

My name is Lewis Edwards. I was Born in Myrtle Point, Oregon on November 14, 1920. My grandparents Manuel Levi Edwards and Mary Edwards homesteaded on Langlois Mountain in the early 1900's. My Father ranched within a few miles of the Smith ranches (described as per attachments) for his whole adult life until his death in June 1973. Both my father and I worked for Harve Smith on the attached properties over a period of at least 10 years. Harves parents homesteaded part of the ranch and Harve purchased numerous homesteads to create the ranch (describes as per attachment). These lands were all being actively grazed from the time of the original homestead in the 1880s to this very day. I derived this from conversations with Harve who I new very well and from our conversations with my father and other neighbors and from my personal observations. I have lived within sight of the Smith ranches for most of my life, and can say with complete confidence that these lands were never unstocked. Sheep, cattle, horses and goats have continuously grazed these lands prior to 1900 and to the present day. I have personally observed these animals drinking from creeks, springs (both developed and undeveloped) , wells and from a variety of ponds scattered across these properties. Some of the ponds were naturally occurring and some where man made.

I currently live adjacent to these properties and have done so since 1949. I traverse these properties on an almost daily basis, so I can verify that these lands are still being actively grazed.

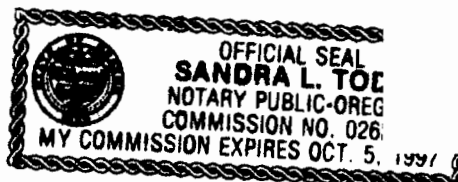


AFFIDAVIT OF WATER USE

I am John Guynup. I have owned the Bob Smith ranch (description attached) since 1976 and the Norman Smith ranch since 1985. I personally can attest to continuous grazing on both properties since 1976.

During this time I spoke extensively with Norman Smith and his cousins John and Lynn Bowan. I also had extended conversations with Everett and Howard Isenhardt as well as Raymond and Irwin Mcleod, all now deceased. Their lives spanned a time period from the early 1900s through 1993.

They lived and worked on and around the subject ranches and from these conversations I am absolutely certain that the subject property was continuously grazed from the late 1800s to present.

I researched the county records and found tax records that showed that substantial livestock numbers were always in place on these properties with no break in the chain. I was also able to ascertain that these ranches have always had higher stocking rates than that of adjoining properties because they have had more grasslands and therefore used more livestock water.



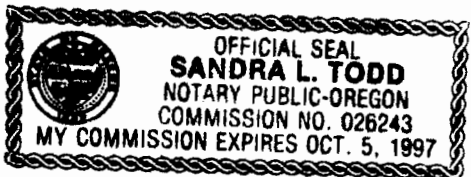

AFFIDAVIT OF WATER USE

June Edwards is my name. I was born June 1, 1929 on the ranch adjacent to the subject property. My grandfather, Frank Henry Strain bought 400 acres on Langlois Mountain in the late 1800s. My parents William and Artie Bell moved to the mountain in approximately 1913.

I have spent my entire life living in the hills around the H. B. Smith ranches later known as the Norman Smith Ranch and the Bob Smith Ranch (as attached).

These ranches have always been recognized as grassland ranches rather than timber ranches and H B Smith was an aggressive grazer and his practices were a topic of discussion. So it is clear to me from family discussions that these ranches have been continuously grazed from the time they were homesteaded. Grazing was the only means of support on these lands that had considerable natural prairies and a wide variety of water sources such as, wells, creeks, springs, ponds. I have personally observed my entire life, (on a daily basis) continuous grazing up to the date of this affidavit.

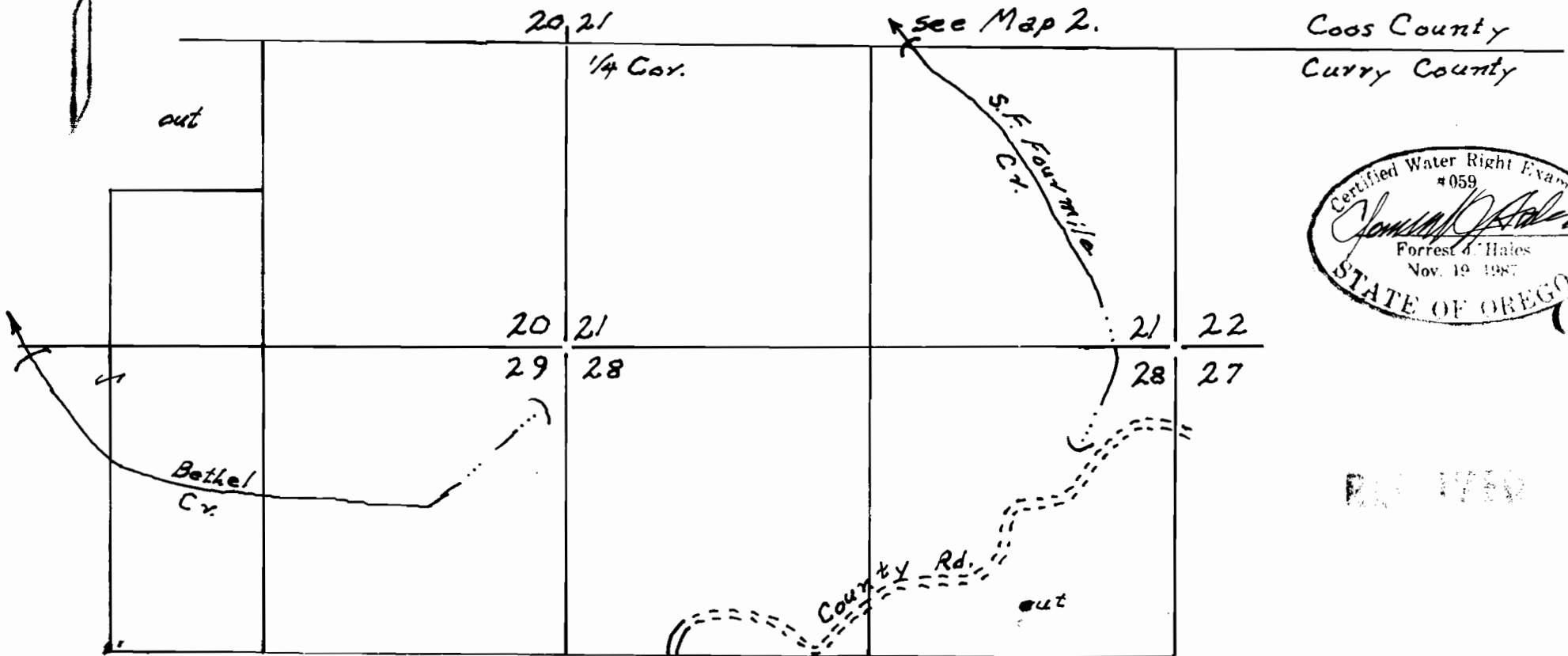

My name is Elnore Elliott, I was born in Bandon on June 12, 1913. My grandparents Nathaniel R. Smith and Eliza Smith settled and filed for a homestead on a portion of the attached property in the 1880's. In fact they are buried in a family cemetery on this very property. My Uncle H.B. Smith took over operation and ownership from my grandparents and other family members. His ownership passed to Norman R. Smith and Robert Smith. Norman's interest was passed to me upon his death and I sold this 1.49 acres, more or less, to John Guynup et al in 1985. John had already acquired the Robert Smith property in 1976.

My mother was H.B. (Harve) Smith's sister. We lived in Bandon and visited the ranch (as per attached description) regularly. I helped gather cattle and sheep on all portions of the ranch and spent considerable time with my uncle. In conversation with Uncle Harve and with my mother (Frances Elliott) there is no doubt that these lands were grazed annually without interruption from the early 1880's to the present. I am 80 years old and have visited the ranch regularly with protracted stays in my childhood and young adulthood and lived on the ranch from 1982 to 1985. So I can personally attest to having seen 70 years plus of continual use. My Grandparents and Uncle made their living grazing sheep and cattle and owned no other lands and had no other way to make a living. This supports my contention that these lands supported livestock with grass and water every year since the Smiths settled here in the 1880's.

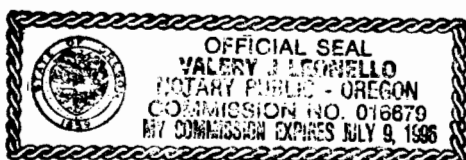

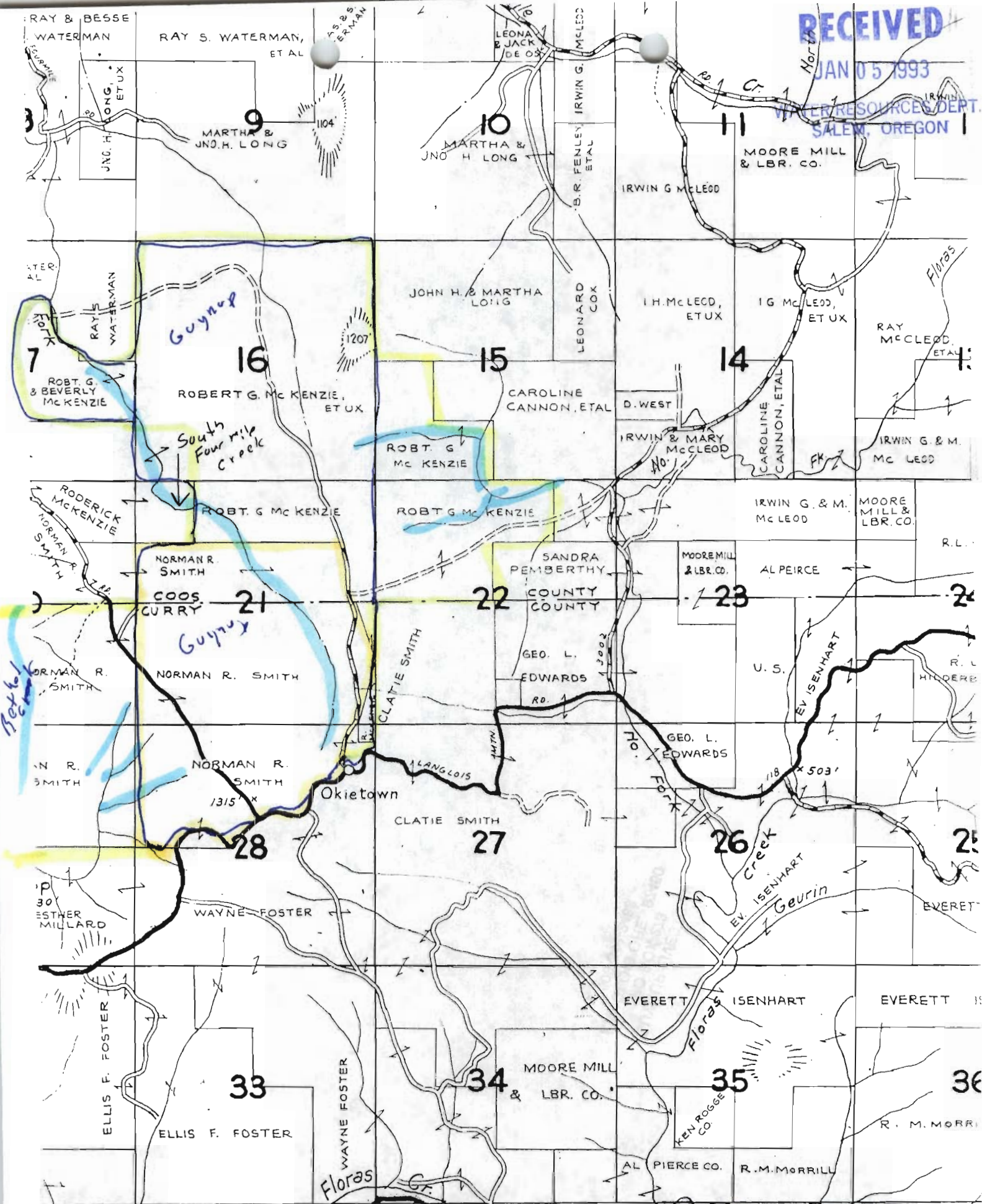


