Alan Sullivan met me at the site on November 4, 1994. At this time he indicated that to the best of his knowledge there had been no variance is use since the date of development in January 1, 1900. The survey was completed on November 4, 1994.

SOURCES:

Joe Cox creek and three unnamed streams, tributaries of Floras Creek.

DIVERSION POINTS:

P.O.D. #1 is an old in-stream pond that the creek flows through. The P.O.D. is 300 feet South and 2340 feet West of the Northeast corner of Section 12, T. 31 S., R. 15 W., W.M..

P.O. D. #2 is an in-stream device located on Joe Cox Creek and is 1045 feet South and 2960 feet West of the Northeast corner of Section 12, T. 31 S., R. 15 W., W.M..

P.O.D. #3 is an in-stream device located on unnamed stream #3 and is 1580 feet South and 1210 feet West of the Northeast corner of Section 11, T. 31 S., R. 15 W., W.M..

P.O.D. #4 is a natural spring pond and is located 920 feet South and 1015 feet West of the Northwest corner of Section 11, T. 31 S., R. 15 W., W.M.

P.O.D. #5 is an in-stream 35 horsepower electric motor and pump. It is located 1180 feet East of the Northwest corner of Section 12, T. 31 S., R. 15 W., W.M..

P.O.D. #6 is an in-stream 40 horsepower electric motor and pump. It is located 450 feet South and 735 feet West of the Northeast corner of Section 11, T. 31 S., R. 15 W., W.M..

MOTOR/PUMP:

A 35 horsepower General Electric motor with a 450 gallon per minute pump is located at P.O.D. #5. No serial or model numbers were visible on the pump or motor. The pump has four inch diameter intake and discharge openings.

A 40 horsepower General Electric motor with a 475 gallon per minute pump is located at P.O.D. #6. No serial numbers or model numbers were visible on the pump or motor. The pump has four inch diameter intake and discharge openings.

PIPE:

Domestic pipe: Residence 1 & 2 850 feet of 2 inch diameter PVC.

Residence 3 800 feet of 2 inch diameter and 250

feet of 1 1/2 inch diameter PVC.

Irrigation pipe: Main 4 inch diameter $400 \pm \text{feet}$

Lateral 2 inch diameter 600 + feet

From P.O.D. #2 450 feet of two inch diameter PVC bears N 20 W thence; N 30 W for 400 feet to the place of use, residences 1 & 2.

From P.O.D. #3 800 feet of two inch diameter PVC bears N 35 E to a 1500 gallon storage tank from the tank a one and one-half inch diameter PVC pipe bears N 15 E for 250 feet to the place of use Residence #3.


P.O.D. # 5 & 6 are seasonal in-steam pumps. The main and lateral pipes are distributed accordingly with the irrigation pattern.

HEADS:

Twenty Rainbird # 40 with 1/8 inch nozzle size, Maximum number sprinklers in use at one time twenty.

#40 head with 1/8" nozzle = 2.9 GPM @ 40 PSI

20 heads at 2.9GPM/Hd = 58 GPM



USES:

The uses are Domestic (three residences), in-stream livestock watering (150 sheep and 30 cattle), irrigation (30 acres). The in-stream livestock watering occurs along Joe Cox creek the three unnamed streams and the two ponds.

LIFT/HEAD:

Residences 1 & 2 are 60 feet lower than the P.O.D. and have a PSI of 26.

Residence 3 is 40 feet lower than the 1500 gallon storage tank and has a PSI of 17.

P.O. D. #5 has a suction lift of 13 feet, P.O.D. #6 has a suction lift of 10 feet both have an estimated PSI of 40.

CALCULATIONS:

Domestic three @ .005CFS = .015 CFS Livestock sheep 150 @ 1.5GPD = 225 GPD cattle 30 @ 15GPD = 450 GPD Irrigation @ 1/80 CFS/ac x 30ac = 8078 GPD

CLAIM OF BENEFICAIAL USE .25 CFS


POINT OF BEGINNING:

The point of beginning was the Northeast corner of Section 12 and the Northeast corner of Section 11, Township 31 South, Range 15 West, Willamette Meridian, Curry County, Oregon. The ties were made with a Set 4 C total station, aerial photos, hand compass and string chain.

CONCLUSION:



I am in the process of reviewing the maps submitted in support of pre-1909 vested water right claims. There may have been some misunderstanding about the required map during the last few months before the December 31, 1992 deadline. As the deadline approached, it was apparent the Water Right Examiners (WRE) would not be able to survey and prepare the required map and site report. We allowed claimants to submit most any kind of map to meet the deadline. We tried to insure claimants understood that the survey, map and site report would be required as soon as the WRE had time to make the field survey and complete the map and report.

The reason I am writing today is about your map. The map submitted does not meet the statutory requirements. I need to know when I might receive the required map from you. I cannot complete my review of your claim without the required map.

Dear PAULINE SULLIVAN,

This will acknowledge that your Surface Water Registration Statement in the name of PAULINE SULLIVAN has been received by our office. The fees in the amount of \$660 have been received and our receipt #96023 is enclosed. Your registration statement has been numbered SWR-551.

You have noted that there may be an overpayment in the amount of \$200.00. We will wait until after we have reviewed your map to determine whether or not a refund is warranted. If indeed there has been an overpayment, a check will be issued in the appropriate amount to "Law Office Trust."

The map you submitted with your claim is not acceptable. ORS 539.240 (2) (d) requires the map be prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner (CWRE). Within 60 days of this letter you must send a letter to this address indicating you have contracted with a CWRE to prepare your map. You should send your letter to my attention. In your letter you must identify the name of the CWRE who will prepare your registration statement map. We will contact the CWRE to arrange a map submittal deadline.

We will not be able to process you claim until we have received your map. If you have any questions regarding this process, please do not hesitate to give me a call.


