

M.** Diversion point located **410 feet South and 630 feet West from E $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 18.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-seventieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **$\frac{3}{4}$ acre foot per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This will acknowledge receipt of your notice to the effect that complete application of water has been made under permit No. 32080.

Pursuant to your report and in line with the general practice of this office, a survey will be made at a later date.

After this survey, proof may be made and certificate issued covering the actual use of water as found by the engineer. In case of irrigation, any lands described in the permit that have not been irrigated will be automatically eliminated from the water right.


