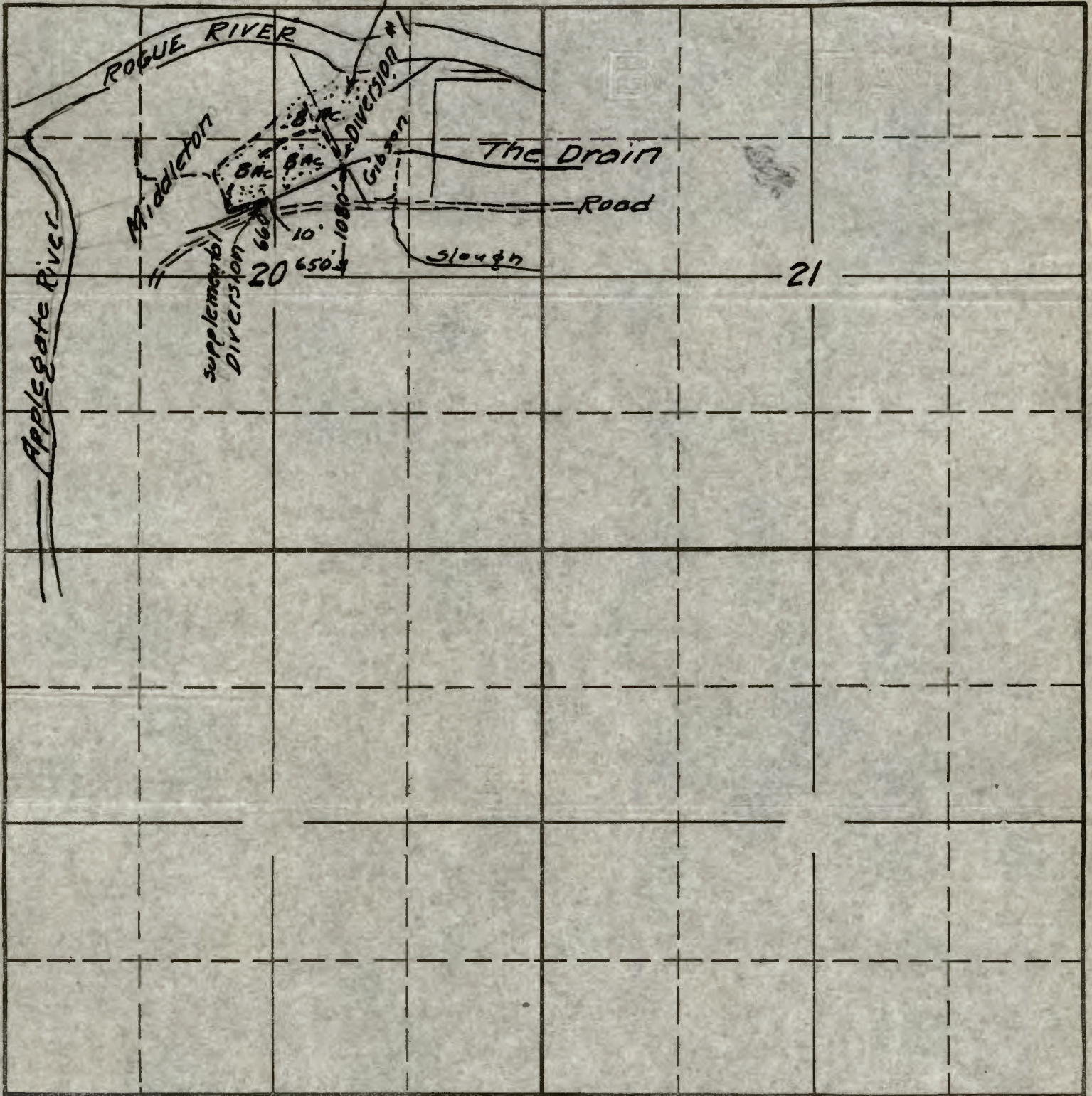

ABSTRACT OF CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT NO. 11167

Howard W. Pealer of Route 4, Box 366, Grants Pass, Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Engineer of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of the Drain a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 11261 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 15, 1934;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.3 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream,

or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$,
8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$,
8 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 20,
Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The right to the use of water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

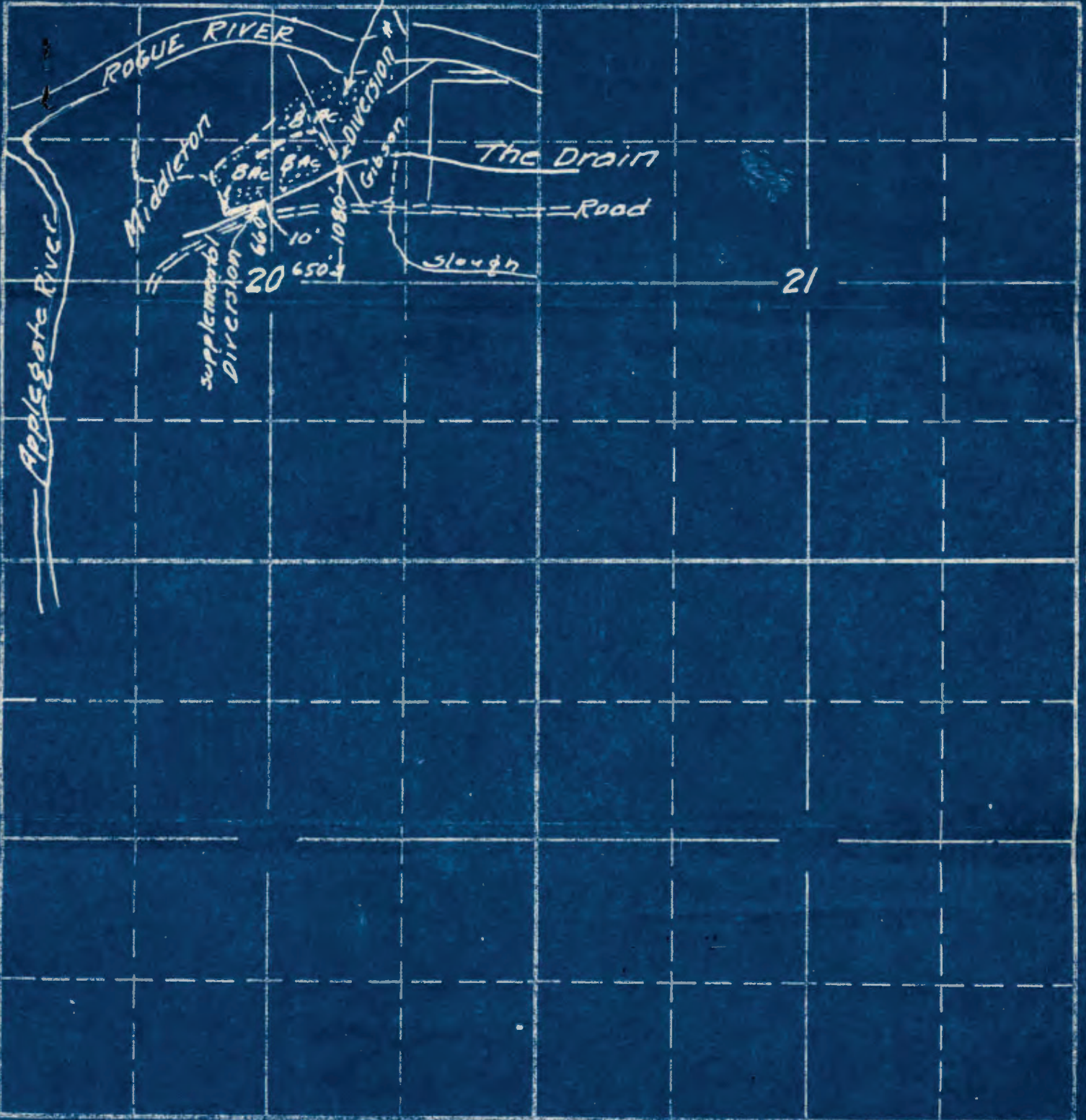
