Dear Mr. Rogers:

Thank you for your letter of March 2nd relative to the cancelation of water right on the V. Berry property and the 15 acres in Section 3 that in my opinion should be canceled.

A similar statement was made by Mr. Sorrels. I feel that the testimony used in the Berry cancelation concerning the flume is pertinent in this instance. Perhaps secondary use of testimony is not admissable however.

I contacted Mr. Allen Balou who moved from the property recently. He stated the water from Rock Creek had not been used on the property while he lived there. He was there only for the past two years. I also contacted Mr. Gene Whittier of 1685 Harbeck Road, Grants Pass, Ore., the former owner of the property, and he stated that he would sign an affidavit that the water from Rock Creek had not been used on the property since he acquired it in March of 1948.

The present occupants of the property are Phelan K. Nelson, Williams, Oregon. Mr. Emil Voss, Virgil Berry, Della Morrison and Mr. Sorrels are all living in Williams, Oregon.

A point that should be brought out concerning the issuance of the certificate and also the cancelation, is no one so far as I can ascertain has ever diverted water from Glade Creek. All of the diversions have been from Rock Creek. There has evidently been a name change on the creek, or there was some confusion as to what the name of the creek was at the time of adjudication. Glade Fork is the creek that is the next usable watercourse upstream on the East Fork of Williams Creek and south of Rock Creek.

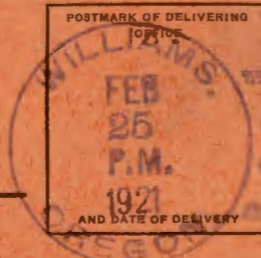

Enclosed please find my official receipt No. 4103 for \$3.00, which amount was transmitted with your letter of the 21st instant together with your application for permit to appropriate water. This application has been numbered 4762 and placed on file in this office.

I note that the application is for the use of water from a different stream and calls for a different point of diversion than under application No. 4503, permit No. 2657, although it covers the irrigation of land covered by the former permit. In view of the fact that it is somewhat cheaper to pay a fee of 15¢ for each acre to be irrigated under this permit than to pay the sum of \$5.00, which is the amount required for an application for a supplemental supply of water for the irrigation of land already having a water right, I would suggest that you transmit the sum of \$2.25 as the balance of fees on this application. Upon receipt of this amount the application will be approved.

I note from the records of this office that final proof has not been submitted under your permit No. 2822, which covers the appropriation of 0.2 second foot from Glade Fork of Williams Creek for irrigation of 15 acres, although the time for the completion of this water right expired October 1st, 1919. In view of the fact that final proof has not been submitted, we presume the water right has been abandoned, and if so, we would be glad to have you authorize the cancellation of the permit, as this will eliminate the necessity of following the regular procedure for the cancellation of the same.

However, if the terms of the permit have been complied with, and the land actually irrigated in accordance with the terms of the permit, final proof should be submitted in order that water right Certificate may be issued by the Board. We would be glad to forward new blanks for final proof upon receipt of request.

As we have received no reply to our letter of July 22nd, 1920, in regard to this matter, you are advised that unless hearing from you within sixty days from the date of this letter, the permit will be presented to the Board for cancellation in accordance with the provisions of Section 7, Chapter 366, Laws of Oregon for 1917, which provides for the cancellation of permits when the holders thereof fail or refuse to complete their water rights within three months after the same should have been completed.

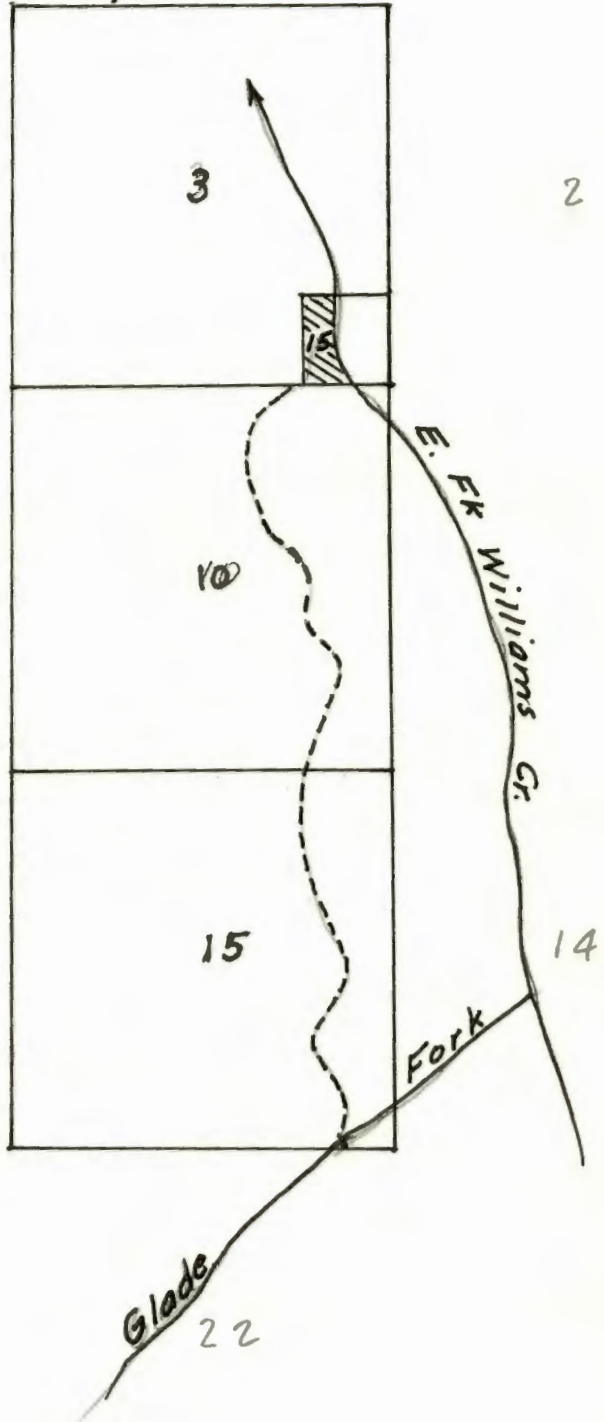

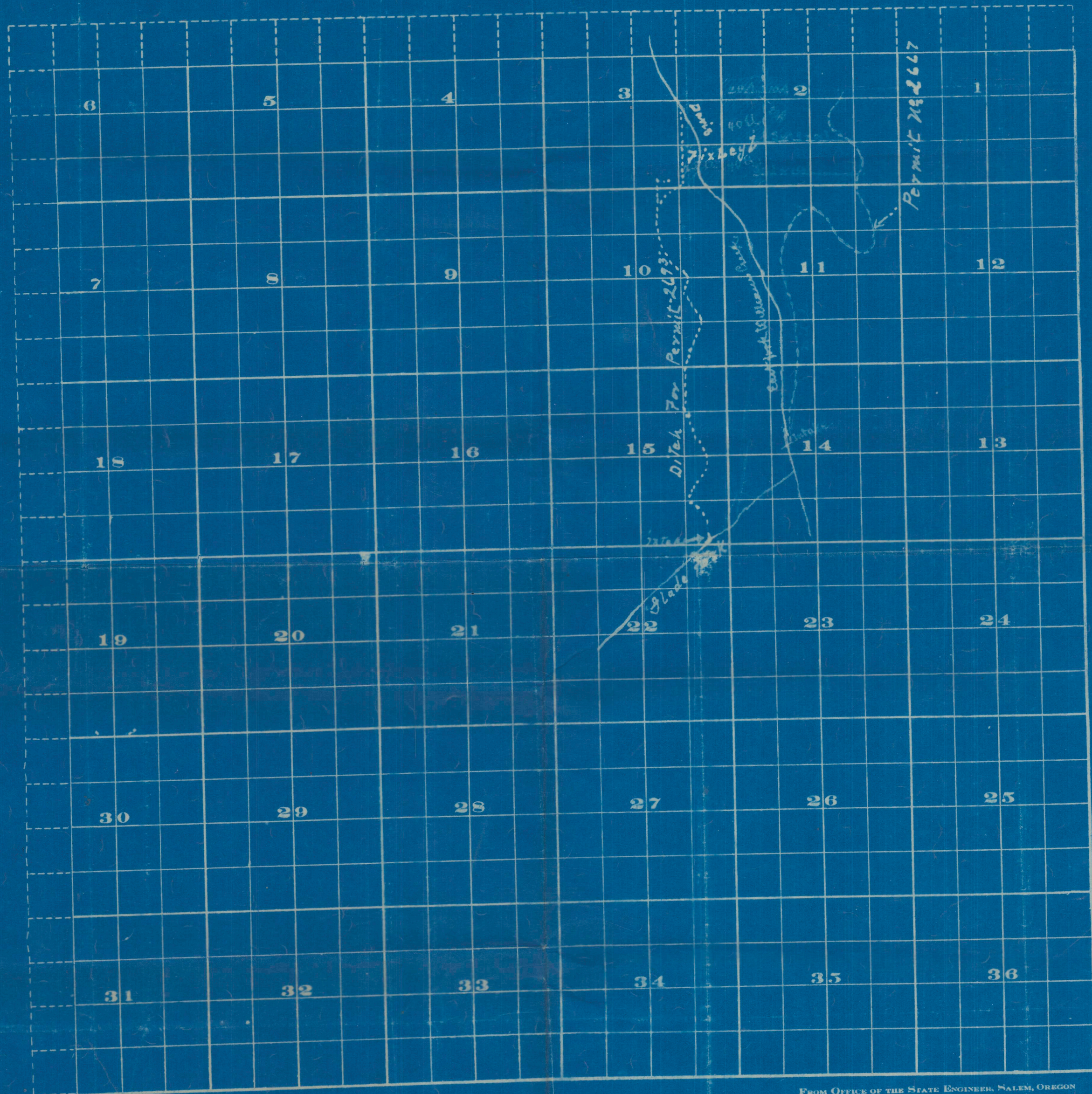

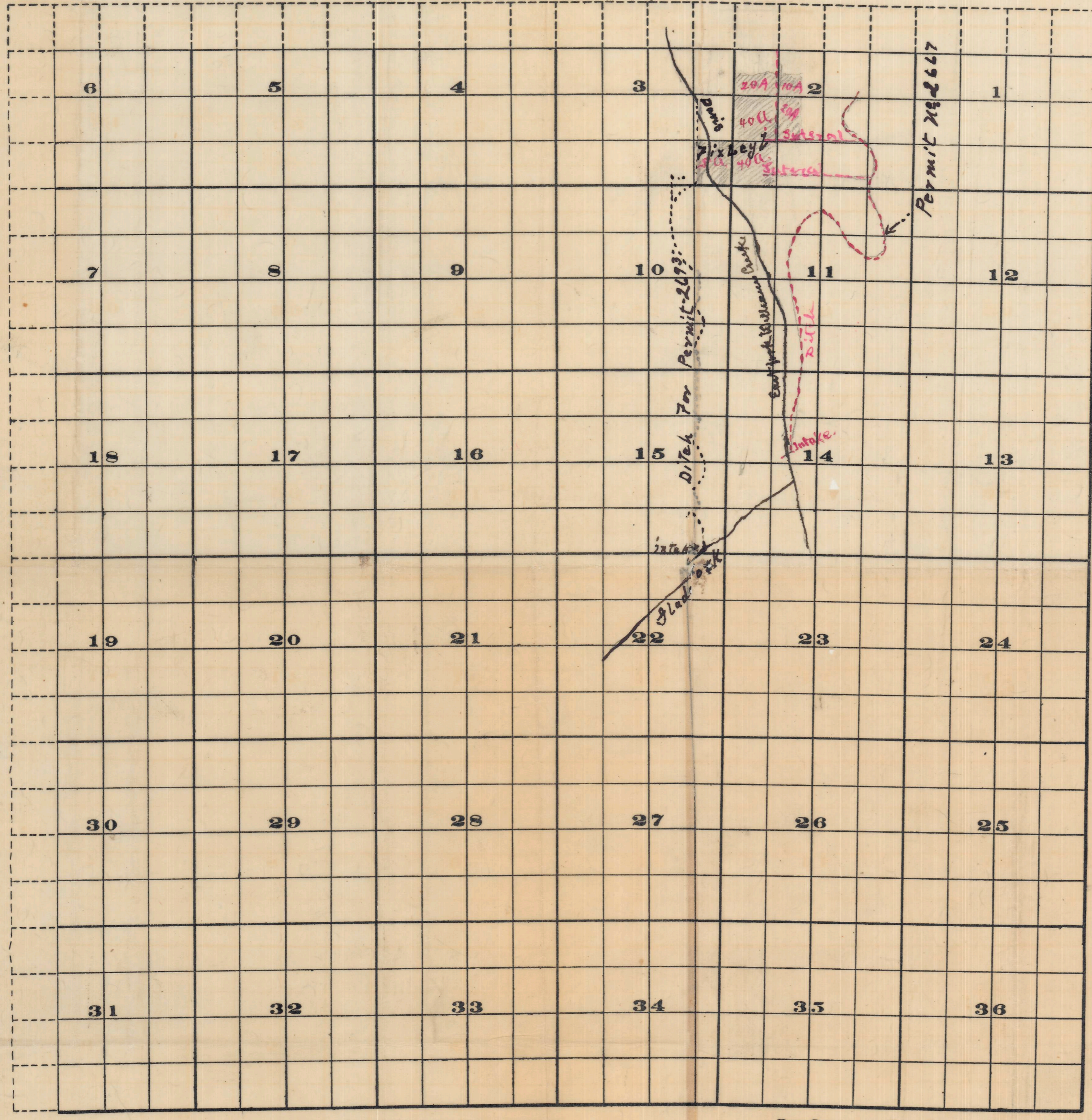
