In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

Oregon law does not allow the Director to reissue a certificate because of a change in the ownership of the appurtenant place of use. The water must be controlled and not wasted. To change the location of the point of diversion, the character of use, or the location of use requires the advance approval of the Water Resources Director.

If any portion of this water right is not used for five or more consecutive years that portion of the right may be subject to forfeiture according to ORS 540.610. Land enrolled in-a Federal Reserve Program is not subject to forfeiture during the period of enrollment. Other exceptions to forfeiture are explained in ORS 540.610.

Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The right shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with prior surface water rights as well as prior ground water rights of others.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for the measuring line, adequate to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

This right is for the beneficial use of water.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

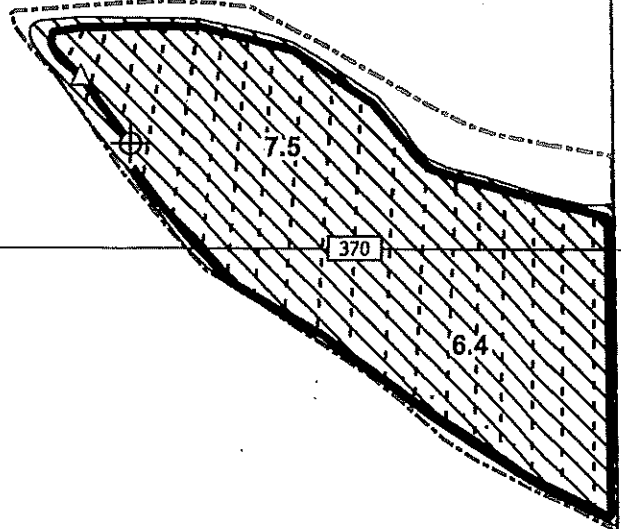

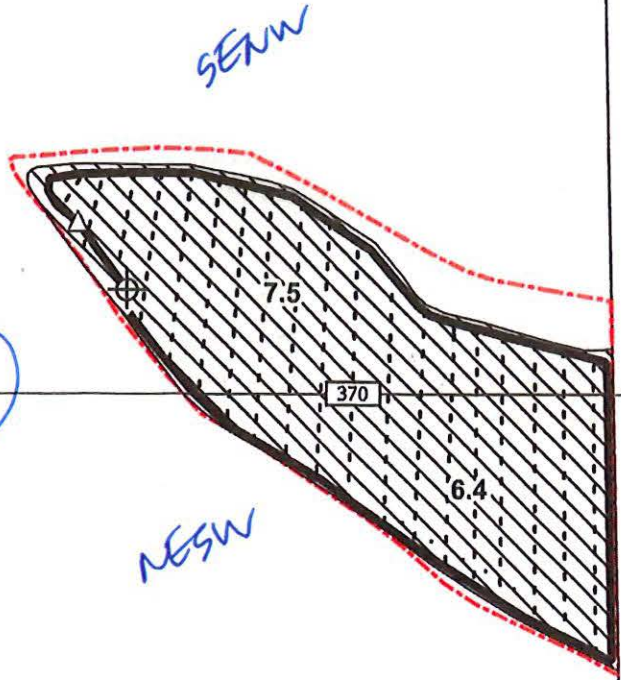

- 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Agreement is to expedite the processing of the Claim of Beneficial Use. (Application Number: G-11671)
2. Authority. ORS 536.055 authorizes the OWRD to enter into a voluntary agreement with any applicant, permittee or regulated entity...
3. Restrictions. Ryan Lieuallen and OWRD agree that this Agreement shall not be construed to restrict in any way the decisions and actions by OWRD...
4. Effective Date and Duration. Unless otherwise terminated by non-deposit of funds by the Applicant, this Agreement shall become effective on the date on which both parties have signed the Agreement...
5. Consideration. Ryan Lieuallen shall pay OWRD in advance for actual costs incurred by OWRD. Ryan Lieuallen agrees to pay the full amount of \$1590 to OWRD prior to commencement of any work...
6. Confidentiality. Ryan Lieuallen agrees that any information provided under this Agreement will be subject to the Oregon Public Records Law records.
7. Indemnity. Applicant shall defend, save, hold harmless, and indemnify and their officers, employees, and agents from and against all claims, su liabilities, costs and expenses of any nature resulting from or arising out of Applicant or its representatives, officers, employees, contractors, or a with respect to the expedited service. The Applicant acknowledges that the Oregon Water Resources Department cannot and does not guarantee a favorable review under the subject regulatory process.

8. **Termination.** Applicant may request to terminate this agreement only in writing at any time during the process. The Applicant agrees to pay for the work done by the Reimbursement Authority personnel up until the time of the written termination request. OWRD, upon receiving such written termination request from the Applicant, will refund any unspent balance after paying the Reimbursement Authority personnel for the work done.
9. **Funds Authorized and Available.** By its execution of this Agreement, Applicants certifies that sufficient funds are authorized and available to cover the expenditures contemplated by this Agreement.
10. **Duration of Estimate.** The Estimate of Time to complete the work is no later than one hundred and twenty days (120) days once this Agreement has been fully executed and payment of the estimated cost deposited. However, this estimate is contingent on the Applicant's expeditious resolution of any deficiency and may be affected by the Department's work load. This Estimate of Time may become null and void after thirty (30) days from the date the Applicant's Agreement is mailed. If the Applicant's Agreement is not received by the Department within thirty (30) days of mailing the Agreement, the Applicant may need to re-apply for a new estimate.
11. **Completion Date.** OWRD, by the execution of this Agreement does not guarantee the completion date indicated in this Agreement. Completion date is only an estimate and may be affected by the Department's workload, issues arising from the processing of the requested services and Applicant's timely response to requests for additional information.
12. **Captions.** The captions or headings in this Agreement are for the convenience only and in no way define limit or describe the scope or intent of any provision of this Agreement.
13. **Amendment and Merger.** The terms of this Agreement shall not be waived, altered, modified, supplemented or amended in any manner whatsoever, except by written instrument signed by both parties. Such waiver, consent, modification or change, if made, shall be effective only in the specific instance and for the specific purpose given. There are no understandings, agreements or representations, oral or written, not specified herein regarding this Agreement.

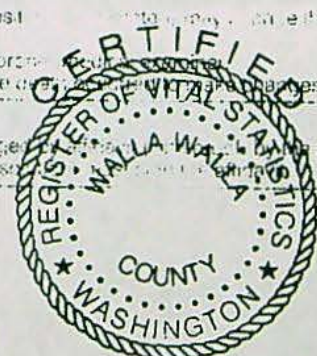

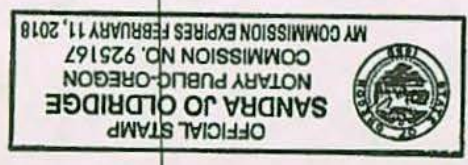

I pulled the file to see what information it contained regarding notification to the Department that the permit development had been completed. I was able to locate a "Form C" that the permit holders submitted in October of 1991. For your reference, I have attached copies of both the notice and the letter the Department sent confirming that the notice had been received.

As we discussed, due to the priority date of the permit, you have the option of waiting for the Department to survey the extent of the use or hiring a Certified Water Right Examiner:

537.799 Survey for issuance of water right certificate. Any person who has applied for or received a permit or a transfer to appropriate water under ORS 537.211, 537.625 or 540.530 on or before July 9, 1987, shall notify the Water Resources Department that the work has been completed and either:

- (1) Hire a water right examiner certified under ORS 537.798 to conduct a survey, the original to be submitted as required by the Water Resources Department, for issuance of a water right certificate; or

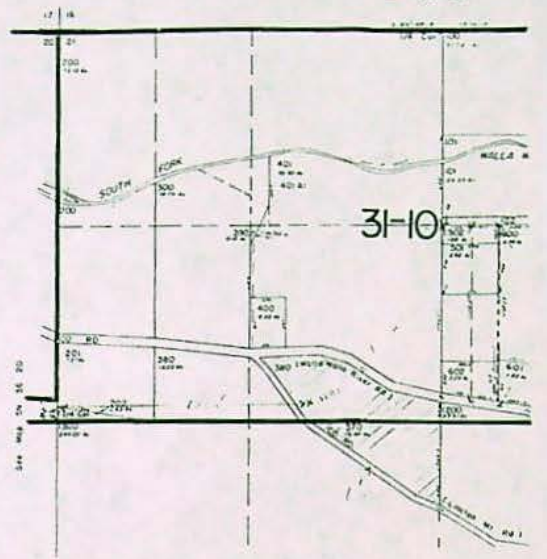

Your Application G-11671 describing the proposed use of 0.17 cubic foot of water per second from one well for the irrigation of 13.9 acres, together with the print of a portion of a map and a copy of the water well report, has been reviewed.

Before your application can be considered for approval, it will be necessary for you to make a certain admendment to the application, submit a map or maps meeting our requirements, and submit a legal description of the property upon which the water will be used.

The legal description is needed to verify the place of use of water and may be copied from your deed, title insurance policy, or sales contract.

We will also need a statement relative to the ownership of the properties involved in the development. If any portion of the proposed development will occur on property not wholly under your ownership, you will need to supply the names and mailing addresses of the legal owners of the property. This information may be supplied in the remarks section of the application or on a separate sheet.

The well needs to be located in the first part of Item 2 by a distance north or south and a distance east of west from a public land survey corner. Applications which are defective, conflict with existing rights or require additional information will be reviewed in detail and will be returned for completion or correction within 45 days.

If your Application is approved, the permit authorizing the project described in the Application would be subject to prior rights and require that the well be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The permit would also require that a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device be installed, if required by the Watermaster, and a log be kept recording the amount of ground water withdrawals. 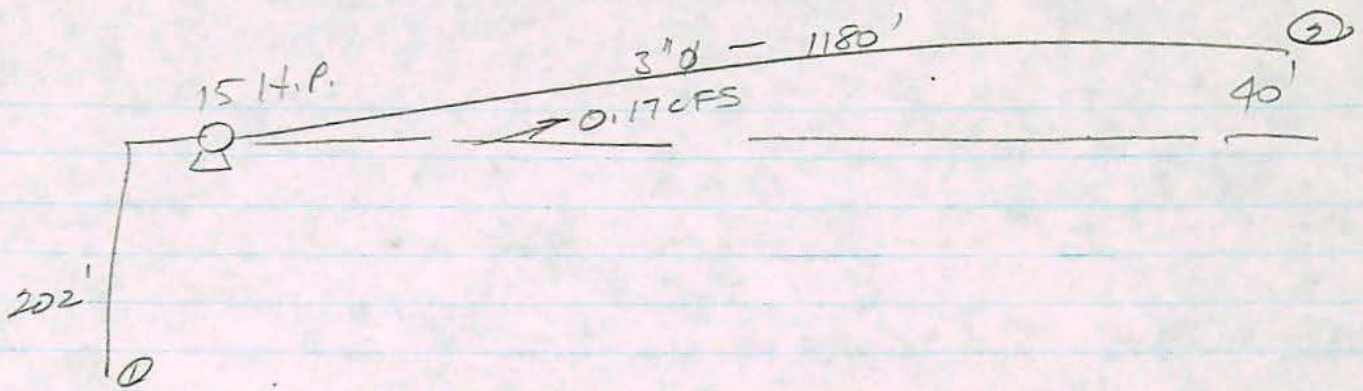

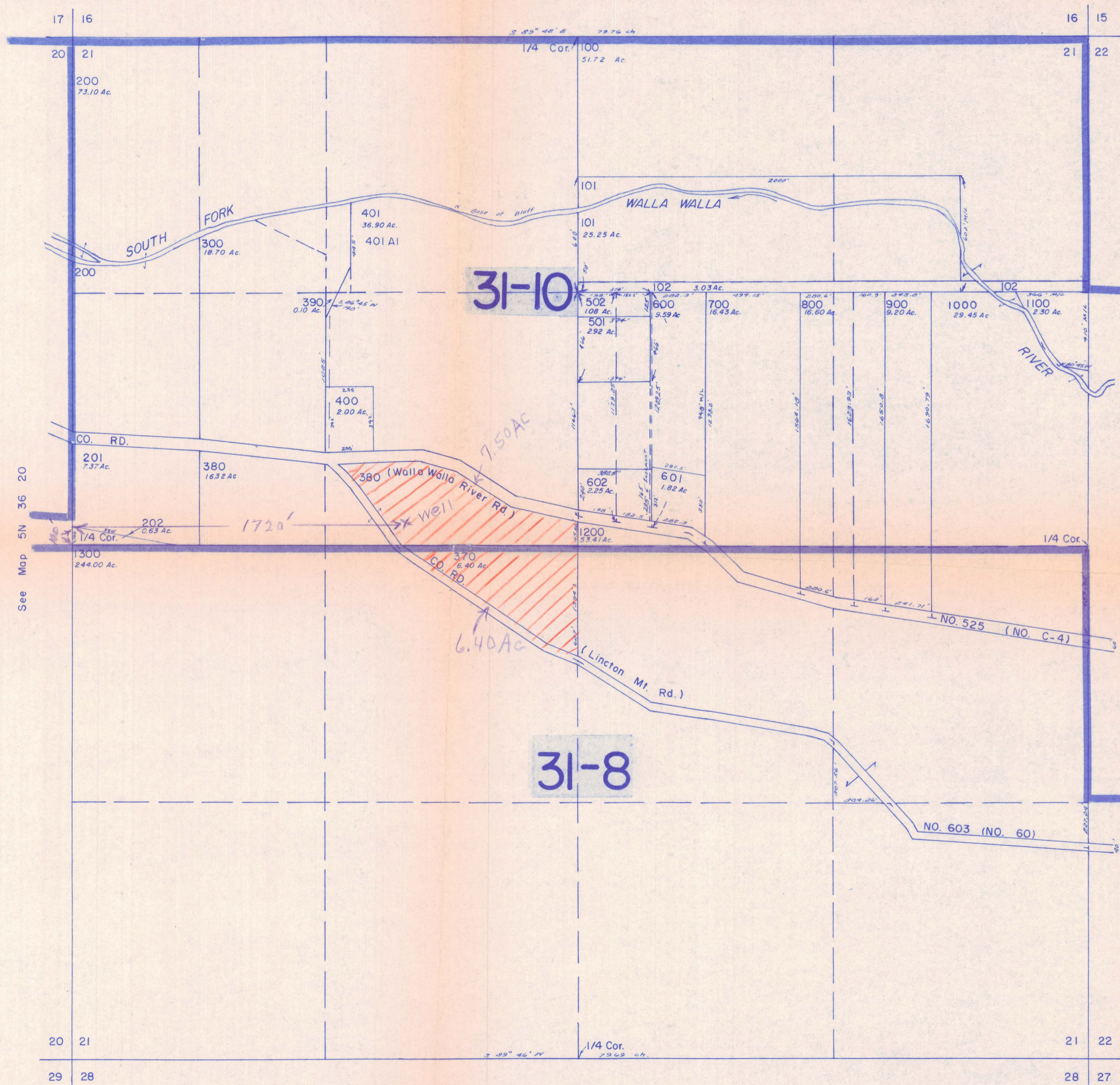
