Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.610, 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which the holder of a certificate of registration may submit a request for recognition of modifications to the place of use, character of use or point of appropriation under a groundwater certificate of registration.

Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Divisions 382 and 380 implement the statutes and provide the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating groundwater registration modification applications.

Findings of Fact

1. On March 11, 2019, CITY OF MILWAUKIE filed a groundwater registration modification application for additional points of appropriation and to modify the place of use under Registration Application GR-1479 (Certificate of Registration GR-1428). The Department assigned the application number T-13144.
2. Notice of the application for groundwater registration modification was published on March 19, 2019, pursuant to OAR 690-382-0600. No comments were filed in response to the notice.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

3. On January 23, 2020, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13144 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of February 24, 2020, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination.
4. On March 11, 2020, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer T-13144 and mailed a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on March 17, 2020, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.
