This will acknowledge the receipt of your letter dated May 15, 1993 and the copies of your map and report in support of the surface water registration statement in the name of Howard & Lillian Winkelman. I am sending you all of the information in regards to the requirements for the map. This includes the following: ORS Chapter 539, OAR Division 28, a portion of OAR Division 14 covering map requirements, the checklist we use to review maps and the claim of beneficial use report information.

I am obligated to review the files, to include the maps, in chronological order. A quick look at your map and report indicates you have used the checklist and beneficial use report. If that's the case, you shouldn't have any problems with the acceptance of this map.

You asked the question in regards to stock drinking directly from a surface water source and what if any water right is required. The Water Resources Department (WRD) will file a claim to a pre-1909 water use for stock direct from a surface water source and then present the claim to the Circuit Court for a water right decree. The WRD will not accept an application for a surface water permit for stock water direct.







INFORMATION: Mr. and Mrs. Howard Winkelman are the owners and operators of the ranch herein described. They do not live on the property. Their address is HC 85, Box 65E, Myrtle Point, OR. 97458. Their telephone No. is 572-5939. Their live-stock have watered directly from the creek for many years. Now they want to stop the riparian watering and pump water to two watering troughs so as to improve the water quality for down stream users and for more efficient use of the land.

SOURCE: Coal Creek is a tributary of Myrtle Creek which is a tributary of Middle Fork of Coquille River.

DIVERSION POINT: Electric power is available at the P.O.D. No other development had been done on the date of my inspection, May 12, 1993.

MOTOR AND PUMP: Mr. Winkelman will use a 3/4 h. p. 3600 r.p.m. electric motor and pump combination.

PIPE: Approximately 1200 feet of 3/4" plastic pipe will be used.

USES: Stock watering only.

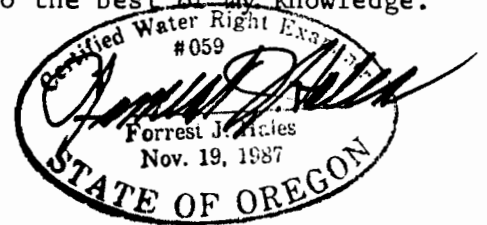
HEAD: The highest trough will be about 50 feet above the POD.

CALCULATIONS: A 3/4 h.p. motor will move about 10 gallons per minute or 0.02 CFS.

P. O. B.: The center 1/4 monument was set recently by the Cadastral Surveyors, it is a bronze cap on a 2" pipe post. I used a staff compass and steel tape to measure to the POB.

REMARKS: None.

This final proof survey and inspection of the use as found to be completed under the terms and conditions of the Pre-1909 Water Registration Act was completed by me on May 12, 1993, and the facts contained by me in this report and accompanying Pre-1909 Surface Water Registration Map are correct to the best of my knowledge.

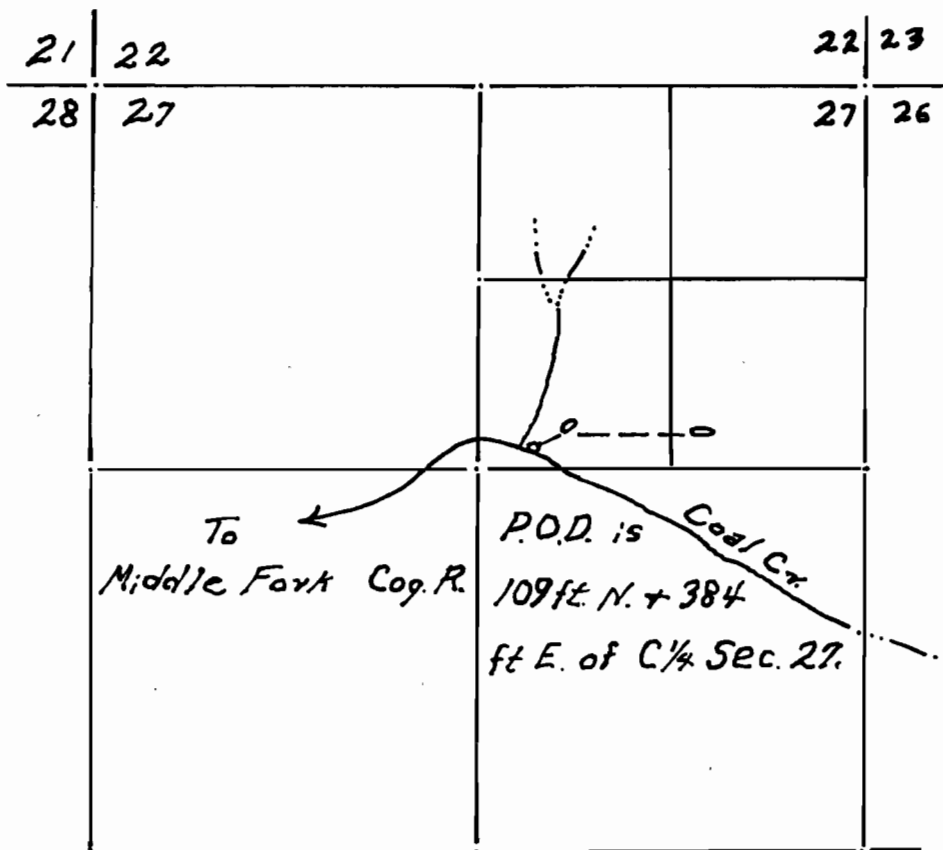

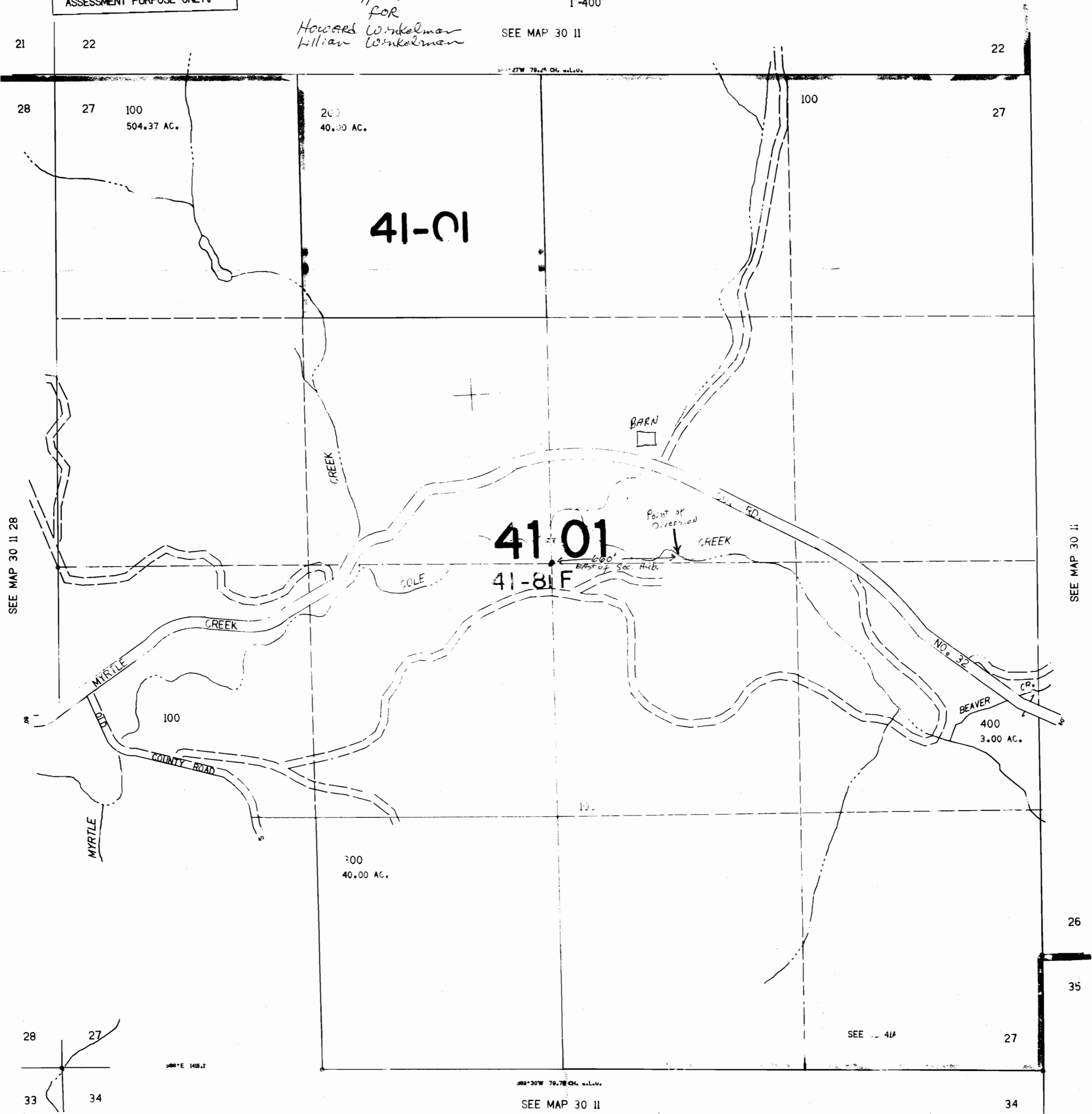

The Everendens had livestock on the property continuously until the subject property was purchased by my brother Elvin Waterman and his wife Amanda in the year 1945.

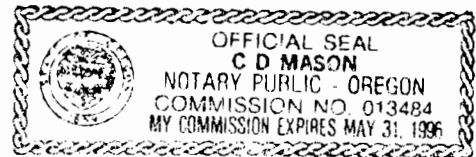

Wright according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts Supplemental thereto, for the South west Quarter of the North east Quarter, the South east Quarter of the North west Quarter, the North east Quarter of the South west Quarter and the North west Quarter of the South east Quarter of section twenty seven, in Township thirty south of Base Elbow west of Willamette Meridian, in Oregon, containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Ernest J. Wright.

Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the promises and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Ernest J. Wright and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Ernest J. Wright and to his heirs and assigns forever, subject to any vested and several water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by Law. In Testimony Whereof, I, Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. 

