Gentlemen:

According to the terms of your permit No. G-3826, for the appropriation of 0.60 cubic foot of water per second from a well for the irrigation of 112.0 acres, complete application of water was to have been made by October 1, 1970.

Complete application of water means the application of water to beneficial use under the permit to the full extent intended. In the case of irrigation, it means beneficial irrigation of all the lands the permittee intends to cover under the terms of the permit. If water has been used, you should promptly submit notice describing the extent of completion as set forth in the letter accompanying your permit and also in our postal card of November 6, 1970.

ORS 537.260 provides that: "Whenever the time within which any appropriation under a permit should have been perfected has expired and the owner of the permit fails or refuses within three months thereafter to submit to the State Engineer proof of completion of the appropriation as required by ORS 537.230 and 537.250, the State Engineer may, after 60 days' notice by registered mail, order the cancelation of the permit.\*\*\*\*\*"

In accordance with the provisions of ORS 537.260, you are hereby notified that unless proof of beneficial use is received within 60 days from the date of this letter, the permit(s) may be canceled without further notice.

If for any reason you are no longer interested in the project described by the permit, we would appreciate it if you would so advise. If the property involved has changed hands and any part of the project has been completed, you should immediately assign the permit to the new owner and advise us of his name and address. An assignment form will be furnished upon request.



Item No. 4 on the application indicates the well is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 1. The map shows the well located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 1. The distance from the center of Section 1 to the well must be shown on the map as it is described in item No. 4 on the application.

This will acknowledge receipt of your returned application No. G-3865, a transparency map and the additional fee of \$10.50 for which our receipt No. 3953 is enclosed.

The application map shows a total of 112 acres of irrigation. Item No. 12 on the application must describe the number of acres to be irrigated in each quarter-quarter section, as shown on the application map.

This application is to appropriate from one well. Item No. 4 describes the location of this well as being 300 feet North and 800 feet East from the center of Section 1. This apparently is the well located between the two ponds, shown on the map. A second well is also located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 1. Do you also intend to appropriate water from the two ponds, and the second well shown on the map?

This will acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to appropriate 270 gallons of water per minute from a well for the irrigation of 100 acres, a print of a map, and the fee of \$25.50 for which our receipt No. 3093 is enclosed. This application has been filed and numbered G-3865.

Due to a recent change in the fees by legislature, this application requires an additional \$5 recording fee.

A map in the form of a transparency so that it may be easily reproduced is required. It must be to a scale of not less than four inches equal to the mile. The map must show the location of the point of diversion in reference to a government survey corner and correspond to item No. 4 on the application. The map must also show the number of acres to be irrigated in each quarter-quarter section and correspond to item No. 12 on the application.

A legal description of the property upon which the water will be used must accompany the application. This can be copied from your deed, title insurance policy, or sales contract.

I am returning your application and the print for completion. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its date of priority, it must be returned on or before June 19, 1967.

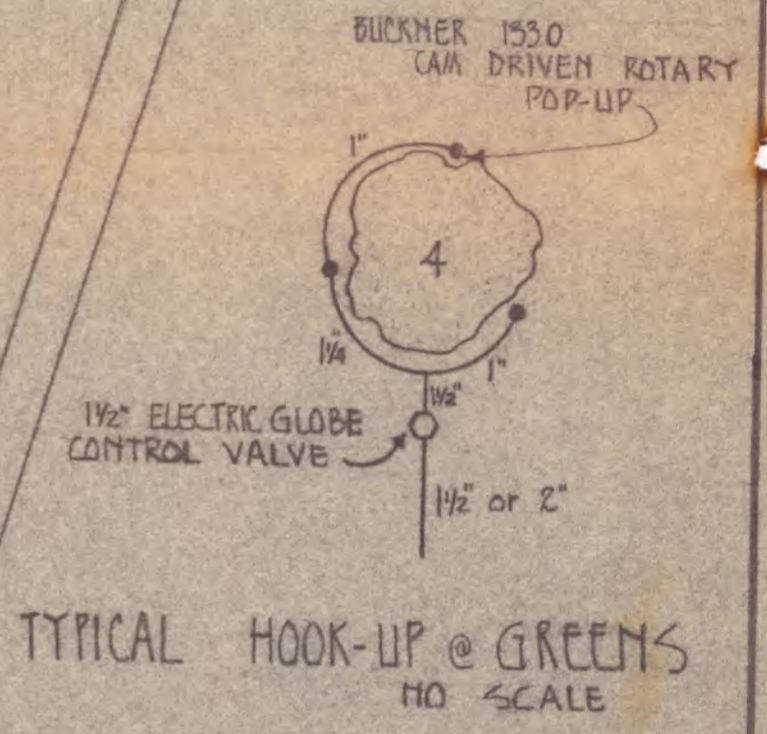
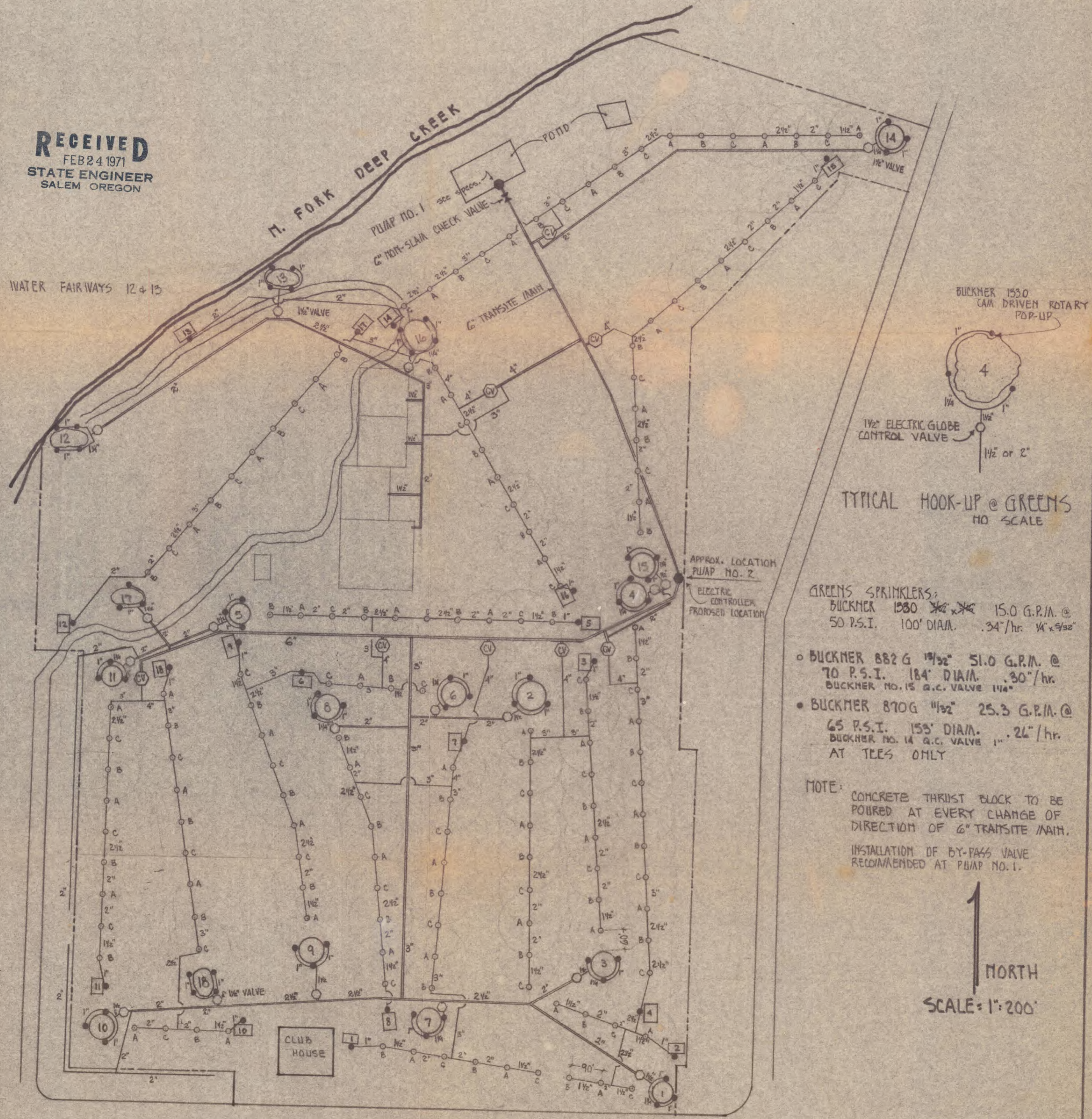

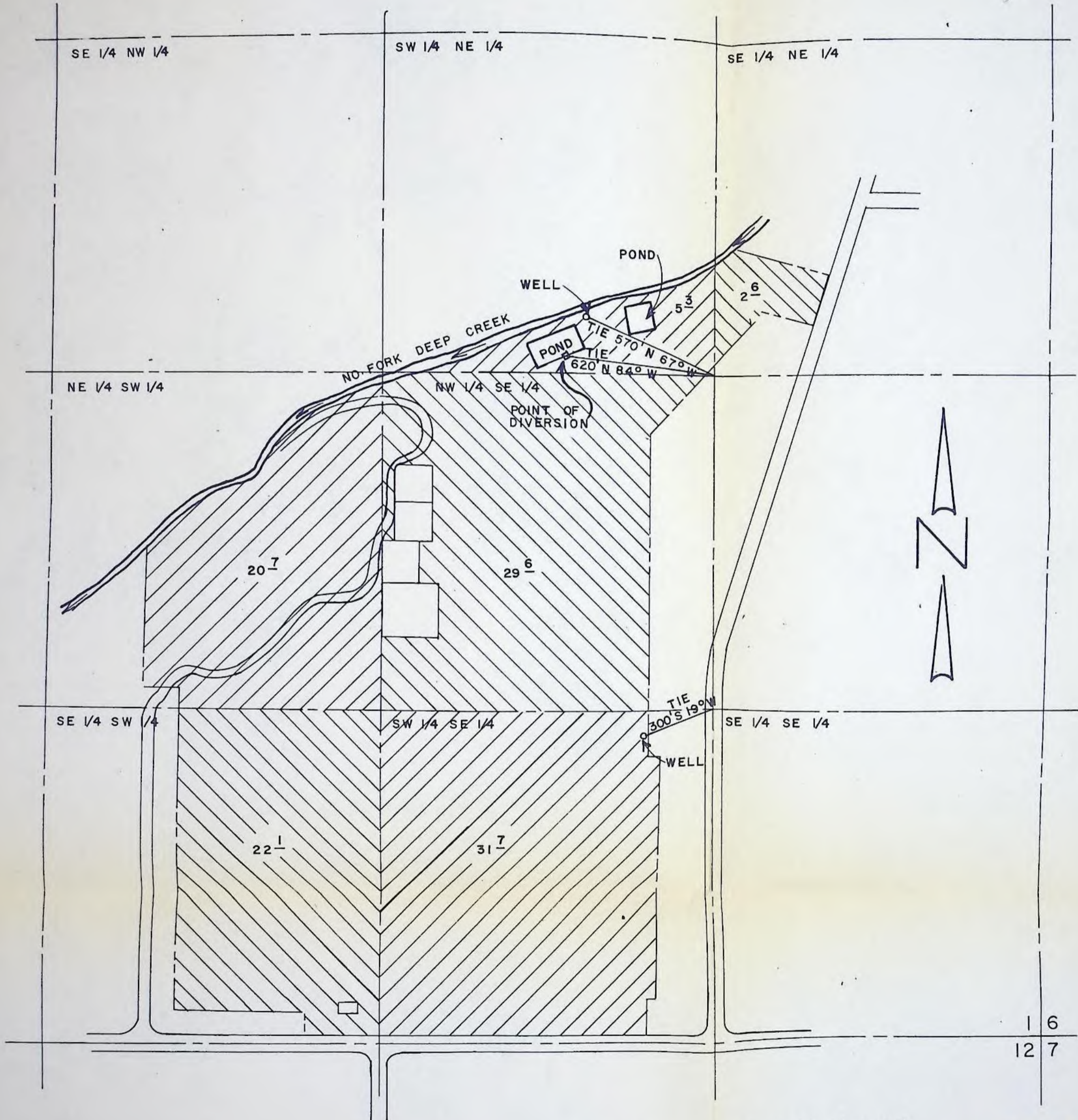
