**PRE-1909 CLAIM OF BENEFICIAL USE AND SITE REPORT

**Information:**

Dane Smith and my representative, Tom Hoshall, visited the place of use on March 17, 1995. All uses of the vested claim were found as described. Mr. Smith pointed out historic aspects and references documenting the continued use since the late 1880's. A barn constructed in 1885 is still standing. The existing house (which is the second residence constructed at this site) was built in 1913 - the original house was constructed sometime in the late 1880's. The ranch is documented in a local book "*History of Haines Slough.*"

Unnamed stream, a tributary of Palouse Creek/Haines Slough, Coos Bay.

Described as perforated section of 4" PVC placed in stream with small clay head gate (3' long x 1' tall). 30' of 4" PVC delivered gravity flow to a 1200 gal. fiberglass storage tank. Flow at time of inspection was 1/2 - 3/4 gal./min. (estimated).

**Motor/pump:**

N.A. - system is based on gravity flow.

**Pipe:**

From storage tank: 1 1/2" x 600' of black poly pipe delivers gravity flow to house and several hose bibs; an additional 400' then serves the barn and three water troughs.

- Stock water (82 head = 82: 24 cattle, 30 llamas, 20 yaks, six sheep and two goats) from troughs and stream.

The Water Resources Department (WRD) received a little over 600 surface water registration statements in December, 1992. All of the files have been set up and receipts for the fees have been sent. The next step is to insure the maps received in support of the claims are acceptable based on Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) and Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR).

I am returning the map you prepared for Dane Smith. You will find the item which requires completion or correction shown below. I have the description followed by the ORS or OAR site and paraphrased statute or rule.
