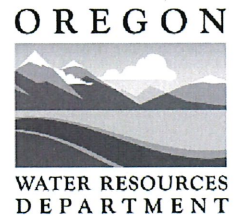

The permittee shall install and maintain a staff gage in Reservoir 2 (App. R-87930, Permit R-15320) and Reservoir 4 (App. R-87932, Permit R-15319) that measures the entire range and stage between empty and full reservoir level. The Director may require the permittee to install a totalizing flow meter or other approved measuring device at each point of diversion. The applicant indicated in the application that meters to measure water use will be installed at the diversion pumps located at each reservoir.

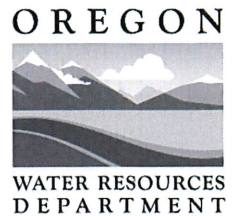
