Dear Don:

Based upon conversation with the current owner and applicant, Jack Erickson, I have gathered the following additional information in response to your request dated July 14, 1994.

The site was settled by Issac and Samuel Donkel in approximately 1900. They built a cabin near the confluence of Cronin Creek and the Nehalem River. The location of this cabin is shown on the attached timber cruise notes.

From 1900 (+/-) through 1946, there were various unknown owners and residents in addition to the Donkel's. In addition, according to the current owner, the site served as a base camp for logging operations. Water use during this period was for domestic and commercial use associated with mill and logging operations. In 1946, the primary residence was moved to a site near the existing house, approximately one half mile upstream from the confluence of Cronin Creek and the Nehalem River. The following individuals occupied this residence during this period:

John Ordway 1946 - 1949 "Curly" Konopski 1946 - 1952 Paul Lathum 1954 - 1976

Mr. Jack Erickson purchased the property in 1953. The existing primary residence was built during 1946-1953. A mobile home was brought to the site in March of 1992, and replaced the caretaker quarters occupied by Paul Lathum and "Curly" Konopski. This caretaker residence had existed since the mid 1940's.

The log pond was originally built in 1951. Mr. Erickson renovated and improved the pond in 1993, to its current condition. The existing Hydroelectric Generation System was installed in September of 1992.

Dear Mr. Knaver:

As per your request for historical evidence supporting the above referenced pre-1909 claim. I have enclosed a sketch from a timber cruise, conducted in 1908. This sketch shows a ranch dwelling at the confluence of Cronin Creek and the Nehlalem River. This is the same approximate location of the existing dwellings. According to the owner, Jack Erickson, this site served as a base camp and hill site for logging activities in the first half of the century. Over time the use has modified with the introduction of new technology, most notably the installation of a minor hydro-electicized generation system as described in our application.

In conclusion, we maintain that this site has supported domestic type uses since at least 1908. Further, these uses have continued without interruption since that time and have evolved into their current condition, which is detailed in our application.

CLAIM OF BENEFICIAL USE AND SITE REPORT FOR JACK A. ERICKSON UNDER PRE-1909 ADJUDICATED WATER RIGHT WATER RESOURCES DEPT. SALEM, OREGON

GENERAL INFORMATION - The current land owner and registrant are one person, Jack A. Erickson, PO Box 3247, Central Point, OR 97502. The property holds two single family residences along the Nehalem River Road. Persons interviewed during the site visit included George Nixon, the current caretaker of the property and resident of one of the two homes on the property.

Prior to 1900, the property was the location of a logging camp and lumber mill which used water from Cronin Creek and the Unnamed Spring to serve the domestic needs of the logging camp. It was during this time that the storage reservoir was first constructed.

The property was patented on April 19, 1900 by Simon Donkel under certificate number 6054. Cronin Creek and Unnamed Spring were used as a source for domestic water. The property has been continuously occupied since that time.

In 1993 piping was installed to allow the water in the reservoir to be used for emergency fire protection.

With the exception of an emergency pump for fire protection, all water is gravity fed.

SOURCE -

<u>Domestic Consumption</u> is supplied by the Unnamed Spring which originates just North of the property line as shown on the map.

<u>Hydro-electric Consumption</u> is supplied by the same Unnamed Spring as domestic consumption. Low flows during the summer months do not allow for the generation of electricity.

Recreational_Use is supplied by Cronin Creek.

Emergency Fire Protection is supplied by Cronin Creek.

DIVERSION POINT -

<u>Domestic Consumption</u> is diverted at the location shown on the map. The diversion structure consists of a 3" poly vinyl chloride (PVC) pipe held in place by a rip rap weir. The weir is approximately 6' long across the width of the stream, 1' high, and 1-1/2' wide. It is constructed without cement using large stones (8" - 12" dia.) piled at the downstream side of a naturally occurring pool.

<u>Hydro-Electric Consumption</u> is diverted at the location shown on the map. The diversion structure consists of a 3" PVC pipe held in place by a rip rap weir. The weir is approximately 6' long across the width of the stream, 1' high, and 1-1/2' wide. It is constructed without cement using large stones (8" - 12" dia.) piled at the downstream side of a naturally occurring pool.

<u>Recreational Use</u> is diverted from Cronin Creek as shown on the map. The water is diverted into a 3" PVC pipe located in a naturally occurring pool and held in place by large stones. There is no diversion improvements on this stream.

Emergency Fire Protection uses the same diversion structure as Recreational Use.

MOTOR- A Honda 5 hp gasoline powered portable motor is used to power the pump for emergency fire protection only..

PUMP - Honda 5 hp portable water pump, with 3" intake and 3" discharge. Pump and motor are assembled as one unit with direct drive. The pump is stored in a shed to be used for emergency fire protection only.

PIPE -

<u>Domestic Consumption</u> supply pipe is a 3" PVC pipe that flows from the intake structure to a sediment tank approximately 200' downstream. This pipe is all laid above ground. The outlet of the sediment tank is 3" galvanized steel with a tee joint that divides the flow between a 1 1/2" PVC pipe that supplies water to the houses and a 2" pipe that supplies water to the sprinkler system and fire hydrants. Both of these pipes are below ground. There is a 3" overflow pipe at the top of the tank that returns excess water to the spring. There is a 3" gate valve at the inlet of the sediment tank, a 3" gate valve at the outlet of the tank before the tee joint, and a 1 1/2" gate valve on the 1 1/2" supply line. There is no additional valve on the 2" supply line or at the diversion structure.

<u>Hydro-Electric Consumption</u> supply pipe is 3" PVC that flows from the diversion to a sediment tank approximately 100' downstream and then on to the hydroelectric plant as shown on the map. With the exception of the last 200', the pipeline is above ground for the entire length. There is a 3" gate valve at the point of diversion and another at the end of the line, just before the power plant. Following the power plant, a 3" PVC pipe flows approximately 100' back into the original stream.

Recreational Use supply pipe is 3" PVC which runs approximately 800' above ground along the side of Cronin Creek to the storage reservoir. There is a gate valve approximately 500' downstream of the diversion point.

Emergency Fire Protection uses the same supply line as Recreational Use.

HEADS - There are approximately 32 permanent sprinklers that are used to irrigate a non-commercial garden and lawn less than one acre in size. There are also three 3" stand pipes that serve as fire hydrants and three 5/8" standpipes for general use throughout the property.

USES -

<u>Domestic Use</u> includes water to two single family homes as well as lawn irrigation for less than 1 acre of lawn surrounding the houses. The fire hydrants connected to the same system as the sprinklers and are also served by this source.

<u>Hydro-Electric Use</u> is exclusively for the generation of electricity. After the water runs through the power plant it is returned to the Unnamed Spring which then flows into Cronin Creek.

Recreational Use is provided by the reservoir which is used for swimming, fishing, and aesthetics.

<u>Emergency Fire Protection</u> is provided by water stored in the reservoir. Except when used to fight fires, the water flows over a spillway and returns to Cronin Creek.

LIFT -

<u>Domestic Use</u>: The elevation difference between the sediment tank and the point of use is approximately 100'.

<u>Hydro-Electric Use</u>: A pressure gage on the power plant supply line just before the power plant indicates a pressure of 55 psi while the plant is in operation. This converts to a pressure head of 127'.

<u>Recreational Use</u>: The elevation difference between the point of diversion and the reservoir is approximately 15'.

Emergency Fire Protection: same as Recreational Use.

DAM X-SECTION - The cross section of the dam was measured at the furthest downstream point. The basis of elevation was the southern corner of a 4'x4' concrete pad $\pm 50'$ to the north of the pond. This elevation was assumed to be 100.00'. Horizontal distance was measured using a rag tape and vertical distance was measured with a Leitz level. The dam x-section is shown on the attached drawing.

DAM OUTLET - In addition to the spillway described below, the dam is equipped with a 3"φ pvc drain pipe. This pipe is located on the downstream end of the reservoir and is fitted with a gate valve. This drain is used to nearly empty the reservoir for routine maintenance.

DAM LENGTH & PROFILE - The dam completely surrounds the reservoir, there are no abutments. The perimeter of the dam is ± 550 '. The height of the dam is at it's greatest on the downstream side where it is approximately 5' from crest to toe. From there the height gradually lessens to the upstream side where the height is negligible.

SPILLWAY - The spillway consists of a 11" wide by 12 foot long wooden channel followed by a concrete lined channel that flows into the Unnamed Spring and then into Cronin Creek. The slope of the spillway was measured at 0.17 ft/ft. A profile of the spillway is included on the attached drawing. On the day of the inspection, the spillway was flowing at a depth of ± 1 ". Using the Manning equation with a roughness coefficient of 0.011, the flow was calculated at 0.228 cfs.

RESERVOIR EXCAVATION - According to the caretaker, the reservoir is excavated to a depth of approximately 3'. Excess excavated material was used in the construction of the dam. The dam appears to be well constructed with no signs of erosion or water piping through the dam at the time of inspection.

The bottom of the reservoir is lined with plastic sheeting that extends over the dam a distance of about 3' past the high water level. The spillway is lined by wooden boards for 12 feet followed by a concrete lining for 24 feet.


