Dear Permit holder,

Oregon Administrative Rule 690-217-0020(1) requires that ground water permit holders with a priority date after December 20, 1988, submit the results of a pump test before the Water Resources Department can issue a water right certificate. A copy of your permit is enclosed. The purpose of this letter is to remind you of the pump test requirement.

Pump tests are intended to provide aquifer and well information for ground water resource characterization and to help solve well problems. There is no penalty for not submitting a pump test.

If there is a reason why a pump test cannot be performed on a well, the owner may request from the Director an exemption from the pump test requirement. Requests shall be in writing and include the reason why a pump test cannot be performed. Exemptions, or conditioned exemptions, shall be granted if the reasons are found to be valid and eliminating the problem would place an unreasonable burden on the well owner. Exemptions shall be granted for public water supply wells if pump testing will cause interruption of service to customers.

Pump tests shall not be required of wells with diameters greater than 36 inches and depths less than 30 feet. Pump tests shall not be required of collector-type wells or infiltration galleries. If your well meets one of these two requirements please let us know.

If you are interested in conducting the pump test yourself, you should first review the requirements at http://arcweb.sos.state.or.us/rules/OARS_600/OAR_690/690_217.html or ask that a copy of the rules be sent to you.

A copy of the pump test form has been included. If you have questions, if you are not the owner of a ground water permit or if you have moved, please call the Department at 503-986-0900.

Qualifications for Conducting Pump Tests

Only pump tests conducted by the well owner, a full-time employee of the well owner who routinely works with and is familiar with wells and pumps, or a qualified individual authorized by the well owner shall be accepted by the Director. Individuals in the following groups will be considered qualified and authorized provided they have significant experience conducting pump tests:

- (1) Oregon licensed water well constructors.
- (2) Oregon registered professional geologists or certified engineering geologists.
- (3) Certified water rights examiners.
- (4) Oregon registered professional engineers.
- (5) Individuals whose primary occupation involves, wholly or in significant part, pump installation, service or testing.

This permit is issued approving Application G-12290. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 9, 1990. The use is limited to not more than 0.19 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 32, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 31 S, R 15 W, W.M.

The amount of water diverted for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS, together with amounts secured under any other rights existing for the same lands, is limited as follows: For temperature control, 0.15 cubic foot per second per acre. For flood harvesting or pest control, 0.05 cubic foot per second per acre. For irrigation of cranberries, ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. For the irrigation of any other crop, ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the proposed place of use under the permit is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 12.0 ACRES
SECTION 32
SW 1/4 18.0 ACRES
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 31 SOUTH, RANGE 15 WEST, W.M.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 15, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. Complete application of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 1994.

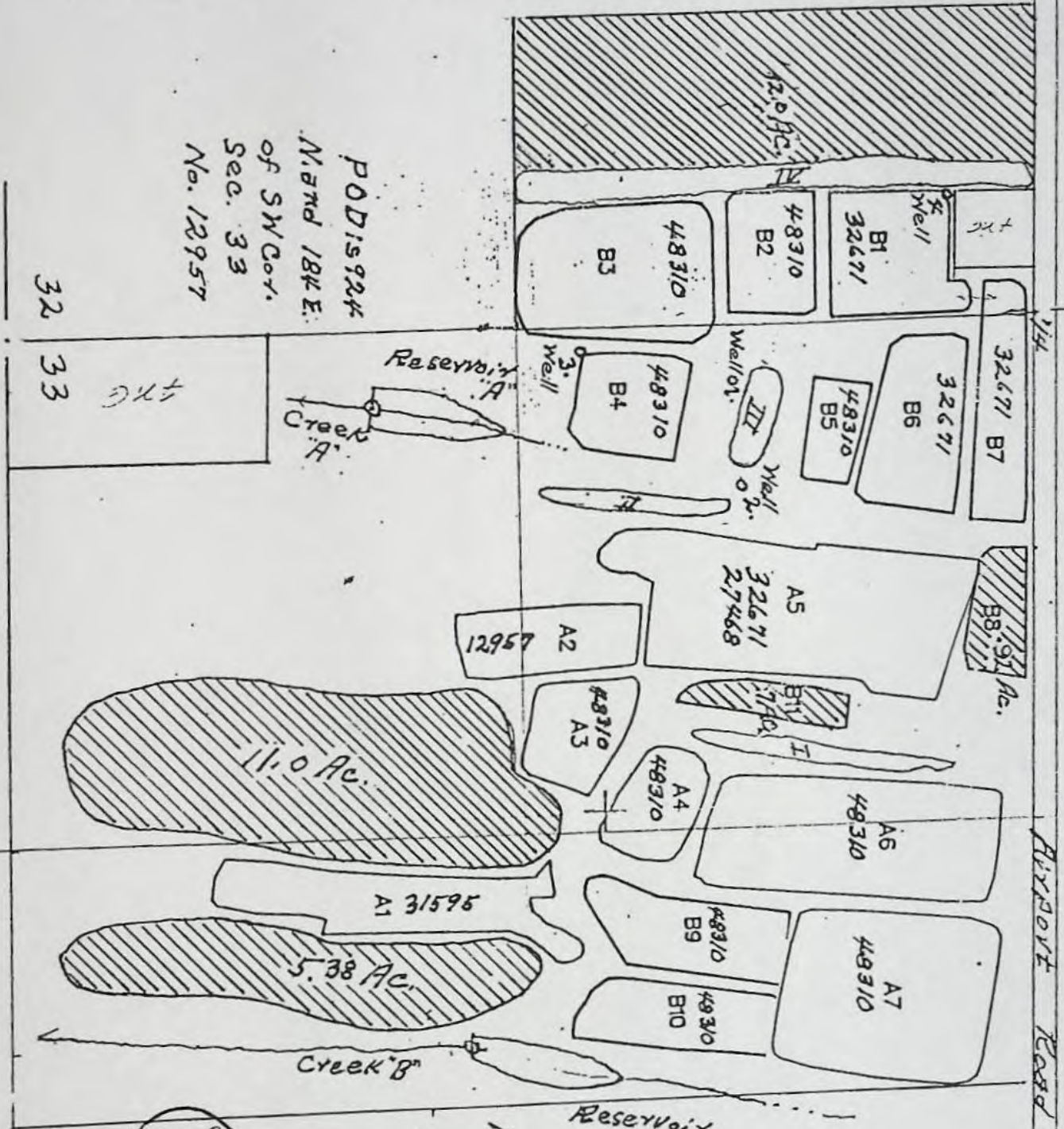
Map For an Application for a Permit to Appropriate Water In Curry County.

I have reviewed Roy Peters ground water application (G-12290) for a second time. The first review resulted in a determination that his wells were in hydraulic connection with an adjacent unnamed stream, and potential for significant interference existed. Mr. Peters contacted me and asked if I would review the application again, based on new proposed well locations. I told him that I would.

Mr. Peters sent a map of the proposed well locations and proposed storage facilities at the site. The two proposed wells are 1600 ft and 1400 ft away from the unnamed stream. Mr. Peter's existing well #4 is 1300 ft from the stream. Based upon my review, Mr. Peters could make application to appropriate ground water from the two proposed wells and well #4 without significant interference with the unnamed stream.

On Monday, June 3, Larry Wells of Representative Schroeder's office called to discuss a ground water application I reviewed some weeks ago. The application (G-12290) was submitted by Roy Peters of Curry County to withdraw water from four wells for cranberry operations. I determined the appropriation would have the potential to impact surface water flows in a nearby stream (about 200 ft away).

Mr. Peters called first. We spoke at length how I came to the conclusion that I did. This call was followed by a call from Larry Wells, identifying that he was with Rep. Schroeder. Again, I discussed the procedure for identifying surface water/ground water connection. After a lengthy discussion, Mr. Wells informed me that we are placing a hardship on agriculture by tying up the water. And in addition, he didn't think that we could make such hydraulic connection determinations from our office.

On June 4, I took a second call from Roy Peters. He wanted to know if I would take a look at his application again if he proposed to drill his wells in a different location. He said he could get as far away as 1500 ft from any natural surface water source. I told him it may not change the outcome of the application, but I would take a look at it.

For the irrigation of any other crop, ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

When required by the department, the permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before , and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. Complete application of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

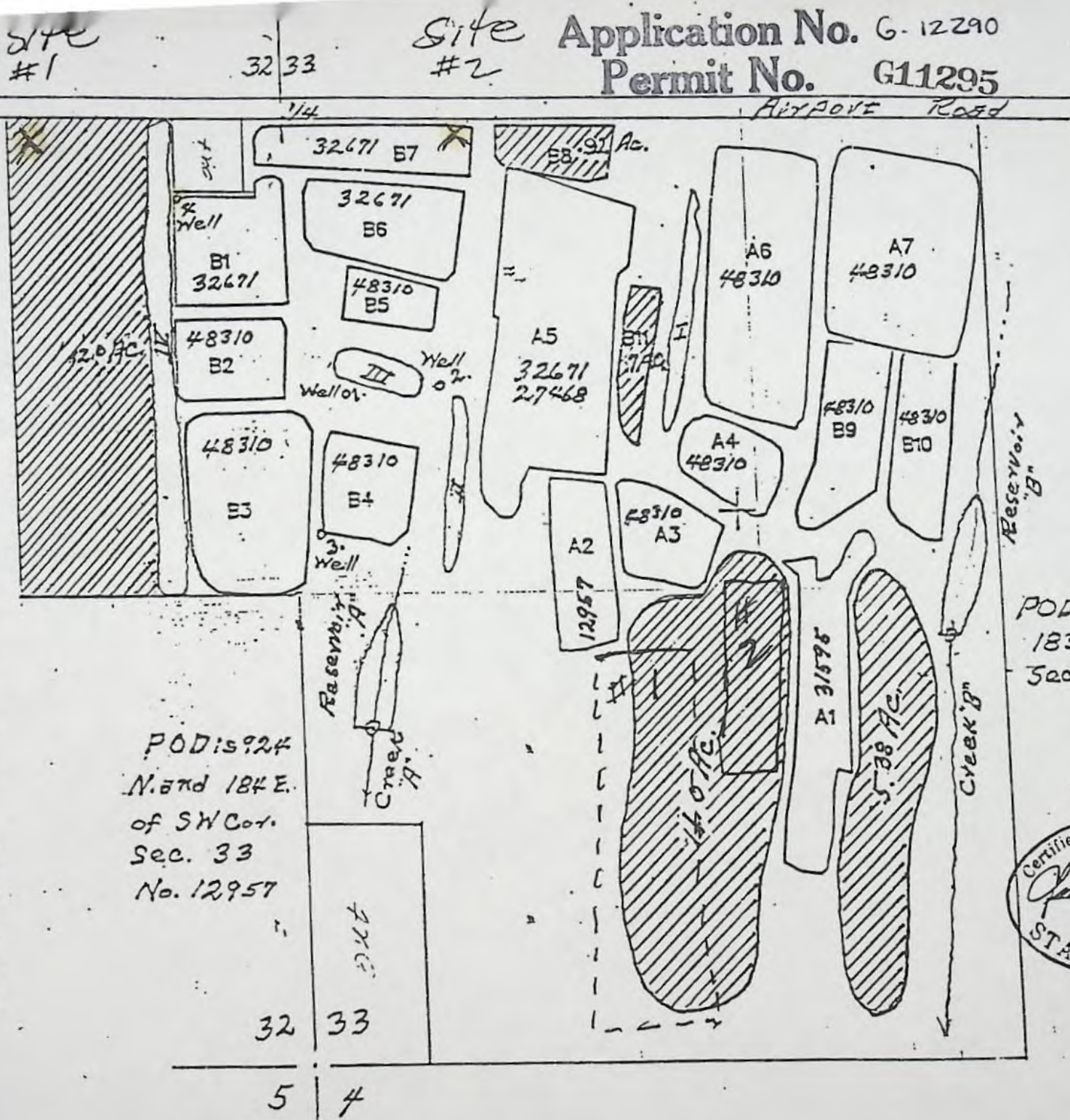
