

to the best of my knowledge the Almasie family came in to this area in late July or August of 1893 by ox team and covered wagon. 4 Boys + 3 girls and Parents. When they got here they camped on a small stream off the road and wintered here while Grand Paw Almasie looked for home stead property and put up shelter. In the time they were here the stream became known as Almasie creek.

While they camped here they put up a shelter that later became a cabin of sorts that was used until the 1910 fire destroyed it. Then Joe Almasie aquired this property and built a one room cabin 16x20 which was later added to - to become a 5 room house which was replaced by a 7 room house in 1939+40. I have been on this property for 71+ years.

money to live on and improve with, about 3 weeks each year.  
Usually the whole family go to the hop fields and sometimes part  
remain on the land to care for things."

As told by Annie:

Our family came from Nebraska to Oregon in 1893. The parents  
could not speak English. We were a poor family and stopped  
now and then across the plains to work for awhile to get a  
grub stake to bring them on. They stopped in Eugene for a  
couple of days and then on to Lake Creek, coming over the  
Chickahominy Mt. They took up a Homestead in the canyon north  
of the now Bob Carr place. They would tend the homestead  
in the winter and go to the valley to work in the summer - even  
the women and children would go pick hops to help make a grubstake  
for the coming winter. Annie recalls that one summer she and  
her brother were left home to tend the homestead, garden and  
animals and lived all summer from the garden and wild berries  
and such. When the family came home in the fall and went to  
build a fire in the cook stove they found a rats nest for no  
fire had been built all summer.

Mike and Mike Jr. helped to out a pack trail up to the Upper  
Lake Creek valley to get to Slayters store as there was no  
road between the Upper and Lower Valley at first.

 Nora Wilcut, Ira Brown, Mike Almasi & Mabel Pepiot went to Eugene in a buggy headed for the county clerks office. Mabel is a womanly little body, warm hearted and unselfish and full of human kindness. Mike has drawn a real prize.  
 Fred Pepiot went to the McKenzie and drove back a band of cattle belonging to Mabel. Mike is bargaining for the Seth Rowe place. (How wonderfully they started out, only to end up in divorce 7 yrs. later)

## The Big 1910 Fire

In 1910, fire raged over many miles of the valley and mountains, destroying thousands of acres of timber. Settlers saved themselves by lying in the creek and throwing water on each other. Some who tried to escape had their wagons and belongings burned in the road after the horses had been cut loose. It was reported that there was a demand for axle grease and tar at Slayter's store to relieve the burns of the animals that survived.

Item dated 25 Aug. 1910:  
Fire yesterday burned out Joe Almasi's dwelling on the Sam Brown place; burned several hundred thousand feet of logs for Ira Brown; the same for A.M. Almasi; burned everything George Graham and family had; destroyed the barn and contents belonging to Emery Seales; burned the barn and contents for Frank Parker, including a days threshing of wheat and oats, also destroying the buildings on the old Pepiot place belonging to Mr. Parker; burned the house belonging to Andy Almasi on the old Fred Rowe place; burned every building Alex Power had; burned over a mile of fence for Marion Wheeler and it would have taken everything if they had not backfired and worked all afternoon and all night like slaves, as everybody else did that saved anything. Little Mabel Wheeler, 8 yrs. old, was set to watch the barn where several fires had been put out and nature got the best of her, she went to sleep and fell off the log she was sitting on and hurt herself, though not serious.

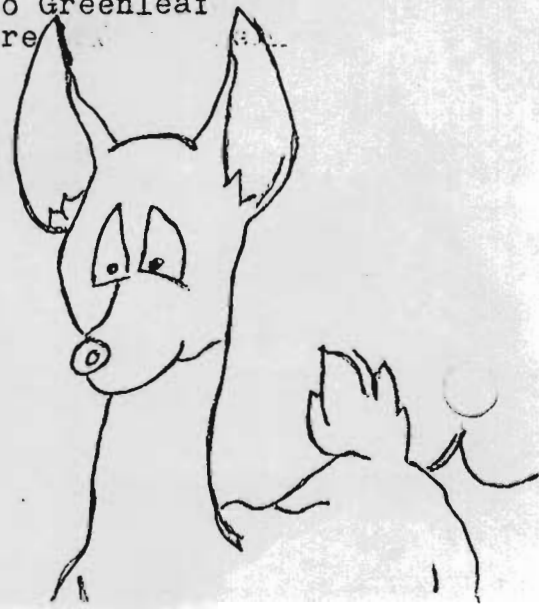
Don't believe there is a farm on Lake Creek but lost some or all of its fences. With the help of neighbors the buildings at O. Wilcuts were saved, but two stacks of grain ready for the threshers were destroyed. The old folks Almasi were burned out entirely, and I believe every building on Nelson Creek is gone. The Leaver family came down and took refuge with O. Wilcuts. Mr. Wilcut is absent having gone to Eugene for a load of supplies.

At 2 o'clock yesterday afternoon telephone communications were cut off from above and at 6 o'clock from below, leaving the post-office (Greenleaf) isolated. Marion (Wheeler) established connection with his nearest neighbor the first thing this morning, but that is as far as he can get by 2 o'clock today. The mail did not come down yesterday but this morning Cleve Rust took his life in his hands and got to Greenleaf with the mail. Trees are falling everywhere and one fell within 20 ft. of Cleve.

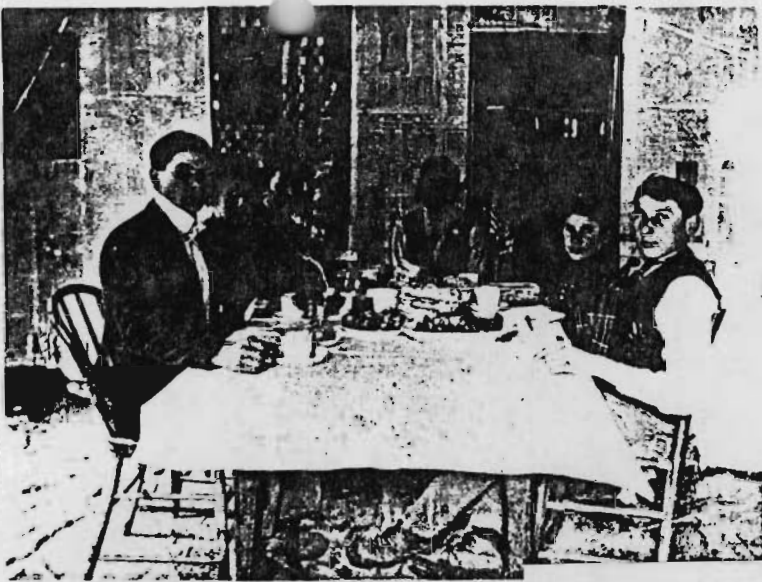
The latest news as supplied by Cleve-  
The butter wagon from Mapleton that was taking butter out to the valley was driven into the river (Lake Creek) in an effort to keep the butter cool. Ed Hunzicker was the driver.

Mike Almasi's cows got their bags so badly burned they cannot be milked.

The community threshing machine burned.

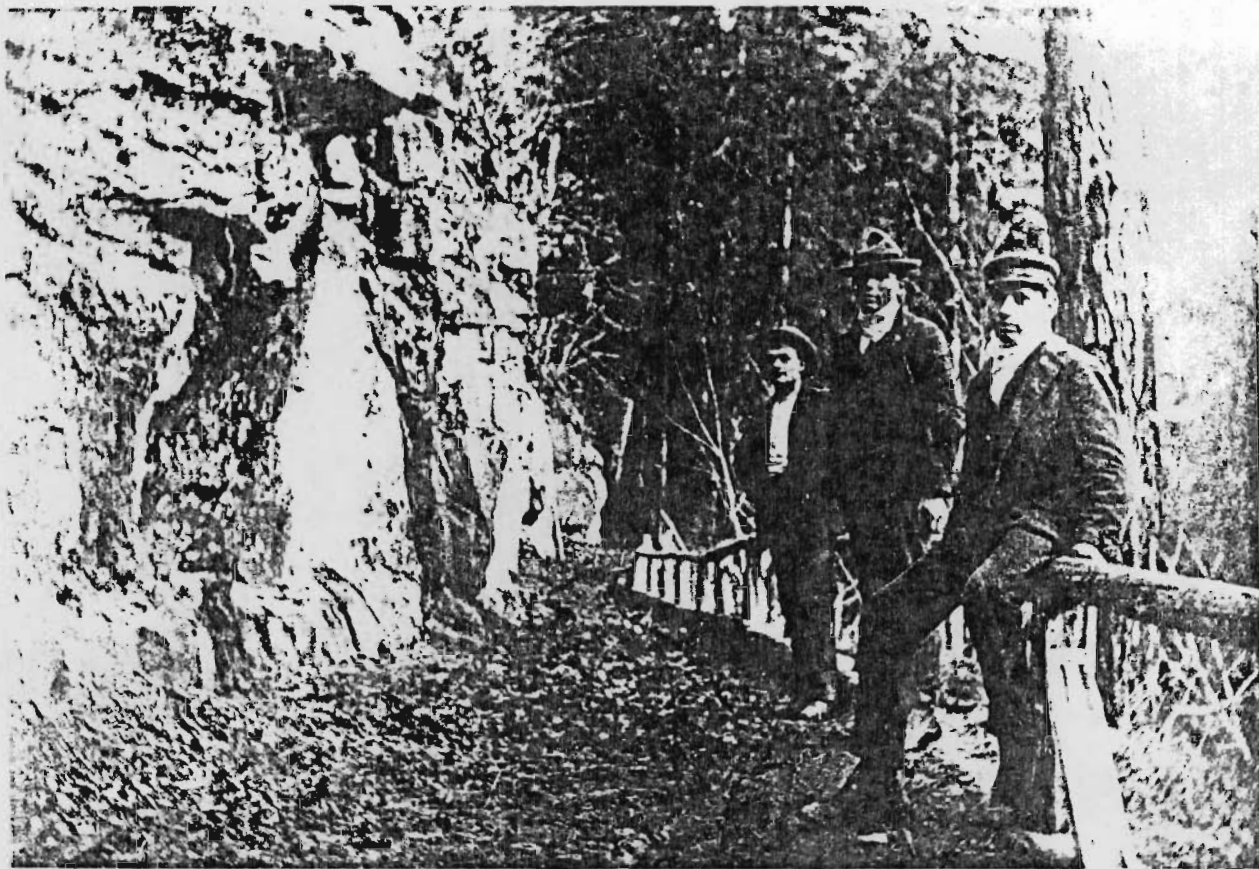

Item dated 23 July 1899:

Cape Jenny, the hair raising Cliff on Lake Creek road has had its terrors modified by placing a railing outside the road where there is a fine place for those wishing to commit suicide to jump 200 ft. to the rocks.

Item dated 14 Sept. 1920:

The Berkshire Bros. spent a day last week overhauling Cape Jenny, trying to get it so they could haul a load over it.

It wasn't until Highway #36 was put through the area that Cape Jenny was improved very much.

Item dated 22 May 1923:

The Rust Bros. took the contract to clear the highway from Blachly Corner to Spring Canyon and are working on it with horse drawn fresno scrapers and graders. (Spring Canyon was at the foot of the Cape Jenny grade.)

Item dated 24 Nov. 1923:

Cape Jenny is a thing of the past. In an endeavor to get enough road wide to get the steam shovel below, the rock at the upper side was loosened (by blasting) so it is dangerous to cross.

Item dated 3 Mar. 1924:

The steam shovel is expected to have the slide on Cape Jenny out soon. It has got nearly to Spring Canyon.


