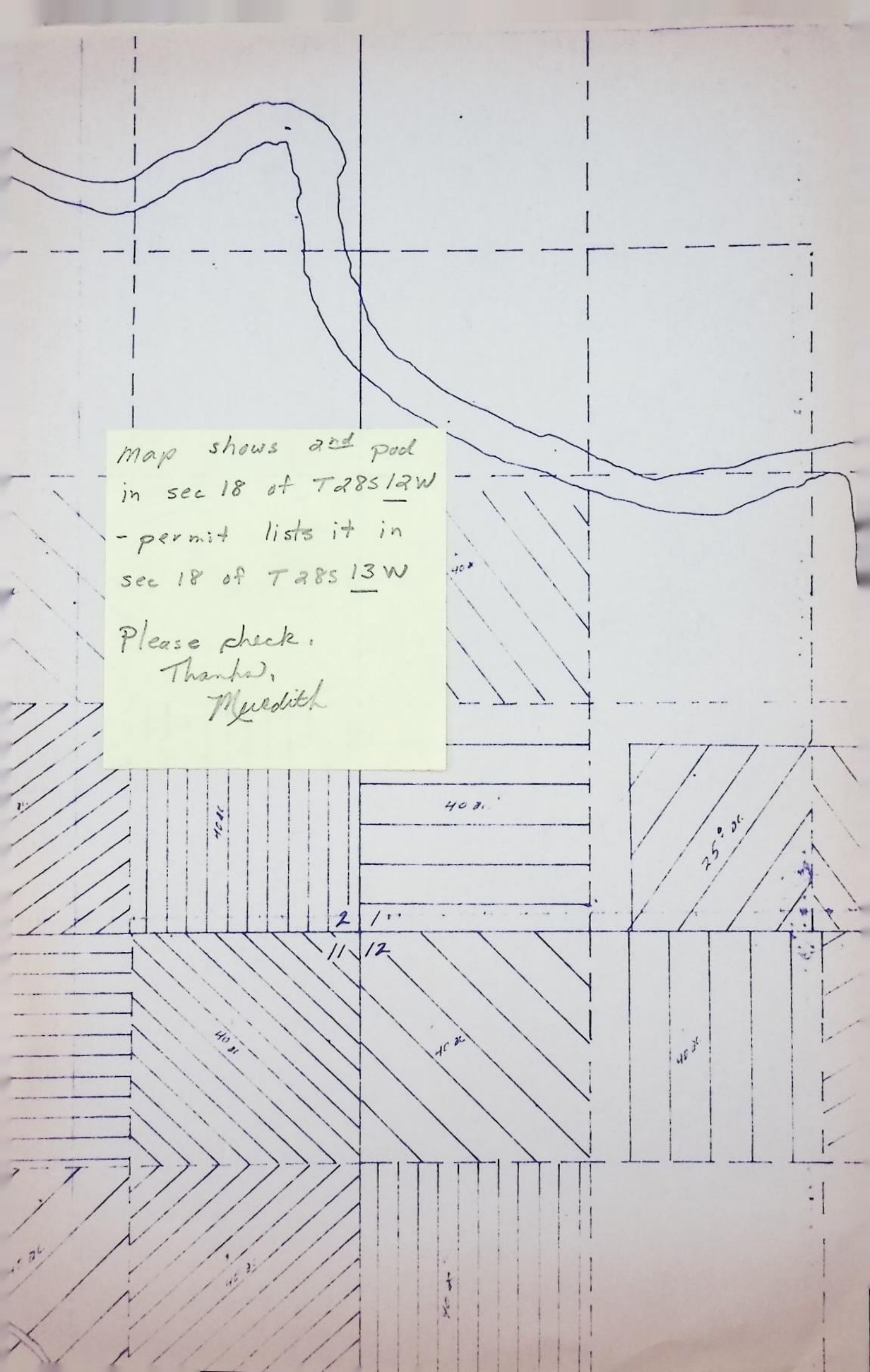

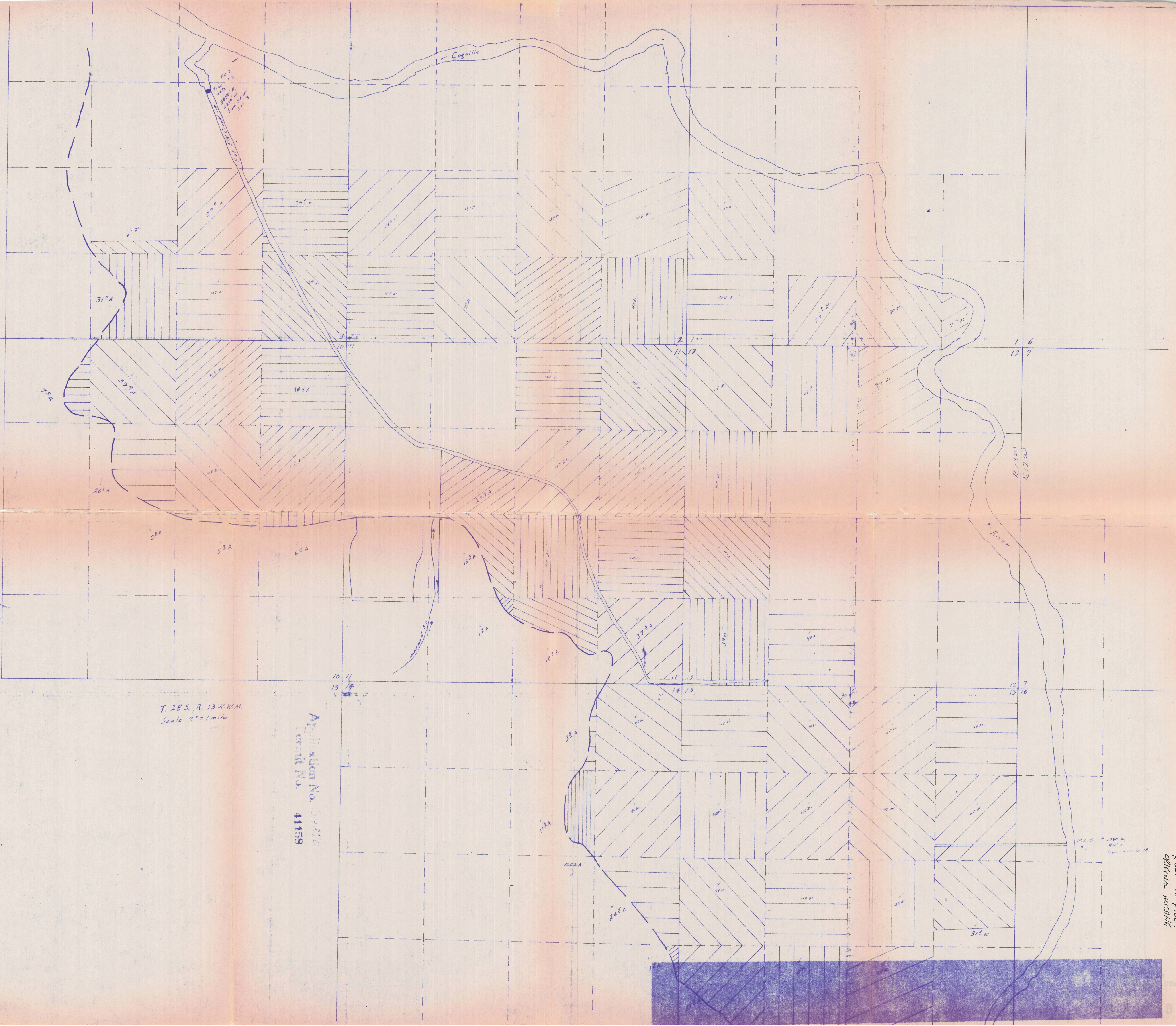

New Water Right Fee Schedule

Effective July 24, 1997

This sheet represents changes to existing fees authorized under HB 2135. See ORS 536.050 for those application fees which were not changed.

Surface Water, Ground Water and Reservoir Applications

Examination Fee:	\$250, plus,

This notice is to inform you that a water rights application fee bill (HB 2135) was signed into law yesterday afternoon by Governor John Kitzhaber. The new application fee structure and how to receive more information on the fees are on the back of this sheet.

Over recent years, water right application processing costs have increased while competition for state General Fund revenue has escalated, making it more difficult for the Water Resources Department to rely on a steady source of General Fund revenue to support the Water Rights Division program. In addition, fees relating to water right applications had not been increased since 1983. Due to these factors, there has been a growing need to develop a self-supporting, fee-based program.

The fees collected relating to water right application processing are far below the actual costs incurred. For example, before yesterday, the average water right application fee was \$420, covering only about 25 percent of the estimated actual cost of \$1,660 for processing water right applications. Transfer application fees also revealed a great disparity between the average fee of \$100 and the actual average processing cost of approximately \$785.

The new law increases water right permit and transfer application fees to assist in covering the Department application processing costs. At the same time, the bill streamlines the structure of water right fees so that they are all based in part on the quantity of water requested. This change allows the Department to base all application fees on the same criteria - the amount of water requested - rather than having some applications based on quantity of water while others are based on acreage. The bill also creates new fees for district temporary transfer and aquifer storage and recovery applications.

The new law creates a base fee to cover application processing costs required by all applications. Additional fees will be based on the amount of water requested in the application. Typically, applications requesting larger amounts of water require greater attention by the Department during the review process. By basing part of the application fee on the quantity of water requested, the Department attempts to cover those additional costs.

The Department has an internet web site. It's address is www.wrd.state.or.us. Information about various Department programs can be accessed from the web site. We are currently working on posting the Department's weekly public notice on the web. Information regarding pending applications will also be available.

The Department's *Summary of 1997 Water Legislation* will be available in August. Copies of the *Summary* cost \$9.00 by mail, or \$6.00 if purchased and picked up at the Department. To receive a copy by mail, please send a request along with a check for \$9.00 payable to the Oregon Water Resources Department at this address. You may download an electronic copy of the *Summary* from the publications library of our website.

You may be aware that this project is unique in its concept of operation and function. The water taken from the Coquille River is from the tidal area and it is diverted into existing drainage ditches within the District for the purpose of maintaining desired water levels for subsurface irrigation of adjoining lands, some flooding irrigation and some sprinkler-pumping type irrigation. The landowners within the District are generally making beneficial use and application of the water for irrigation in one or all of the above mentioned methods.

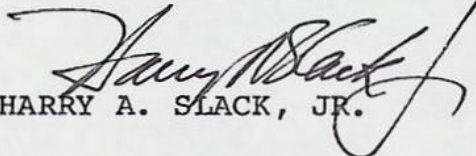
However, not enough time has elapsed to allow the individual landowners to make a determination of how, when and where to irrigate. Experimentation in this process is occurring and we foresee the necessity for needing another one or two years to determine the extent of acreage to be acually irrigated. We believe that most if not all of the area to be irrigated will, in fact, have been irrigated at one time or another depending upon moisture conditions, appropriate regulation of water levels in the ditches and knowledge required for control and application.
