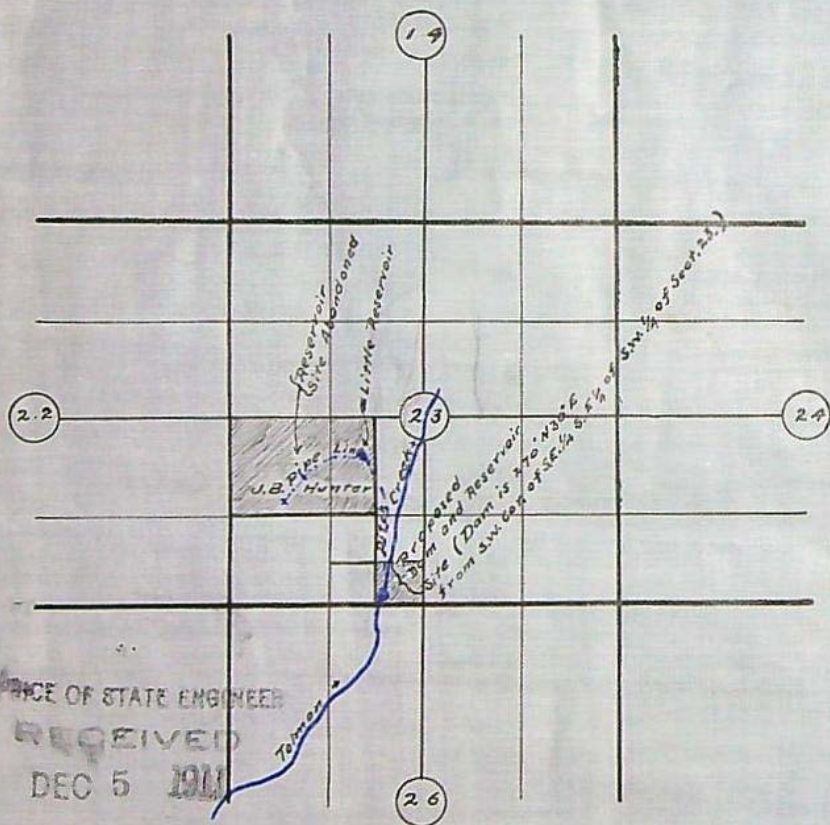

I herewith enclose application of J. B. Hunter for the appropriation of water, of what is known in this county as Toleman Creek.

The facts in connection with this proposed appropriation are as follows;

Mr. Hunter has used water through an old ditch for the the past fifteen years, and is still using it, but he now proposes to construct two small reservoirs, both of which are situated on his own land and pipe surplus water of Coleman Creek into these reservoirs and afterwards pump the water out for irrigation purposes . His proposed pipe line will extend the entire distance across privately owned lands.

I have thought it quite probable that owing to the fact that Mr. Hunter owns the land on which his reservoirs are to be constructed, and that no other party will have any interest or be effected thereby, that no application for a reservoir site would be necessary, And for the same and further reason that there is such a small amount of water to be appropriated that an actual survey, field notes and maps would not be necessary.

I have accordingly filled in an application and herewith

enclose same, together with a crude map showing the location of the creek, the pipe line, the land to be irrigated and also the location of the proposed reservoir. I also enclose Mr. Hunter's personal check, in the sum of \$10.50, which I presume will be your filing fee.

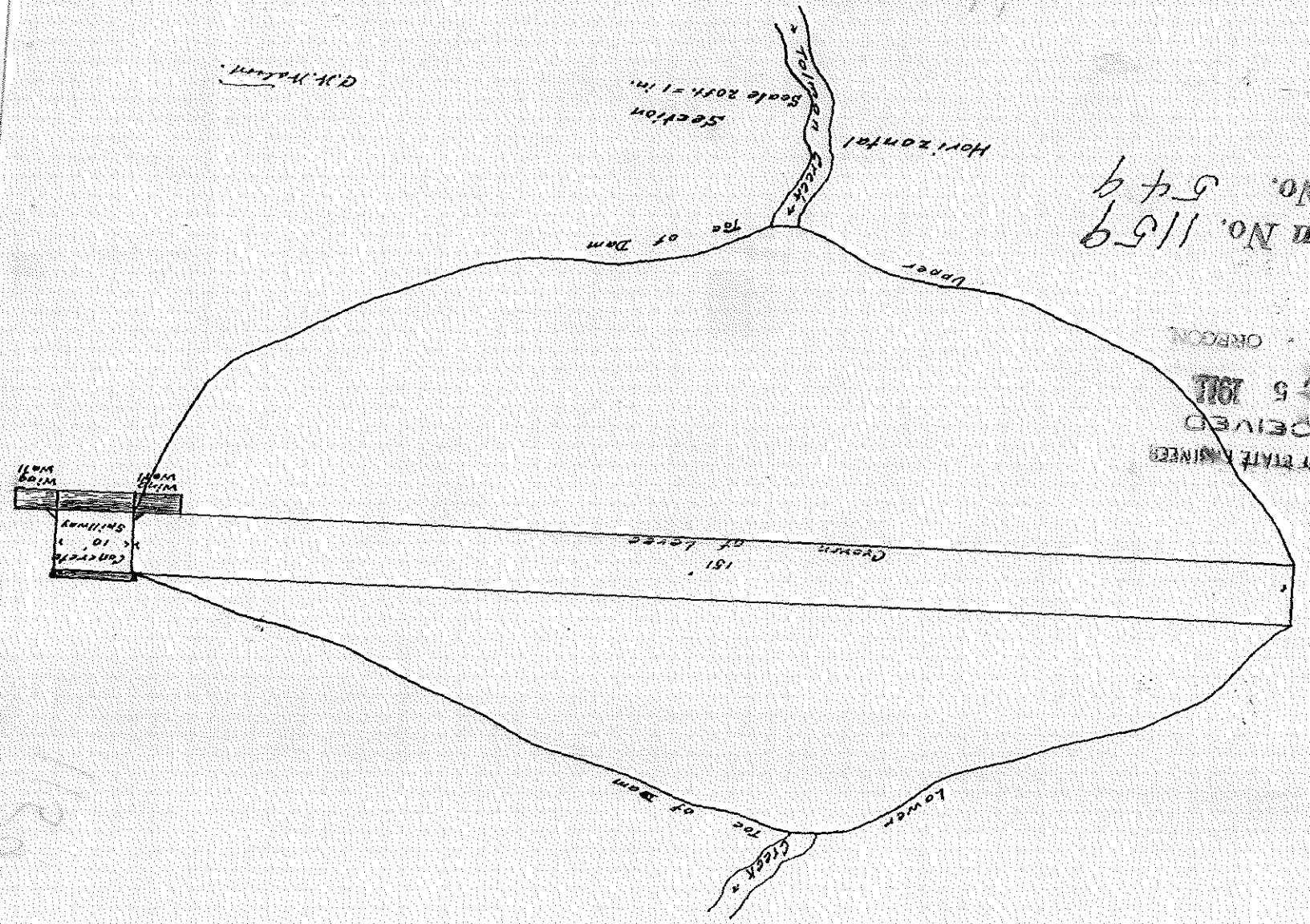
If this notice is irregular or incomplete I will be glad to make any corrections necessary.

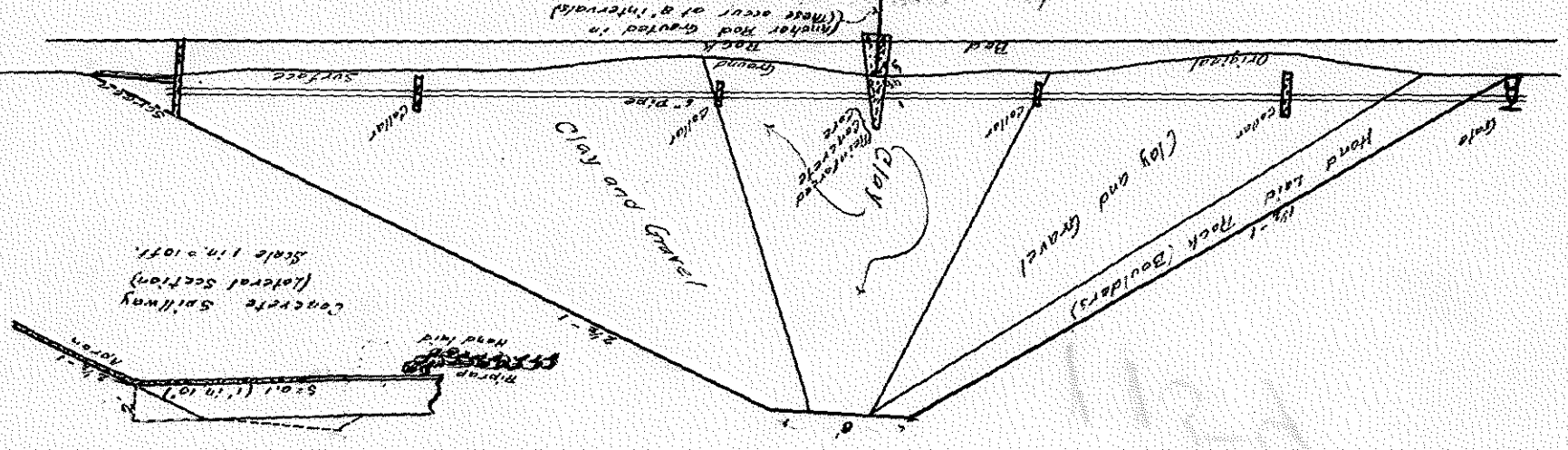
