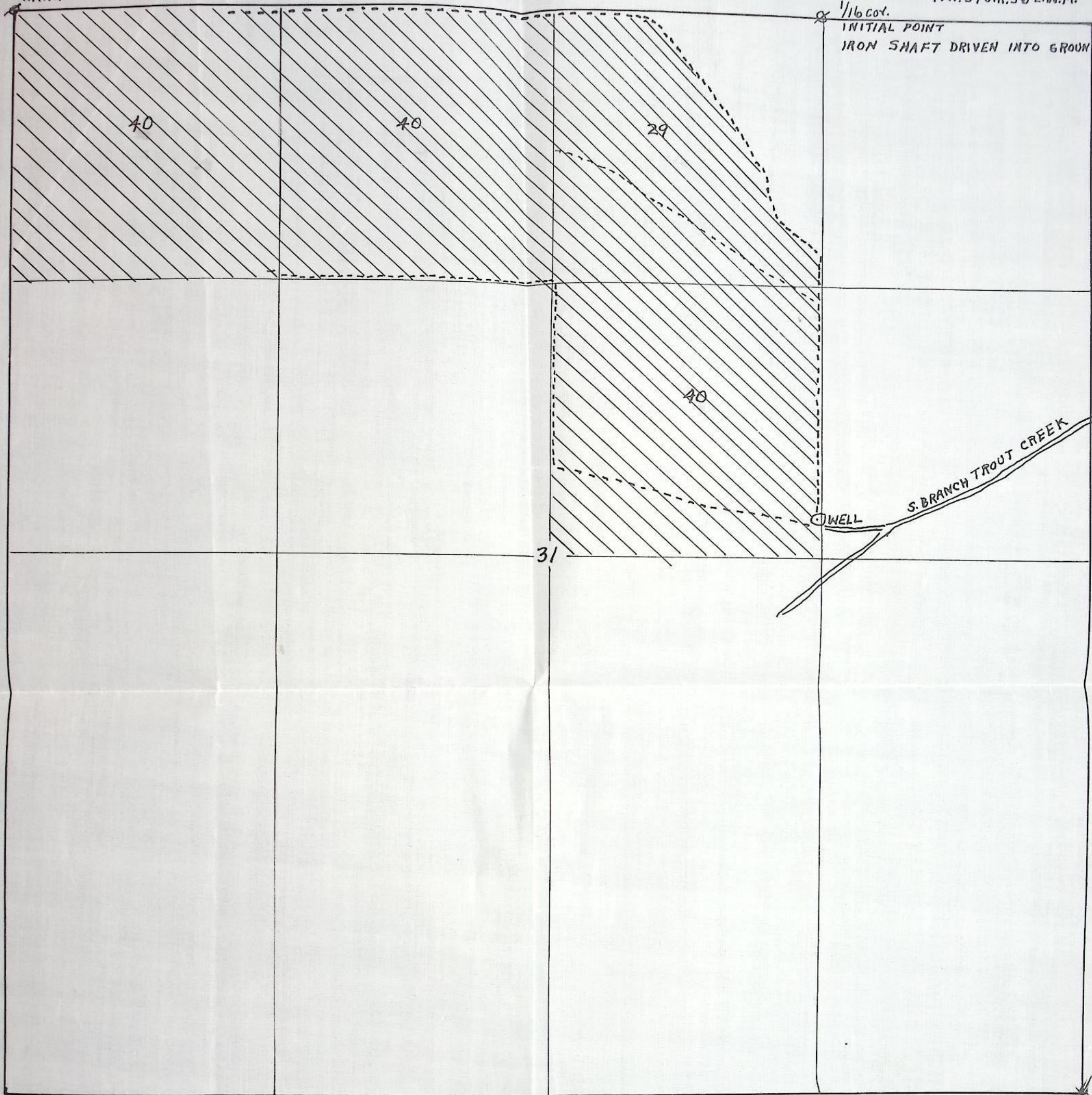
