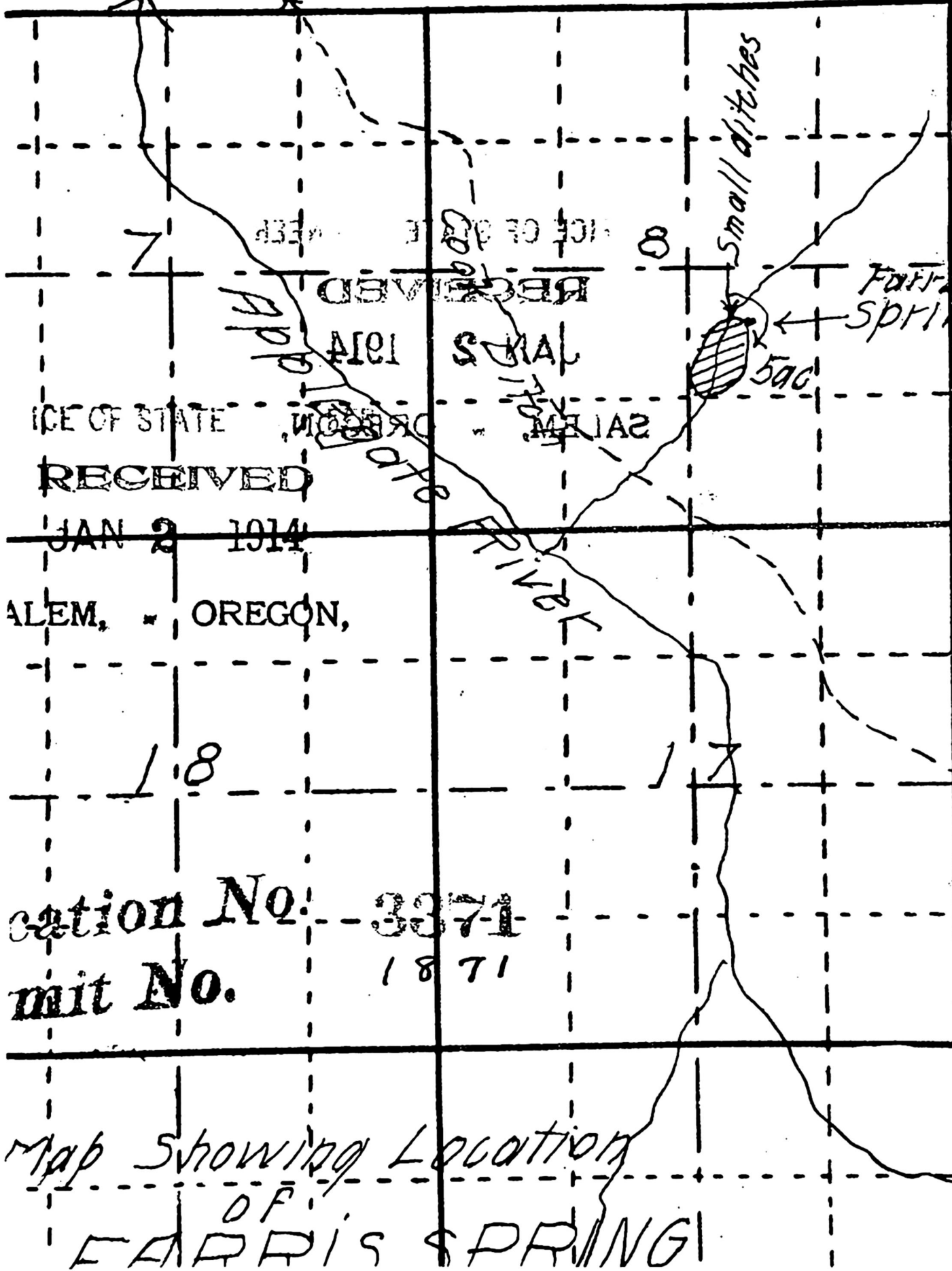

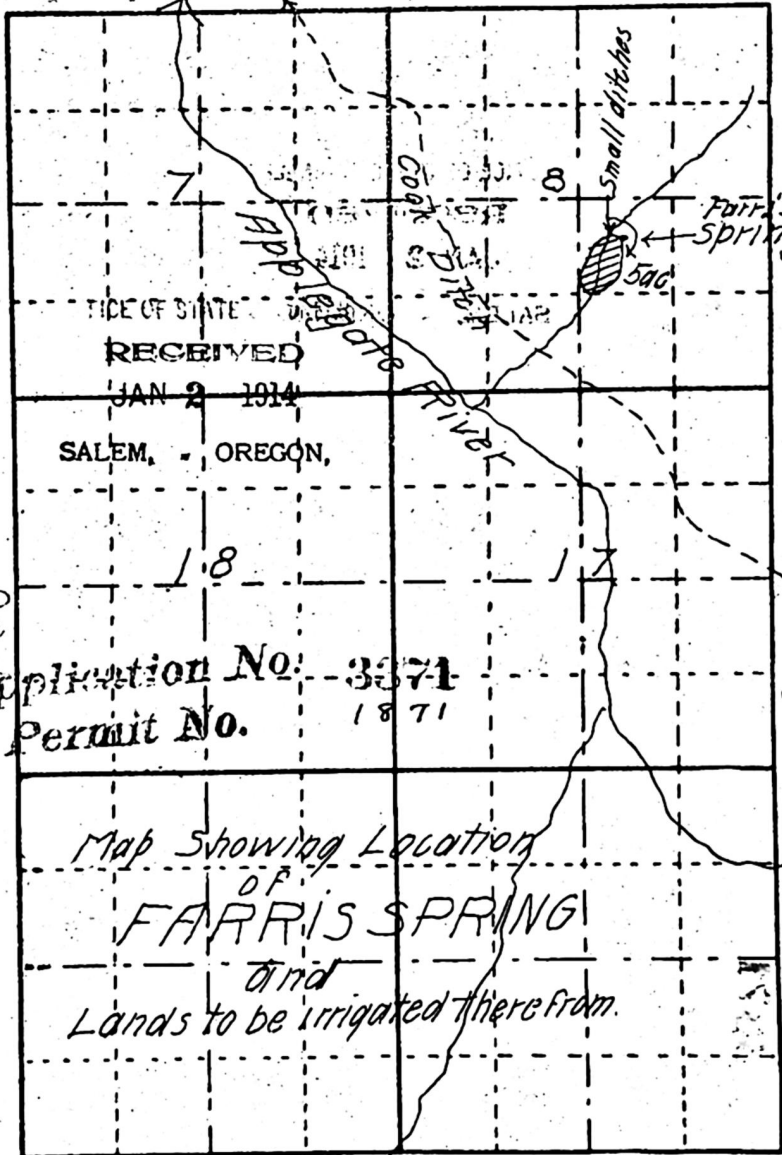

(For Rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That DAISY V. LEWMAN of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Ferris Spring, a tributary of Applegate River and domestic use.

under Permit No.—1871 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the ~~State~~ Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 208, on the 12th day of April, 19 16 that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 2, 19 14; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic ~~foot~~ per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

1 acre in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Eight (8), Township Thirty-eight (38) South, Range Four (4) West of Willamette Meridian, in Josephine County, Oregon.

The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated; or its equivalent in case of rotation; balance for domestic use. The use for irrigation purposes shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.

Note:

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits)

This is to Certify, That DAISY V. LEWMAN

of Murphy, State of Oregon 97533, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Farris Spring, a tributary of Applegate River

and domestic use for the purpose of the irrigation of 1 acre of land, under Permit No. 1871 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1

at page 208, on the 12th day of April, 1916; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 2, 1914; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: One acre in the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section Eight (8), Township Thirty-eight (38) South, Range Four (4) West of Willamette Meridian, in Jackson County, Oregon. The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated, or its equivalent in case of rotation; balance for domestic use. The use for irrigation purposes shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State officer.

(NOTE: This certificate is issued to amend that certain certificate issued to Daisy V. Lewman on the 22nd day of May, 1916, and recorded in Volume 2 at page 1063 of State Record of Water Right Certificates and in Volume 1 at page 38 of Record of Water Right Certificates of Josephine County, Oregon, the right covered by said former certificate being erroneously described as being in Josephine County, Oregon, whereas the same is in fact situate in Jackson County, Oregon) The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.



Gentlemen:

I enclose herewith Certificate of Water Right issued to Daisy Lewman on May 22, 1916, under Permit no. 1871. This certificate is erroneous in that it describes the lands irrigated as being situate in Josephine County, when as a matter of fact, these lands are situate in Jackson County, Oregon, and the Certificate should be recorded in that County. I assume that the proper procedure would be to issue a new Water Right Certificate in lieu of the one enclosed describing the lands as in Jackson County. The preceding Water Right Certificate can then be marked cancelled and reference made on the margin of the book to the page on which the new certificate appears of record in your office. If you will therefore kindly issue the Certificate as requested we will attend to the recording of it in Jackson County, or forward the necessary recording fees to you if you so desire.

Dear Madam:

In reply to your letter of the 17th instant in regard to water right certificate No. 1063 that was issued covering your water right under application No. 3371, permit No. 1871, you are advised that the final proof as submitted and sworn to by Daisy V. Lewman plainly stated that but "One acre" had been irrigated under this permit. The final proof blanks as made out in this office stated that the permit called for the irrigation of 5 acres in the NW SE Sec. 8, T. 38 S. R. 4 W., and in the column showing the number of acres actually irrigated appear the words, "One acre".

In view of the circumstances I would suggest that you make a new application covering the four acres that was omitted from your final proof and I am enclosing application blanks and copy of instructions.

I am very sorry the error occurred but can see no way to remedy the same except by the filing of a new application. However, if you do not wish to do this you may take the matter up with the Board at its next meeting the third Wednesday in November by filing proper affidavits.
