




This will acknowledge receipt of your notice to the effect that complete application of water has been made under permit No. G-4645.



Dear Mr. Hendrix:

This will acknowledge an application for a permit to construct a reservoir and store 1.5 acre feet therein from Cold Spring Creek for irrigation, supplemental irrigation, and fish culture, a small dam data sheet and the fee of \$20 for which our receipt No. 21433 is enclosed. This application has been filed and numbered R-47680.

Also acknowledged is an application for a permit to appropriate 0.11 cubic foot per second from Cold Spring Creek and Reservoir for the irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 5.0 acres, fish culture, legal description, map, and the fee of \$50 for which our receipt No. 21434 is enclosed. This application has been filed and numbered 47681.

Enclosed is a copy of the map submitted with application No. G-4979. These 4.0 acres designated as supplemental irrigation on the application map does not include all of the land designated as 4.0 acres of irrigation from the well. Is the entire 4.0 acres to be supplemented from the reservoir? If so, the map should be in agreement with that submitted with the earlier application.

Our hydraulic engineer indicates that the spillway described on the small dam data sheet is not adequate to pass the anticipated fifty-year flood. If the depth of 2.5 feet is to be maintained, a bottom width of 12 feet is recommended.

I am returning both applications, small dam data sheet, the map and print for correction, endorsed so that in order to retain their priority dates, they must be returned to this office on or before January 18, 1971.
