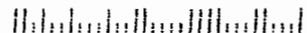

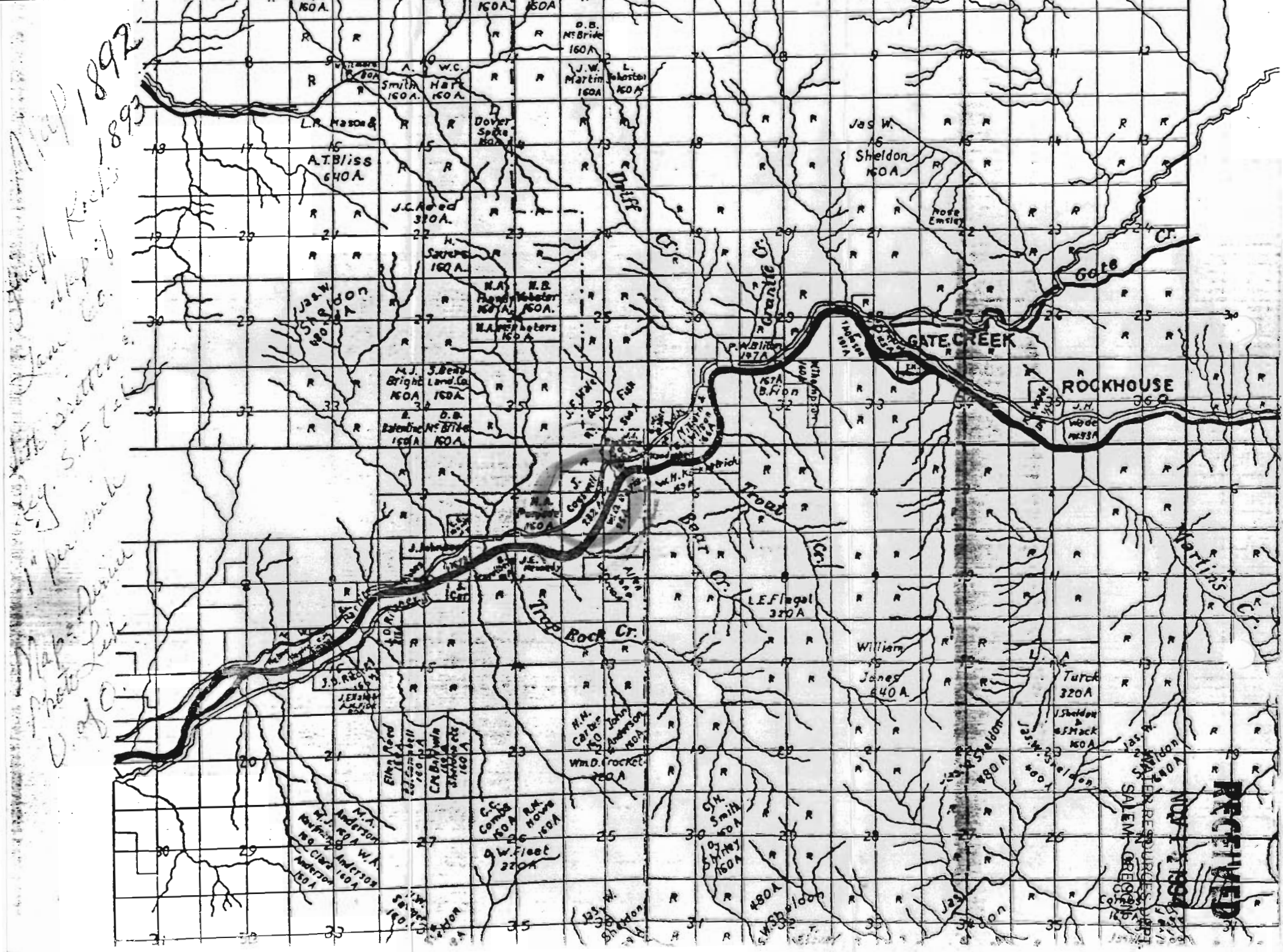
Please send a confirmation that we indeed do have water rights granted to us for our personal file.

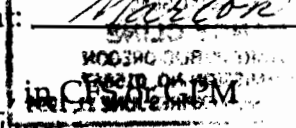

In response to your letters dated April 12, 1994. This one letter will address the questions you have on all three of the SWR's noted above. I will also enclose two copies of this letter for your records on the other two SWR's.

The pipe size from the diversion point to the end of the delivery system is a 6" diameter plastic pipe. The diversion point system is a valve at the toe of the slope of the Eugene Water and Electric Board (EWEB), canal. When the canal was built Cogswell creek was the source of water for those properties these water rights are addressing. The canal construction diverted Cogswell creek into the canal. EWEB installed a valve system to divert water from the canal to the properties formerly using Cogswell creek for their supply of water. The Valve size is a 10" diameter valve and pipe from the canal leading into said 6" diameter pipe leading to said properties.

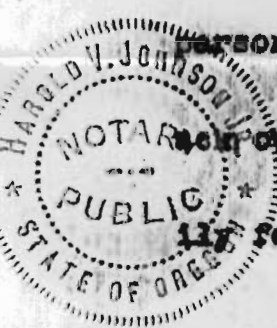

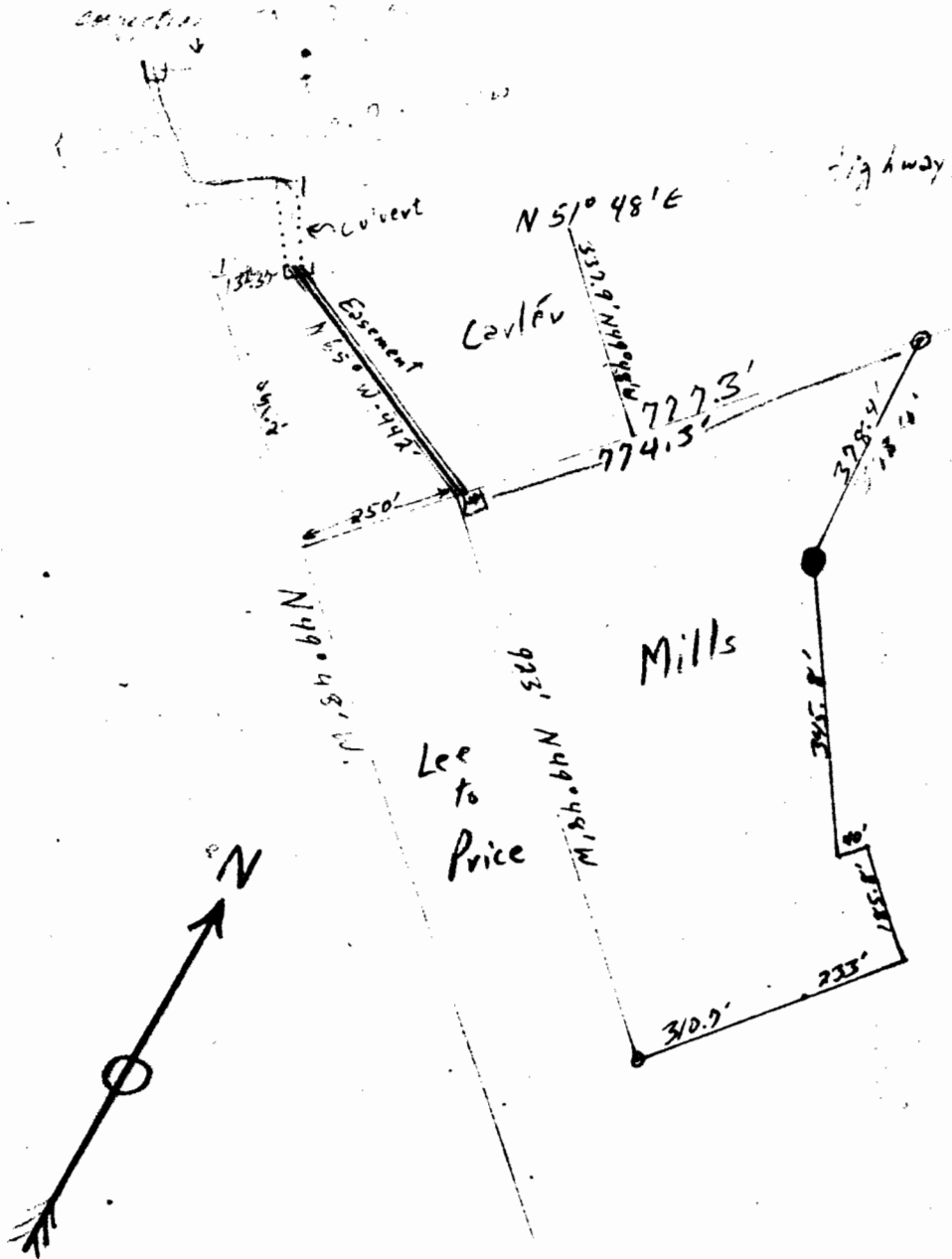

# Last of Elston Property Sold At Leaburg

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LEABURG -- The last of the property owned by the Elston family, prominent residents of this area since 1924, has been sold.

Mrs. Francis Elston has sold her home on Greenwood drive and has purchased a home at 8414 Southwest 10th St., in Portland, to be near her daughter.

The Elstons first came to the area more than 40 years ago when John William Elston purchased 282 acres, which included all the property from Greenwood cemetery on the west to the old Curry place on the upper end of Greenwood drive, extending across the highway and canal.

In 1928 he sold all land north of the highway to the Eugene Water and Electric Board. At this time, also, the new McKenzie highway was built.

The father built the house formerly owned by Mr. and Mrs. Albert Wooley, known as the Blueberry farm, now occupied by Mr. and Mrs. Charles Merrill.

He gave each of four sons 50 acres. Francis built the home now owned by Mr. and Mrs. Lester Yenne and one across the road which Mrs. Elston recently sold to William Knuth of San Francisco, who had previously purchased another tract in the area.

Marion Elston built the house formerly owned by Mr. and Mrs. W. E. Mills and then sold to the Walter T. Hansen family, who are now in Haiti, where Hansen is in government service. The house is now occupied by Robert Marquardt Sr.

Ira Elston constructed the house formerly owned by Ed Yenne on Cogswell creek and later sold to Cliff Morgan. The fourth son, Clarence, built the house on the highway now owned by Loren McPherson.

SUBJECT: Petition for Late Claim for Surface Water Registration

The water right dispute first came into evidence during Aug. 1993 while the State Highway 126 was being widened to provide a passing lane and our water supply was shut off. Our irrigation water supply comes from the EWEB canal taken from the McKenzie River.

I (Doris) had grown up on the property since 1942, presently owned by Don Carnes & Paula Medaglia. My parents, W.E. Mills & Ruth in 1966 sold us 1.03 acres (Tax rolls: Acct #546133, 17-15-01-3-00102) and later in 1980 their home at 90107 Greenwood Dr., (Acct. #546117, 17-15-01-3-00100) with Ruth E. Mills retaining a Life Tenancy clause which she (a recognized local Historian) capably and efficiently lived out her life until April 1993. We moved into the 90107 home on Aug. 29, 1993. Never once was it ever pointed out to her that there was any need to file for water rights. Recorded in Lane County records was the fact clearly spelled out that water rights truly did exist. She had careful documentation of which are enclosed copies or excerpts from various documents.
