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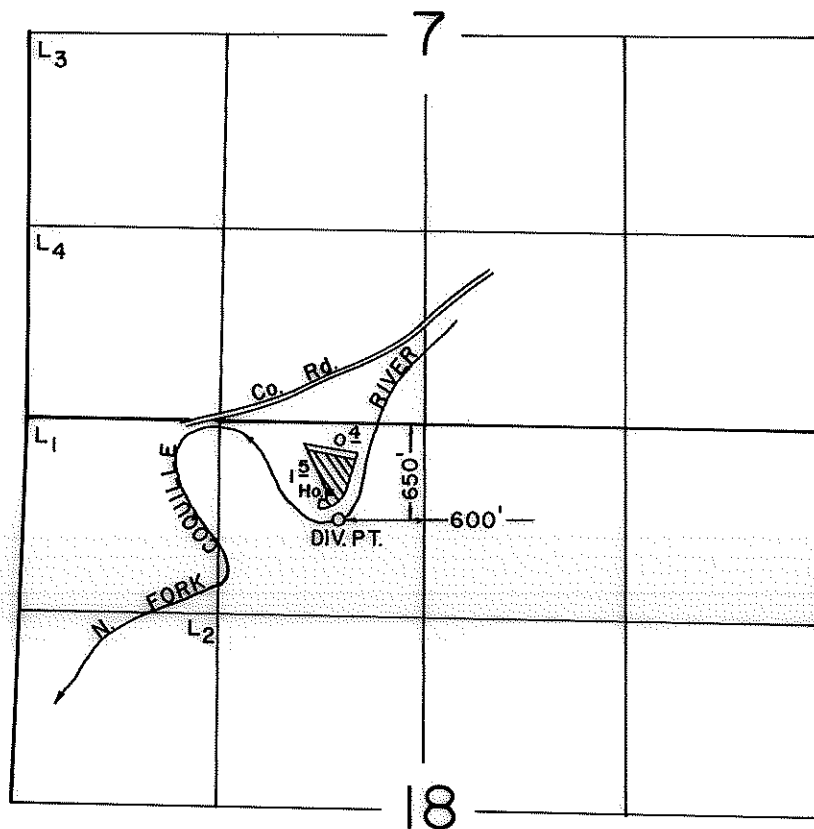

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62045 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Joy D. Main of Box 3592, Fairview Route, Coquille, Oregon 97423, phone 396-3454, for the use of the waters of North Fork Coquille River, a tributary of Coquille River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot of water per second for domestic use and 0.018 cfs for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 3, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.023 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 650 feet South and 630 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 18, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 27 South, Range 11 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 27 South Range 11 West, WM Section 18 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 domestic use for one family and 1.5 acre irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

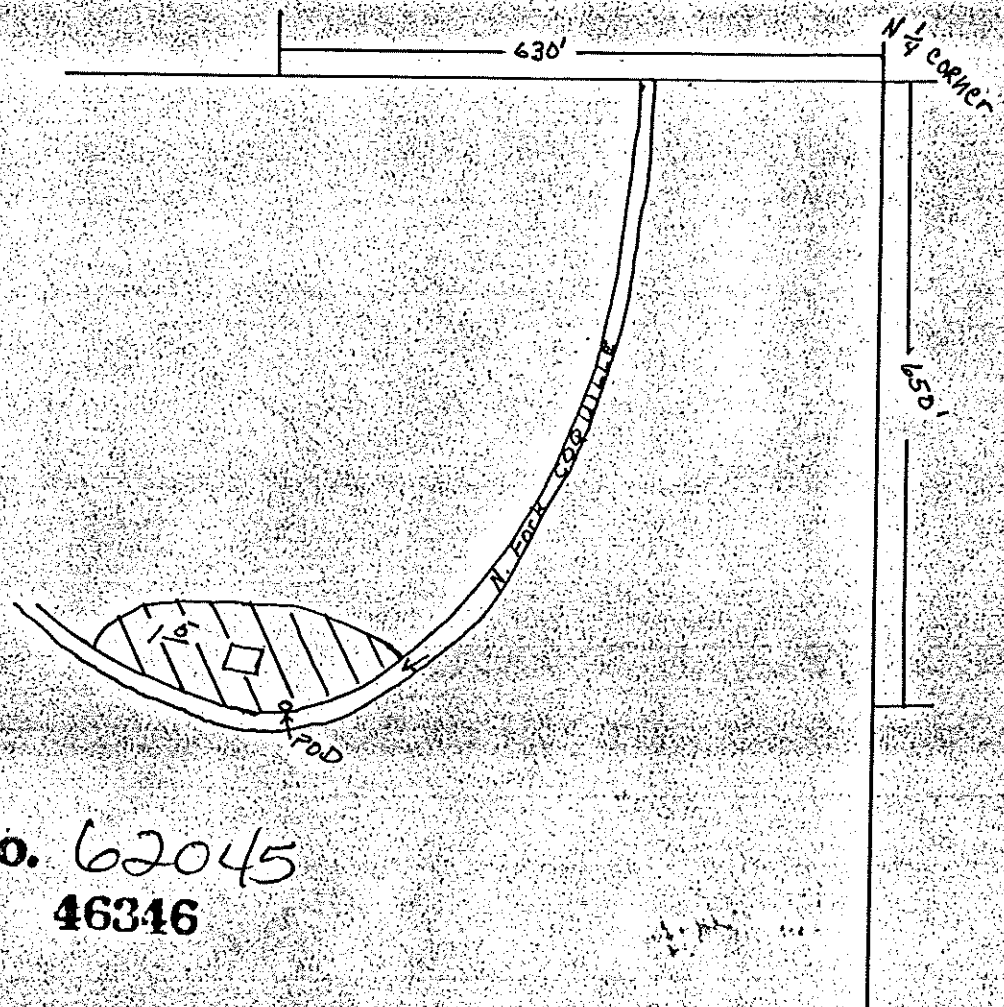

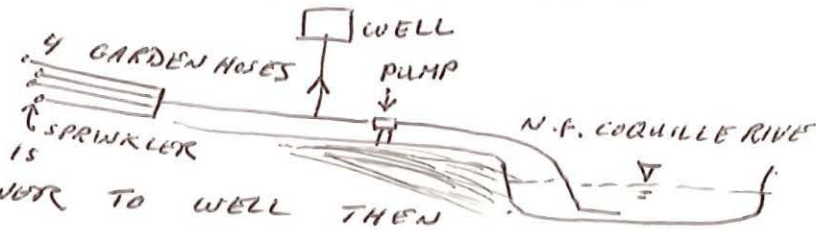

NOTICE TO SELLERS & BUYERS:

By law, all water belongs to the public [ORS 537.110]. In almost every instance, a Permit OR Water Right Certificate from the **Water Resources Department** is needed before using, diverting; or storing water [ORS 537-130]. However, most domestic wells do not require water rights. A water right stays with the land. In order to keep track of water right ownership, ORS 537.330 requires persons selling property that has a Water Right Certificate to: 1) provide evidence of the Water Right Certificate to the buyer and 2) notify the Water Resources Department of the Water Right Certificate involved with the real estate transaction. Sellers are exempted from this requirement if the water uses are served by a water district or a city.

Water that has been used for a long time in one place or that involves a water structure (like a dam) that already exists is no guarantee that there is a water right which would allow the water use to continue.

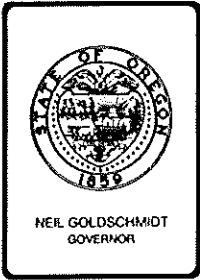

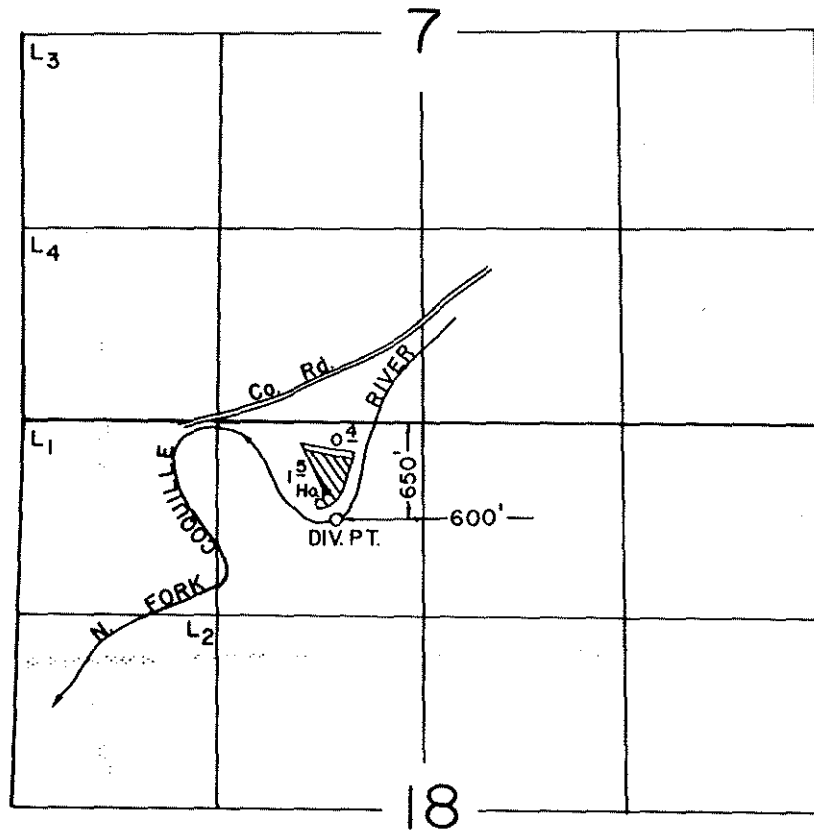
If you agree with the proposed certificate and map no response to this notice is required. Shortly after the 60 day period, the recorded certificate of water right will be mailed to you.
