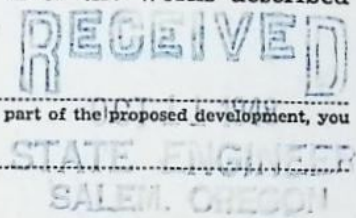

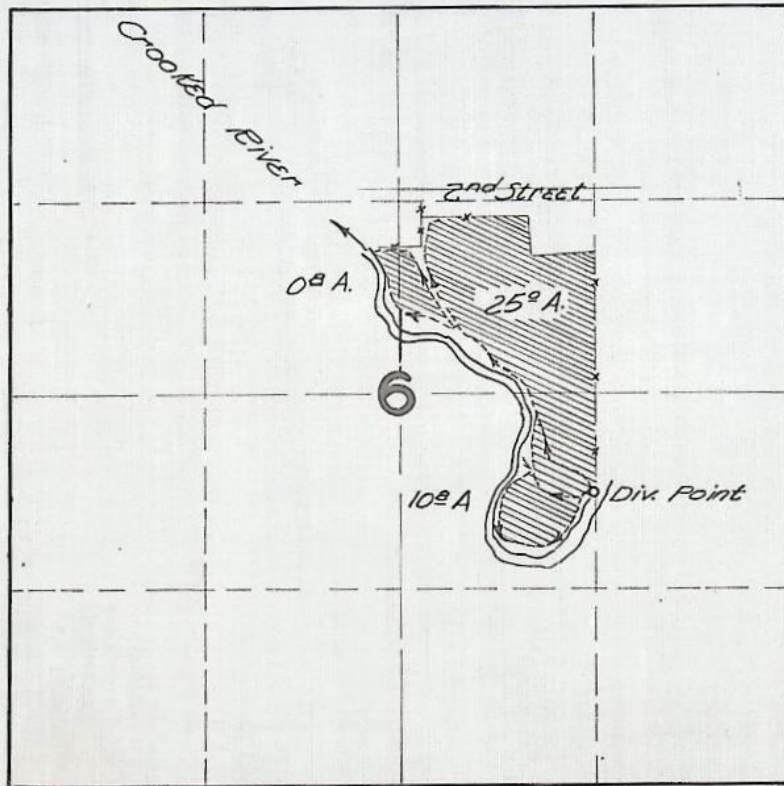


Dear Mr. Lau:

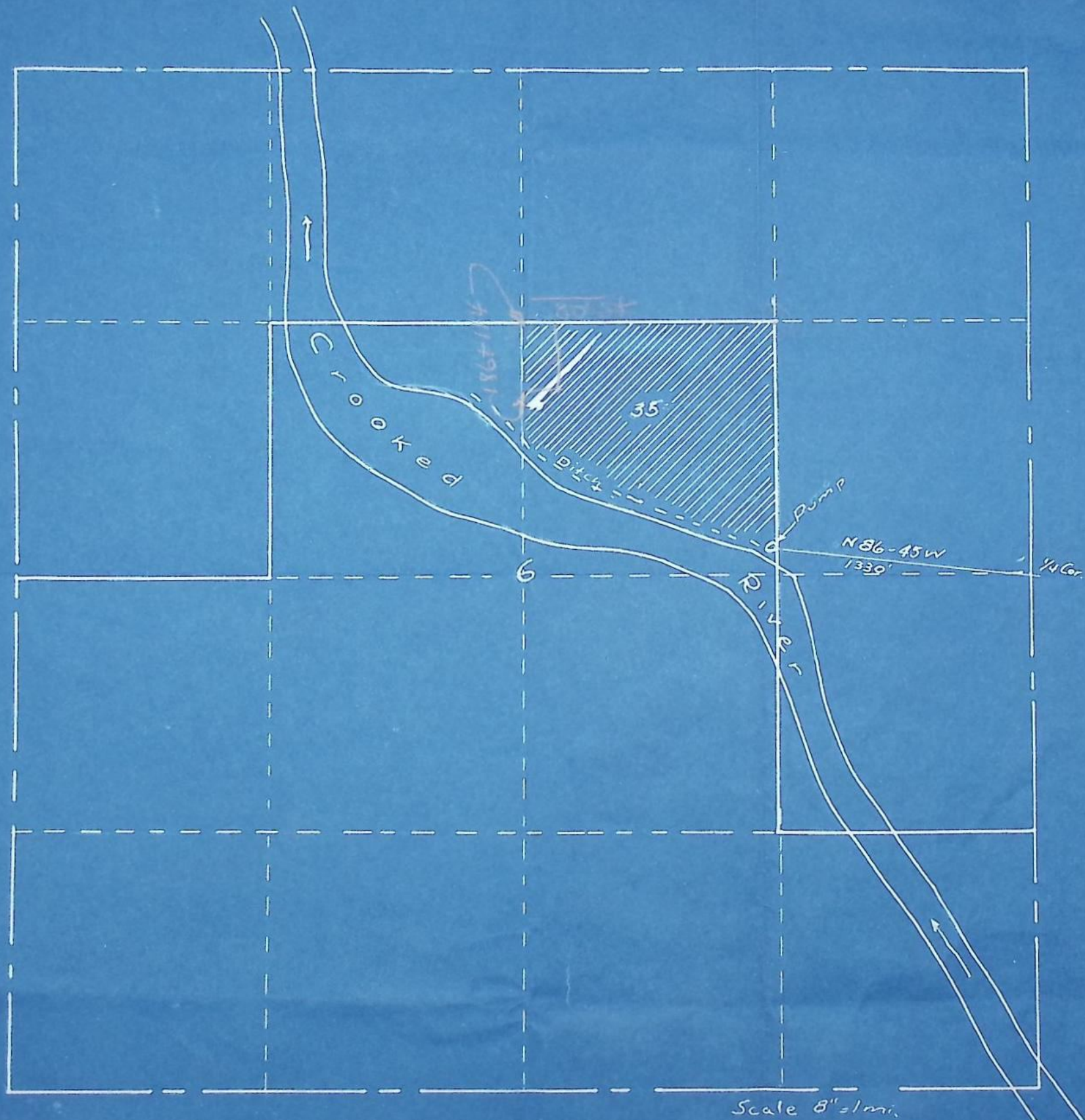

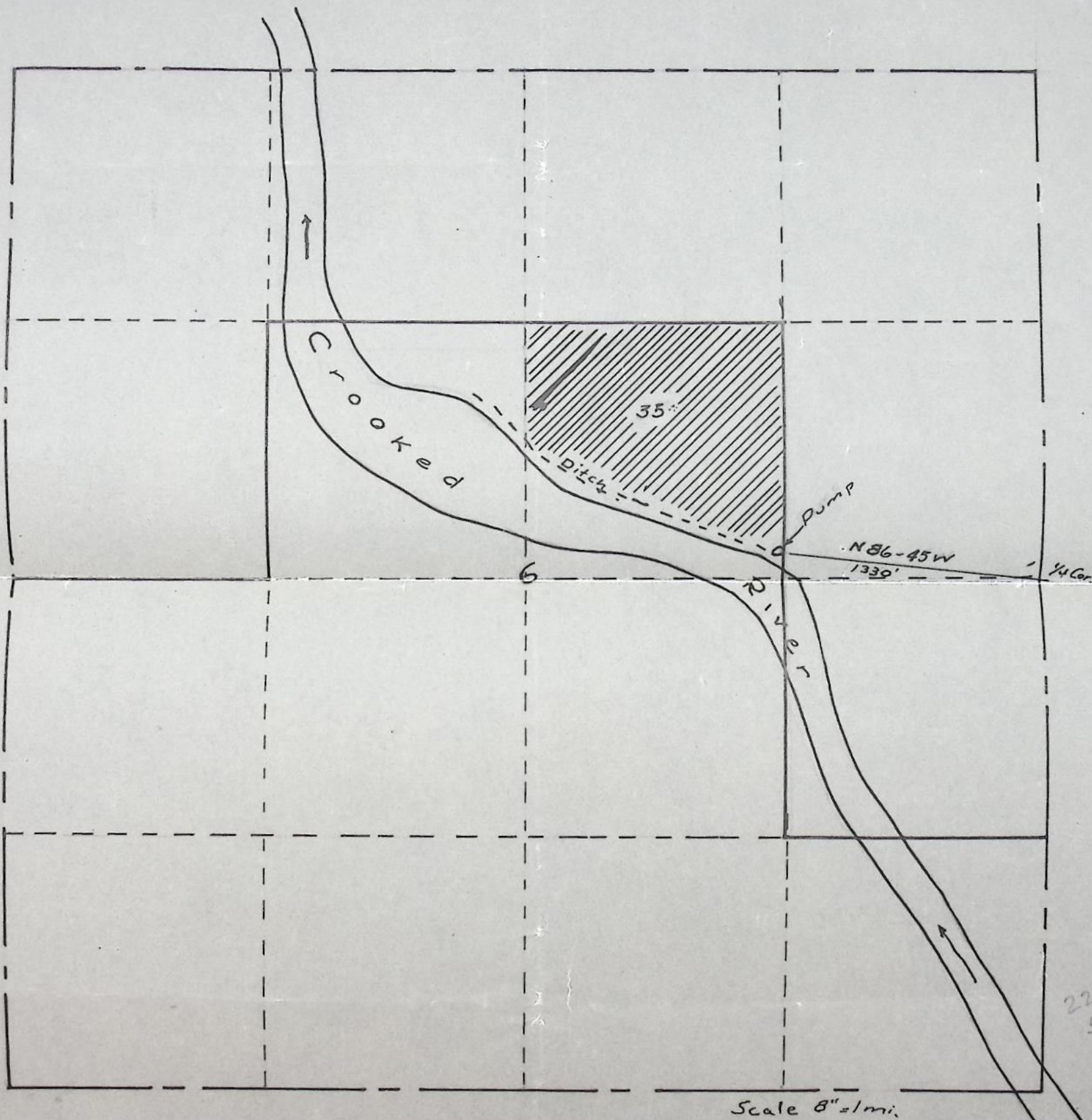

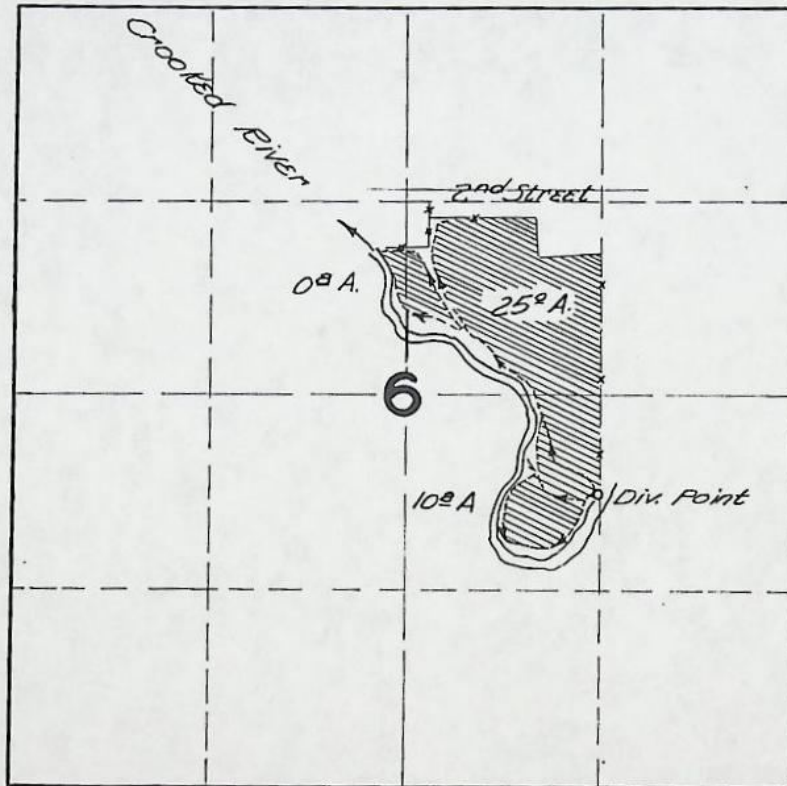


Map of Section 6 T.15S. R.16E. W.M.

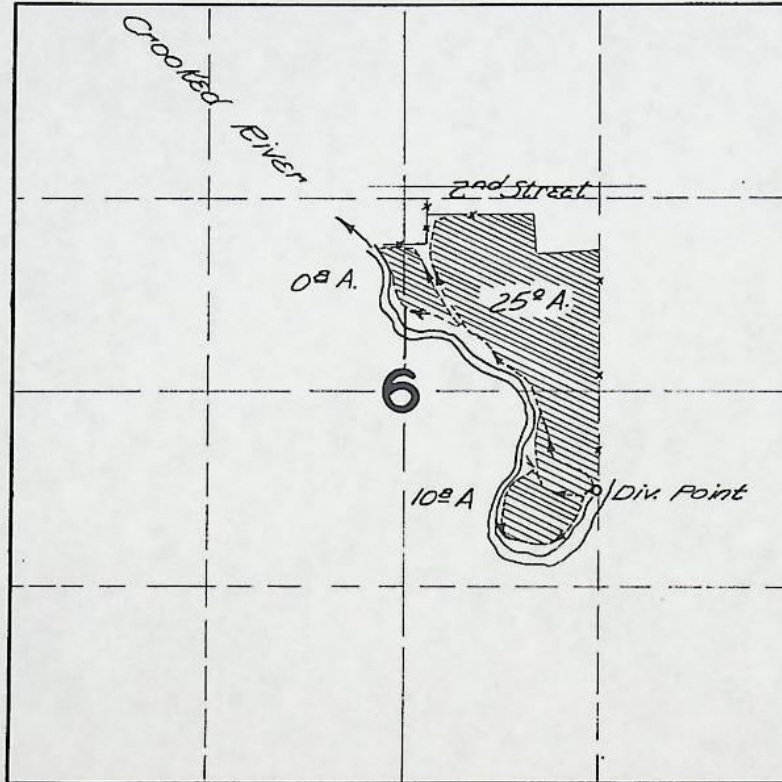
