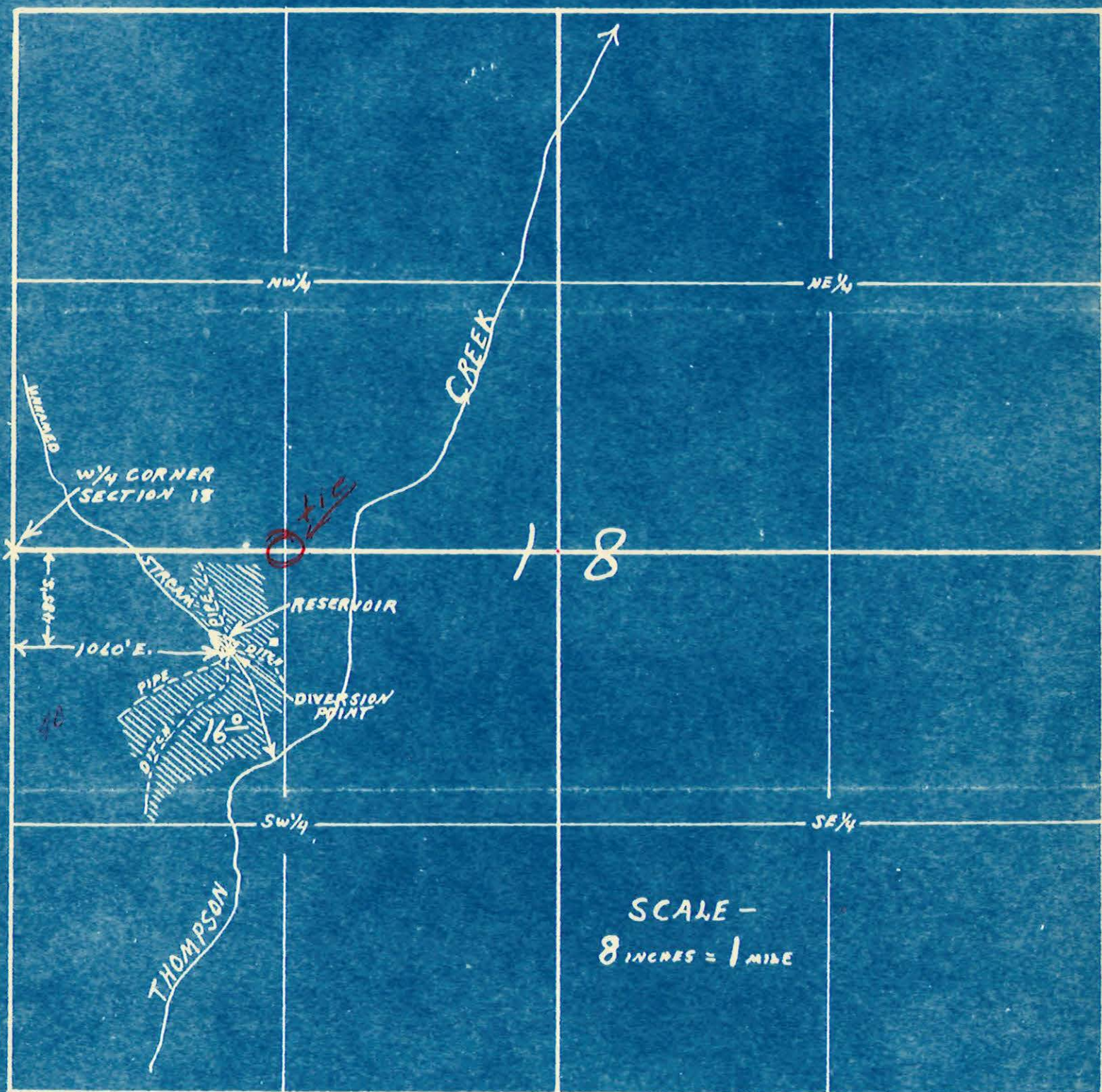

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROSIE GIBSON

of Rt. 1, Box 25, Applegate, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Appl. #R-27630, Permit #R-1430 a tributary of Big Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 2.8 acres

under Permit No. 21764 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon, that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 9, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 18, T. 39 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1430,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.8 acres Lot 3 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 18
T. 39 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

On December 30, 1960, we mailed you copies of drafts of the certificates in connection with the incomplete water rights represented by permits numbered R-11,30 and 21764, together with the instructions that the affidavits at the bottom of each page be signed and the copies be returned to this office accompanied by the certificate recording fees in the amount of \$2.

To date these forms have not been received nor has any correspondence regarding them. This is to notify you that unless we receive the signed draft forms and the certificate recording fees within thirty days from the date of this letter, we will be required to take steps toward the cancellation of these permits.

Dear Madam:

This will acknowledge receipt of your notice to the effect that complete application of water has been made under Permit No. 21764.

Pursuant to your report and in line with the general practice of this office, a survey will be made at a later date. After this survey, proof may be made and certificate issued covering the actual use of water as found by the engineer. In the case of irrigation, any lands described in the permit that have not been irrigated will be automatically eliminated from the water right.

In the meantime, the permit which you hold will be valid evidence of the water right in question so long as you continue to use the water.

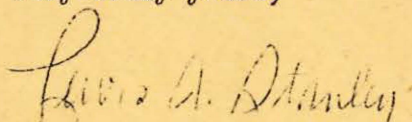
