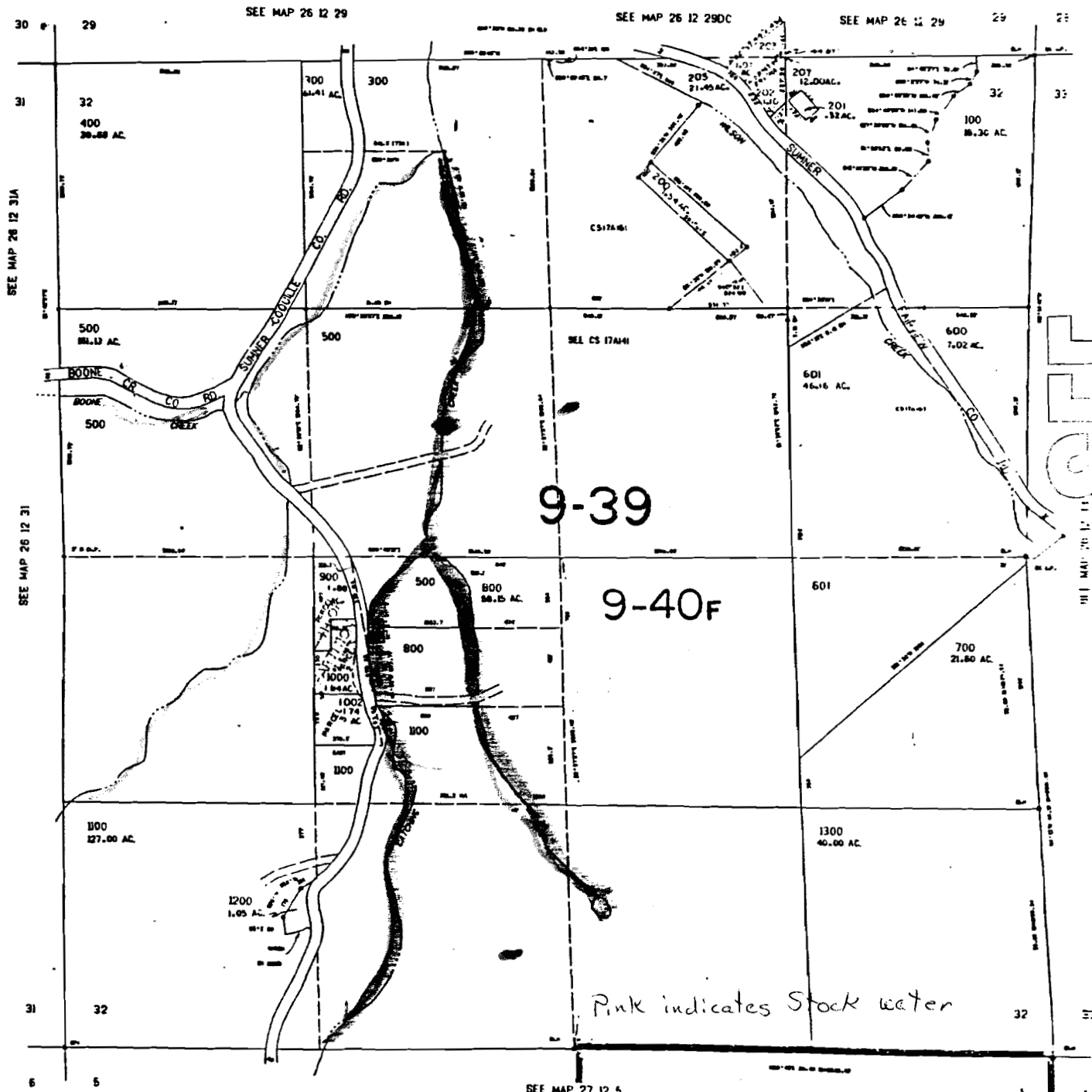

To Whom it may Concern:

I, George Ross, Jr., was born in Marshfield (now Coos Bay) July 29, 1905 and was raised on my father's dairy farm on Catching Inlet and Ross Slough.

My earliest memories are of the milk boat with its deck lined with milk cans from the dairies on Catching Inlet stopping at our wharf to pick up the milk. Its destination was the Coos Bay Creamery on the other side of Bull Island in the old Coos River channel.

The creamery was built in 1892, my grandfather, Frank Ross, being one of the founders. When my parents, George Ross and Lucy Black were married in 1899, Frank Ross gave them the farm and a herd of dairy cows. I have positive knowledge that from that time to the present the dairy has continued uninterrupted. It included more land in 1899, running from what is now Azalea Acres on Catching Inlet down to Ross Inlet and up Ross Inlet including Boekeloos, Evans, Atkins, and Dr. Levy's.

In 1900 my father sold the land straight across from us to John Collver. Ida Matson used to tell the story when I was less than two years old, looking across the slough and saying, "John Collver's cows are sitting down. This land was later sold to Albert Collver, Everett Messerle's grandfather, and has been in Messerle ownership ever since as a dairy until the barn burned down and as a beef ranch since that time.

The portion that my son Gordon dairies now was divided into five fields. Four of them had watering troughs fed from springs along the foothill, while in the pasture next to Ross Inlet, the cows had to drink out of the slough. I remember this from my early memories of going after the cows with my father and later on my pony.

My early associations with Gordon Collver, my same age, across on Stock Slough, of fishing up Collver Creek (Stock Slough) afforded me the knowledge that the Collvers had dairied there for many years and that livestock has continued until this day on all the bottom lands on Stock Slough on lands now owned by John Stalcup, John Dubisar, Foster McSwain, Messerle's, Dan Scoville, Lou Ann and John Rode, Mel Burnette, Gordon Ross, John Szymik, and Chet Fors, and have dairied and ran stock on every acre of it at one time myself.

My grandfather, Henry Black, milked cows on a farm halfway to Sumner now owned by Bill Cole and the Messerle farm, called the Anchor Ranch, was four separate dairies in the early years. On to Sumner from Henry Blacks we could go by wagon to the Byers Ranch. Uncle Frank Black married Alice Byers. This farm is still in dairying being owned now by V. J. Willis. The Messerle farm in Sumner was at that time owned by Capt. Harris. Mrs Harris had her own cheese plant, and in 1902 exhibited the Grand Champion Cheese at the Chicago Expedition.

I can attest that all of the ownerships I have specifically mentioned have been in livestock production continuously from my earliest memories until this day, and that I can say with equal certainty that any bottom land on Ross Inlet, Catching Inlet, Stock Slough, or Sumner has supported livestock from the time it was cleared and drained until the present with the exception of a few annual crops for a season at a time.

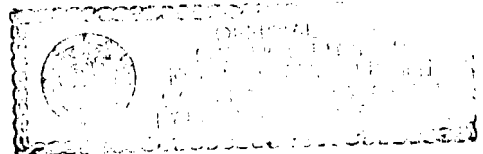

Dear Mr & Mrs Willis,

I am in the process of reviewing the maps submitted in support of pre-1909 vested water right claims. There may have been some misunderstanding about the required map during the last few months before the December 31, 1992 deadline. As the deadline approached, it was apparent the Water Right Examiners (WRE) would not be able to survey and prepare the required map and site report. We allowed claimants to submit most any kind of map to meet the deadline. We tried to insure claimants understood that the survey, map and site report would be required as soon as the WRE had time to make the field survey and complete the map and report.

The reason I am writing today is about your map. The map submitted does not meet the statutory requirements. I need to know when I might receive the required map from you. I cannot complete my review of your claim without the required map.

Dear MR & MRS WILLIS,

This will acknowledge that your Surface Water Registration Statement in the name of VJ & DOLORSE WILLIS has been received by our office. The fees in the amount of \$200.00 have been received and our receipt #96019 is enclosed. You should have submitted a total of \$400.00 for the two uses you indicate on your claim form. There is a balance due of \$200.00 and your claim will not be processed until the balance is received. Your registration statement has been numbered SWR-545.

The map you submitted with your claim is not acceptable. ORS 539.240 (2) (d) requires the map be prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner (CWRE). Within 60 days of this letter you must send a letter to this address indicating you have contracted with a CWRE to prepare your map. You should send your letter to my attention. In your letter you must identify the name of the CWRE who will prepare your registration statement map. We will contact the CWRE to arrange a map submittal deadline.

We will not be able to process your claim until we have received your map. If you have any questions regarding this process, please do not hesitate to give me a call.
