Water Resources: The water right application file # 59689 in the name of Willamina Lumber Company proposes to appropriate water from Willamina Creek for manufacturing (0.40 C.F.S.) and maintenance of fire protection equipment (0.01 C.F.S.). According to Ralph Jackson, Supervisor of applications and permits, there is a need of further clarification from Willamina Lumber Company on the amount of water needed for manufacturing. The amount of water needs to be justified depending on the extent of use in the manufacturing process. It may be possible that this amount of water cannot be justified, but on the otherhand it could be possible that this amount of water could be increased if there is justification for this. The point of diversion is located 988' South and 1,252' East from the Northwest corner of section 1 T.6S., R.7W.W.M. being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1 T.6S., R.7W.W.M. The average flow for Willamina Creek at U.S.G.S. Gage 14-1930 located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 13 T.5S., R.7W.W.M. river mile 6.2, for the months of July, August and September are 29.45 C.F.S., 20.5 C.F.S., and 105.8 C.F.S. respectively. This information was obtained from the U.S.G.S. publication of Water Data for the water years 1977 and 1978. There are three named creeks that flow into Willamina Creek below U.S.G.S. Gage 14-1930 and they are Wilson, Tindle and Ash Point Creek. The flows from these three creeks would not be monitored by the U.S.G.S. Gaging Station as their confluence is downstream from the station. The amount of water required to fullfill the water rights the full length of Willamina Creek is 25 C.F.S. There are several large appropriations of water for Municipal use. The City Of Sheridan has a water right for 8.0 C.F.S. and the City Of Willamina has several water rights totaling 2.80 C.F.S.

Minimum Flow Policy: There is a Minimum Flow on Willamina Creek and its tributaries for 20.0 C.F.S. located at U.S.G.S. Gage 14-1930 in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 13 T.6S., R.7 W.W.M. river mile 6.2. There is also a minimum flow on the South Yamhill River and its tributaries for 15 C.F.S. located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5 T.5S., R.4W.W.M. near Whiteson, Oregon. The Yamhill River and its tributaries has a minimum flow of 15 C.F.S. located in Section 7 T.4S., R.3W.W.M.

at Lafayette, Oregon. Willamina Creek is a tributary of the South Yamhill River and the South Yamhill River is a tributary of the Yamhill River. If the flow of water drops below the minimum flow specified, water rights will be shut off upstream from the point specified starting with the most recent water right filed.

Conclusion: If a permit is issued to application # 59689 it will be subject to the minimum flow policy as well all prior water rights.
