THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

7833 LOWER RIVER ROAD
GRANTS PASS, OR 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of EWE CREEK, a tributary to the ROGUE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 13.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under permit S-524. The date of priority is DECEMBER 8, 1910. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.16 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgate, in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same source as the original point of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described.

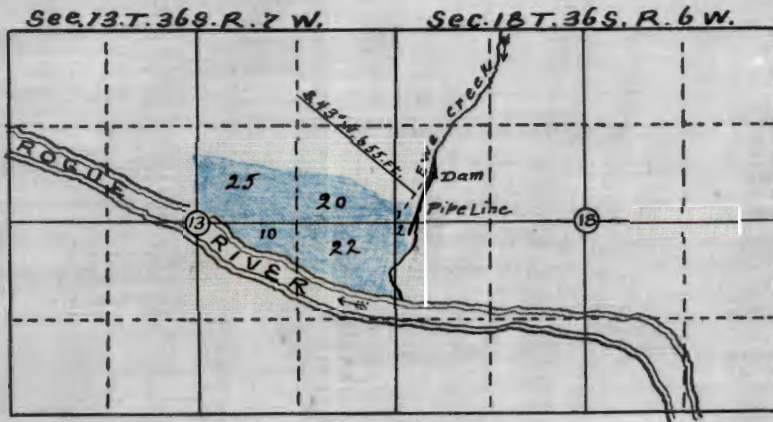

CHAPTER 236.

AN ACT

Providing for the payment of an annual license fee to the State by claimants to the use of water for power purposes where the water was applied to power generation, and the power generated prior to the 22d day of May, 1909, with suitable penalties for failure to pay the same, and providing the manner for collecting the same. [S. B. 84.]

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:

Section 1. Every person, firm, corporation or association hereinafter called "claimant," claiming the right to the use of water for power development where said water was applied to the development or generation of power, and the power generated thereby prior to the 22nd day of May, 1909, shall on or before the 1st day of January, 1912, and on or before the 1st day of January of each year thereafter, pay to the State of Oregon in advance an annual license fee based upon the theoretical water horsepower claimed under each and every separate claim to water, graduated as follows, to-wit: Ten cents for each and every theoretical water horsepower up to 100, inclusive; five cents for each and every theoretical water horsepower in excess of 100 and up to and including 1,000; and one cent for each and every theoretical water horsepower in excess of 1,000; *provided, however*, upon filing the statement as hereinafter provided, the United States, or the State, or any municipal corporation, claiming the right to the use of water to any extent for the generation of power, or any other claimant to the right to use water for the generation of 25 theoretical water horsepower, or less, shall be exempted from the payment of all fees herein provided.

Section 2. The fees herein provided shall be paid to the State Engineer in advance, and shall be accompanied by a written statement showing the extent of such claim. Said statement shall set forth the name and address of the claimant; the name of the stream from which the water is appropriated or claimed for power development; a description of the forty acres, or smallest legal subdivision in which the point of diversion and point of return are located; the date of the right as

claimed; the maximum amount of water claimed expressed in cubic feet per second of time; the total average fall utilized under such claim; the manner of developing power, and the use to which the power is applied. If the regular flow is supplemented by water stored in a reservoir, the location of such reservoir, its capacity in acre-feet and the stream from which it is filled and fed, should be given, also the date of the right as as claimed, for storage purposes.

Should any claimant fail or neglect to file such statement within the time specified, or fail or neglect to pay such fees within the time specified, the fees due and payable shall be the amount specified in Section 1 of this Act increased twenty-five per cent, and the State shall have a preference lien therefor, together with interest at the rate of ten per cent per annum from date of delinquency, upon the property of the claimant used, or necessary for use, in the development of the right or claim, together with any improvements erected thereon for such development, and upon notice from the State Engineer, the Attorney General shall proceed to foreclose the lien, and collect the amount due, as herein provided, in the same manner as other liens on real property are foreclosed.

Section 3. The filing of a claim to water in excess of the amount to which the claimant is legally entitled shall not operate to vest in such claimant any right to the use of such excess water, nor shall the payment of the annual license fees, provided for herein, operate to vest in any claimant any right to the use of such water beyond the amount to which claimant is legally entitled. The filing of such claim to water shall be conclusive evidence as to the abandonment by the claimant of all rights to water for power purposes in excess of the claim as filed.

Section 4. The amount of theoretical water horsepower upon which fees shall be paid under the provisions of this Act shall be computed by multiplying the maximum amount of water claimed, expressed in cubic feet per second, by the average total fall utilized, expressed in feet, and dividing the product by 8.8.

In reply to your inquiry of the 19th instant with reference to application No. 1122, permit No. 524, in the name of Alice Jordan, I beg to advise that actual construction work under this application was required to begin on or before January 28, 1912, be completed on or before January 28, 1913, and the water completely applied to the proposed use on or before January 28, 1915. Notice of beginning construction work within the required time and notice of prosecution of work with diligence up to December, 1912, has been filed, but no reports have been filed since that time.

If the water was applied to the proposed use within the time fixed in the permit, the right is undoubtedly good. On the other hand, if the work has not been completed and the water applied, it would appear that the rights thereunder have lapsed and I would suggest that a new filing be made in this office. No subsequent filings have been made on the waters of Ewe Creek. Blanks and instructions are enclosed.

If the permit is in good standing at the present time, assignments should be filed showing the transfer to you.

In reply to your letter of the 19th instant in regard to affidavit of ownership under application No. 1122, permit No. 524, you are advised that the letter of the State Engineer dated February 15, 1916, was in error in stating that the assignment had been recorded. It is the custom of that office upon receipt of an assignment or affidavit for record in the miscellaneous records to stamp the same as received on a certain date, and if the fee for recording same was not received, to hold the assignment or affidavit until the fee had been paid. 


