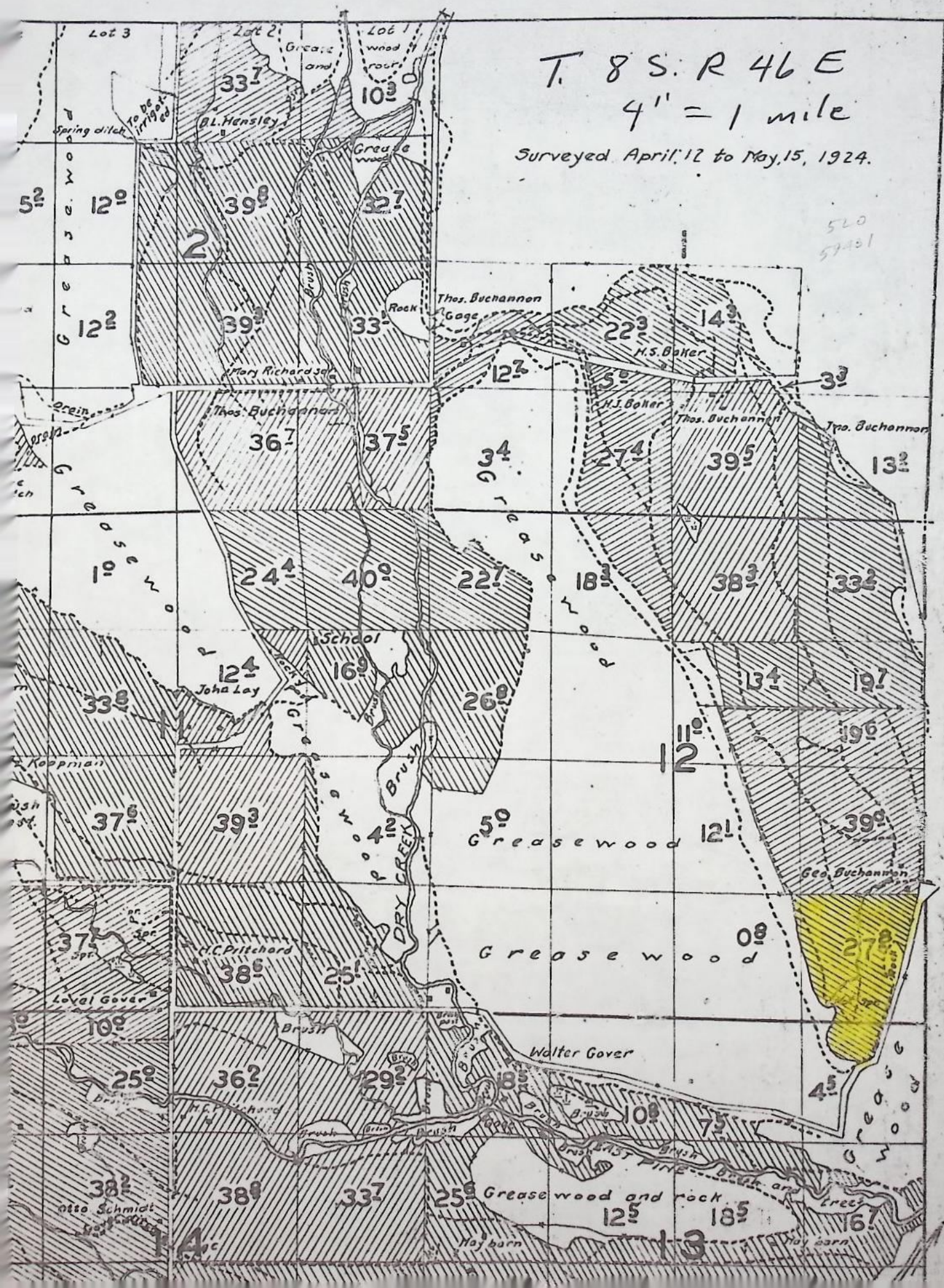

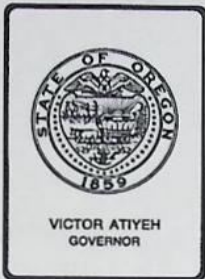

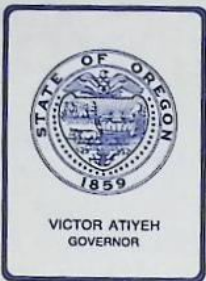

This is to acknowledge Application 60088 and supporting map you resubmitted for Ralph E. Garvin. The prints of two aerial photographs and your letter explaining about the drainage channel were also received. The application has been reinstated and given a new date of priority of September 13, 1983, and now describes the proposed use of 0.85 cubic foot per second of water from an unnamed natural drainage way, being 0.75 cfs for the irrigation of 27.8 acres and 0.1 cfs for stock water (20 to 30 head of cattle).

If, as discussed in our recent telephone discussion, the natural channel of the drainage way flows in a southerly direction on the property north of Mr. Garvin's property and prior to reaching Mr. Garvin's property the channel turns east and eventually flows into Pine Creek, the supporting map will need to properly identify and locate the channel of the unnamed natural drainage way, show the point where water will be diverted from the channel along with noting the distances from a reference corner to the point of diversion. The ditch to be used for carrying the water to the stock watering facility and pumping sump will also need to be properly identified and illustrated on the map.

We still need the \$15 recording fee for the stock use.

The issuance of a permit approving the application shall not be construed in any sense as granting a right of access to the drainageway. All rights of access and/or right-of-way must be obtained from the owner of the property.

I am returning the application and map to you for correction and completion. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its priority date it must be received in this office on or before November 28, 1983.

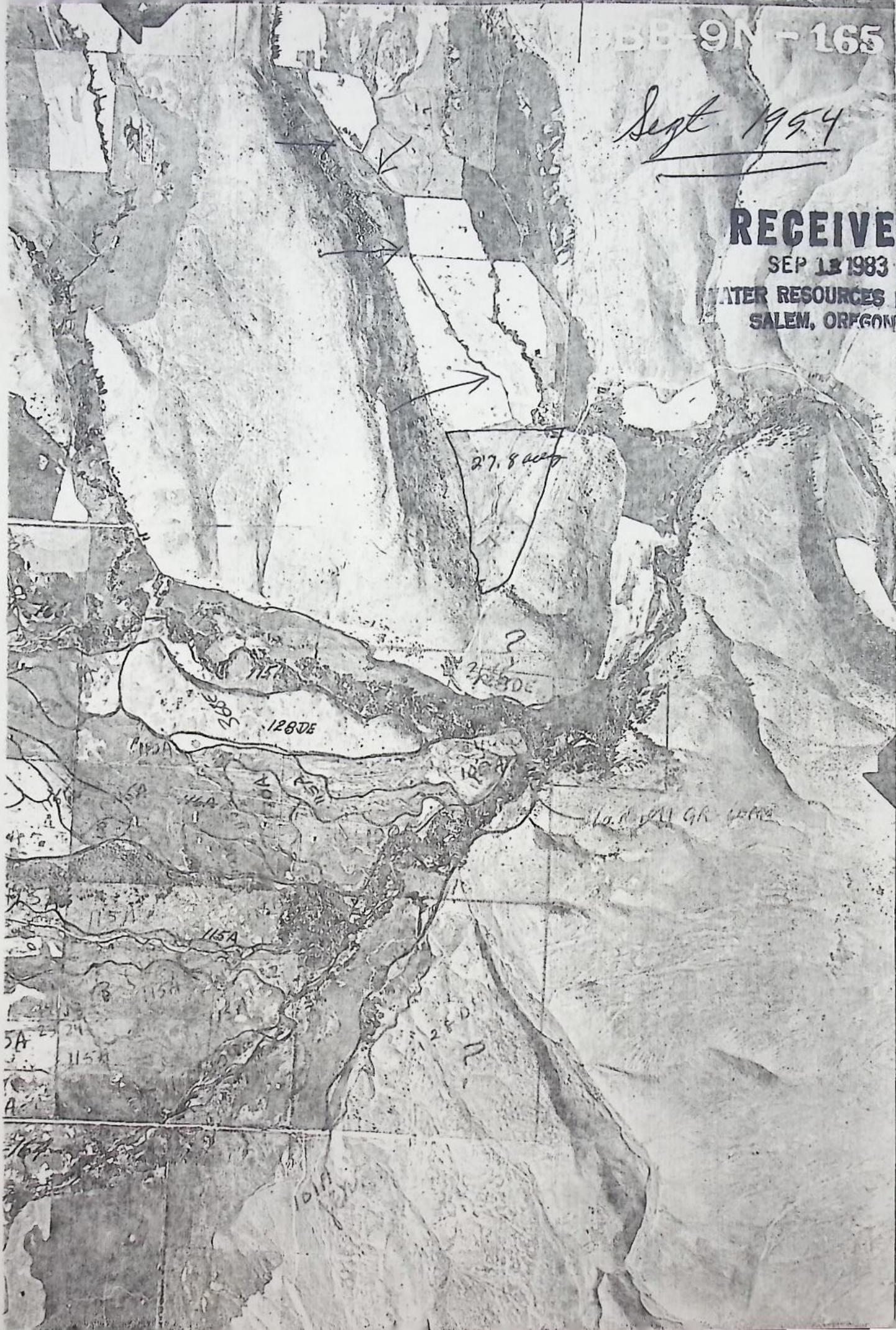

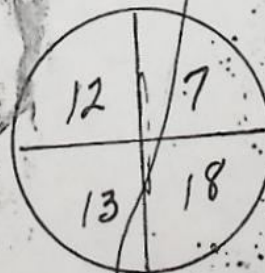

Based on an inspection made by our representative in your area of your proposed project as described in your Application 60088, the source could not be considered an unnamed draw, but could be considered a drainage ditch which collects waste and seepage water. I again apologize for the delay in responding to the return of your Application 60088 and supporting map.

According to the information supplied in Item 6 and according to the information supplied on your supporting map, you do not intend to divert water from the stream channel for stock watering, but that the stock will drink directly from the stream or the pumping sump which, according to your map, is in the stream channel. If so, a water right could not be perfected for stock uses and the request for a permit for water for stock should be deleted from your application. As mentioned in my earlier correspondence, in order to perfect a water right for stock use, it is necessary to make a physical diversion of water from a stream in a measurable amount.

If you should decide to divert water from the stream channel and convey the water by means of a ditch or pipeline, you may leave the request for stock water on the application, but you will need to show the stock watering facility on the map and explain in Item 6 how the water is conveyed from the stream to the stock watering facility. We will also need the \$15.00 permit recording fee for the stock watering.

We will also need information on the origin of the water you wish to appropriate. By copy of this letter I am asking V. Kent Searles, the Watermaster for your area, to investigate your proposed project and submit a report on his findings. Upon receipt of his report we can advise you of any matters that may need your attention. A copy of your application and supporting map are being sent to Mr. Searles.

So that you may again review your application, I am returning it and the map for correction and completion. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its priority date it must be received in this office on or before July 7, 1983.

This is to acknowledge your amended Application 60088 and supporting map. Your application now describes the proposed use of 0.85 cubic foot per second of water from an unnamed draw, being 0.75 cfs for the supplemental irrigation of 27.8 acres and 0.1 cfs for stock watering.

In order to perfect a water right for stock use, it is necessary to make a physical diversion of water from a stream in a measurable amount. If the use is only within the stream channel at the pumping sump, no right can be perfected. Therefore, if this is the case, the stock use should be deleted from the items of your application. If you intend to divert the water from the stream to some stock watering facility, the location of this stock watering facility needs to be clearly illustrated on your supporting map. We will also need to know the approximate number and type of stock to utilize the facility in order to justify the amount of water to be allowed.

You may also wish to review the area to be irrigated. The cross-hachured area on your supporting map only represents about 21 or 22 acres instead of the 27.8 acres noted.

I am returning your application and map for completion. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its priority date it must be received in this office on or before April 5, 1983.

Your Application 60088 received in April of 1980 describing the proposed use of 0.75 cubic foot of water per second for the irrigation of 30.0 acres and 0.25 cfs for stock watering, together with the supporting map, has been reviewed.

I apologize for the long delay in the processing of your application. We will need additional information on your source and uses of water before the application can be considered for approval.

If you intend to appropriate wastewater carried through an existing ditch or canal not owned wholly by you, it will be necessary for you to submit an agreement between you and the other owners of the ditch authorizing its use to carry the wastewater.

I am not sure from examining your application and map as to whether your source of water is wastewater or merely water from a drainage ditch. If it is intended to appropriate wastewater, it will be necessary for you to identify the area from which the wastewater originates and how it will be physically gathered, controlled, and conveyed to the lands to be irrigated.

There is an existing water right of record appurtenant to most of the land illustrated on your supporting map described by Certificate 7058. Certificate 7058 describes a right of record which provides for the use of water from Lake Fork of North Pine Creek and is still valid providing it has not been lost through intentional abandonment or nonuse for any five successive years. If any portion of any right is not used for any period of five successive years, that portion would be forfeited. If the existing right is still valid and you wish to retain it, it will be necessary for you to advise us of how you intend to utilize water from the drain in relationship to the use of water allowed under the existing right.
