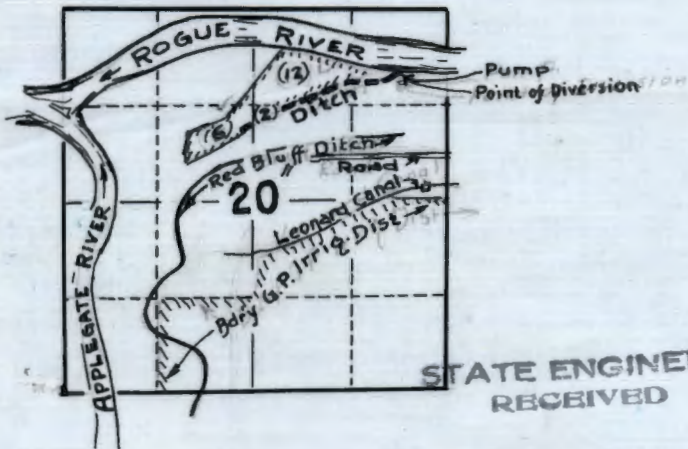

NOTICE OF BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION

I, J.W. Stinger, the holder of Application No. 10569, being Enlargement Permit No. 7141, issued by the State Engineer of the State of Oregon for the appropriation of 0.25 second-feet of the waters of Rogue River in accordance with the tenor of such permit and the limitations endorsed thereon by the State Engineer, began the actual construction of the works described therein on the 15 day of March, 1926, being within the time limitation as fixed in said permit for the beginning of construction work.

Remarks: One man and one team built 80 rods of ditch and irrigated about 12 acres of land also cleared and leveled most of it
