**Summary:** Order approving Application G-19533 and issuing Permit G-19046.

**Authority**

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On May 22, 2026, Rachel A. Dotson submitted an application to the Department for an emergency-use permit, requesting 0.044 cubic foot per second, further limited to 4.5 acre-feet, of groundwater for supplemental irrigation of 5.0 acres from Well 1 (JACK 57572) for use from May 1, 2026, through October 31, 2026.
2. The required examination and recording fees were paid.
3. The Department has not received adverse comments related to the possible issuance of the attached permit.
4. The Department completed a review of the application in accordance with OAR 690-019-0040.
5. The use is proposed in a designated drought area according to the Governor’s April 21, 2026, Executive Order 26-07.
6. Drought conditions have created an inability on the part of the applicant to obtain water under existing Water Right Certificate 35858.
7. The Department considered the factors described in OAR 690-310-0130 and finds that:
  - a. The proposed use requested in this application is allowed in the Rogue Basin Program (OAR 690-515-0040(1)(a));

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is a Final Order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 536.075 and ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- b. Groundwater is available in the amount requested for this emergency, temporary use;
  - c. The proposed use will not injure other water rights; and
  - d. The proposed use does not comply with other rules of the Commission; groundwater use has measurably reduced the surface flows necessary for the Rogue Scenic Waterway, and the proposed use would further reduce surface water flow to this scenic waterway.
8. The Department has considered the need for water because of the drought emergency and the short-term nature of the proposed emergency use and determined that the use would not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

**CONCLUSION OF LAW**

The application will not cause injury to existing water rights and will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest (OAR 690-019-0040(3)).

**ORDER**

Application G-19533 is approved, and Permit G-19046 is issued as limited by the conditions contained therein.
