PART I: BACKGROUND INFORMATION

"Monson Memories" begins with material from Inez (Benson) Wilson's unpublished book "BENJAMIN and MARY ANN (THOMAS) ROBERTS and THEIR FAMILIES" because Iscah Roberts was their oldest daughter.

BENJAMIN ROBERTS, born March 6, 1845, in Batley, Yorkshire, England, and MARY ANN THOMAS, born July 12, 1850, near Merthyr-Tydfil, South Wales, were married January 2, 1866, at Neff's Farm, Barton, Maryland. He had emigrated with his parents from England in 1865, she when one year old with her parents. At the time of their marriage, he was 20 years of age and she was 15.

Benjamin worked in the coal mines in Allegany County, Maryland, as the family did in their homeland at Batley, England. Their two oldest children were born in Lonaconing, Maryland. Iscah (named after his sister) in 1866 and Amelia Jane, another sister, in 1869. Before their third child was born, they left Maryland and by way of Cape Horn moved to Mortonville, Contra Costa County, California. There David was born May 22, 1871. Then later they continued on to Coos County, Oregon, where Benjamin was employed at the Flanagan and Mann Coal Mine at Newport. (The name was changed to Libby when a Post Office was established and it was learned there already was a Newport Post Office farther up the coast.)

Three more children were born at Newport: Emma, March 12, 1873; Elizabeth Ann, February 28, 1875, who died while a child, and James Stubley, January 15, 1877.

In 1879, Benjamin and Mary Ann took up a homestead at Ten Mile. To reach there they traveled by boat up Haynes Inlet, then by horse and wagon or walking over the hill. Benjamin continued working at the mine, while the rest of the family lived at the homestead.

Iscah married Nels Monson, who also homesteaded at Ten Mile adjoining the Roberts' place, on May 22, 1882. She was 15 years old at the time. Five more children were born to the Roberts: Edith, April 22, 1882; George, August 29, 1884; Abraham, September 22, 1886; Allen Thomas, September 17, 1889, and Joseph Milton, February 8, 1891.

Amelia Jane "Janey" married Rufus Stewart, September 17, 1890. They had a daughter Minnie. Amelia Jane died March 7, 1895, with childbirth. The Roberts raised their grandchild as well as their daughter Emma's three children when she was separated from her husband Charles Markham. So with their own 11 children and 4 grandchildren to raise, they had quite a large family! (Amelia Jane was probably the first person to be buried at the Templeton Cemetery.)

(The Templeton Post Office was established June 21, 1898, east of Ten Mile Lake. It was called Templeton after Robert Templeton, a bachelor who was the main person getting the route started.) Albina Coleman was the first of four postmasters. Others were Edward Taylor, Benjamin Roberts, and Miss Greta Walker. The mail was carried by boat and horseback from Marshfield to Gardiner, Oregon. Some of the known mail-carriers were: Lemuel and William Copple, Dale and Merl Holden and Rudy Sandine. The Post Office was discontinued February 28, 1917.

In 1907, Mary Ann and Benjamin made their first trip back to Maryland since leaving in 1870. They presumably traveled by train. Both of their parents had died since they left. Mary Ann brought back a hooked rug her sister Amelia Jane McCormick had made and had given to her. Mrs. Andrew Wilson of North Bend, Oregon still has this rug. (1980).

On January 3, 1909, Mary Ann died of cancer. She had been ill for some time.

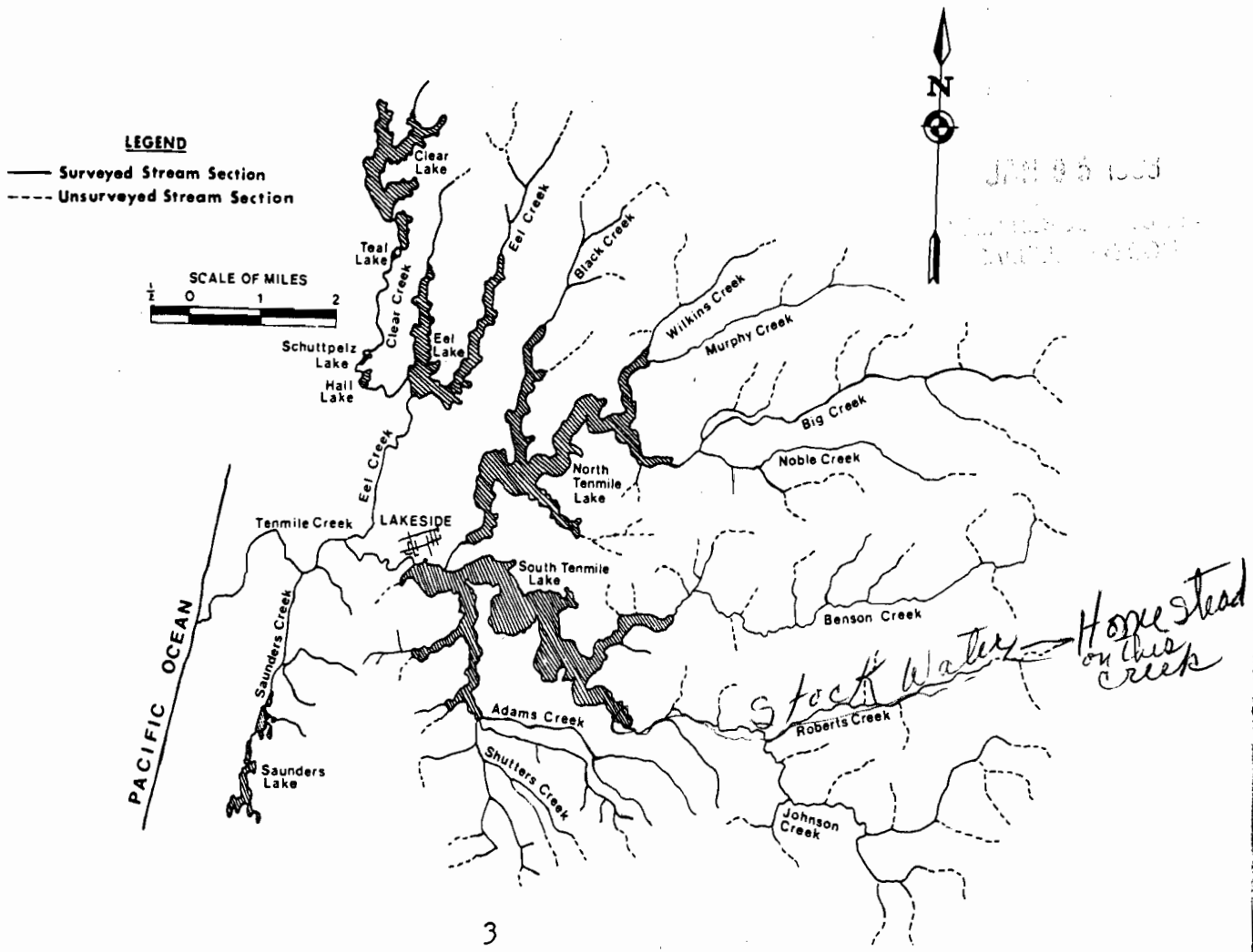
On March 1, 1913, Benjamin rented the farm to his three sons: Abraham, Allen, and Joseph for \$500 a year. After that it was always called "The Boys" place. Esther Monson was their housekeeper for many years.

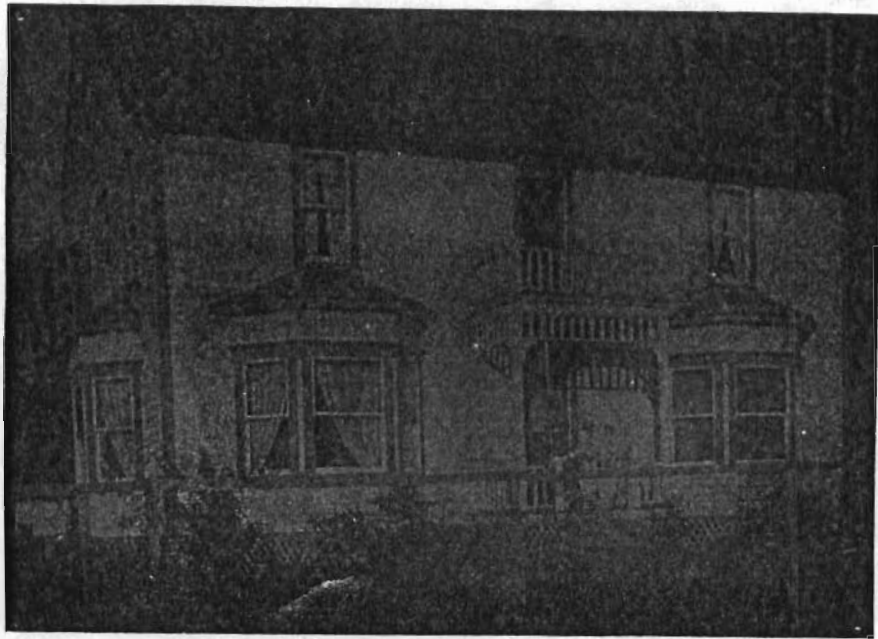
umbelliferous genus *Ferula* and used in medicine", as explained in the American College Dictionary. So now you know! The horrible garlic-like smell was enough to frighten away almost anything. At any rate we were a very healthy lot. (Two neighbor children died one year from Diphtheria.)

Grandfather always had a supply of rock candy, white and pink, for us children, as well as hourhound drops and licorice, which he liked best of all. Mamma said that when I was real small and just beginning to talk, he taught me how to say Australia in Swedish. He would hold me on his lap and ask where I came from, and I would answer "Owstrawlia"! When the first "Talking machine" was displayed at the Central Hotel downtown, it was Grandfather who took us to see it. There it was on a table in the middle of this large room. For ten cents we listened through something resembling a stethoscope and heard a faraway voice singing "Molly, Molly, always so jolly, Mollie and I and the Baby".

I remember his collapsible Spy Glass which he let us look at the moon through. It was about 16 or 18 inches long, with a brown covering and it had two smaller metal sections that pulled out, making it in all probably about 30 inches long. We loved to look at distant objects and when we looked through the other end everything seemed very far away. I don't know what became of it, but I do have his old snuff box which he always carried in his vest pocket. It is tiny - just two and a half inches long, oval shaped and made of birch bark with a little leather loop on top to open it with.

When we were small, Grandfather used to lie face down and have us walk up and down his back bone in our stocking feet. He said it felt great and was good for the spine. Also he used to measure us on our birthdays - height, weight, and how far we could reach - and he put it down in a little book.
