Dear Roseburg Forest Products,

We have received your letters of February 10, 2026, notifying the Department that Roseburg Forest Products is changing from the specific industrial uses of Stored water under Certificates 75434, 91143, 23959, 23960, 26351, 47589, and 19783 and Surface water uses under Certificates 52974, 89043, 34980, 37703, 19785, 76588, 23958, 23961, 26352, 47590, and 76587, to general industrial uses.

Any general use (new use) of water will continue to occur within the property of the original water right, and the quantity of water used for general industrial purposes will not be greater than the rates and volumes allowed under the original water rights.

The requirements for making the change are established under ORS 540.520(9) and OAR 690-380-2340. Your letters appear to include all of the information required under the statutes and rules. We will file your notifications in our water right records.

Current statutes and rules do not include a process for Department review and approval of notifications of specific to general industrial changes. Any issues associated with eligibility and compliance will be addressed by the Watermaster during normal distribution and regulation activities.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HARBOR PLYWOOD CORPORATION OF OREGON

of Hoquiam, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Cow Creek, a tributary of Umpqua River, for the purpose of log pond and boilers, being 0.44 cfs for pond and 0.01 cfs for boilers under Permit No. 15855 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 3, 1944.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.45 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on James Catching D.L.C. #43, Section 26, T. 30 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

Flint D.L.C. No. 45, Township 30 South, Range 6 West, W. M. Thence along the southerly side of said Railroad right-of-way North 59° 04' East 332.0 feet; thence along a fence line South 10° 45' East 1000 feet; thence West 471.0 feet; thence North 808.7 feet to the place of beginning, containing 8 acres. 


