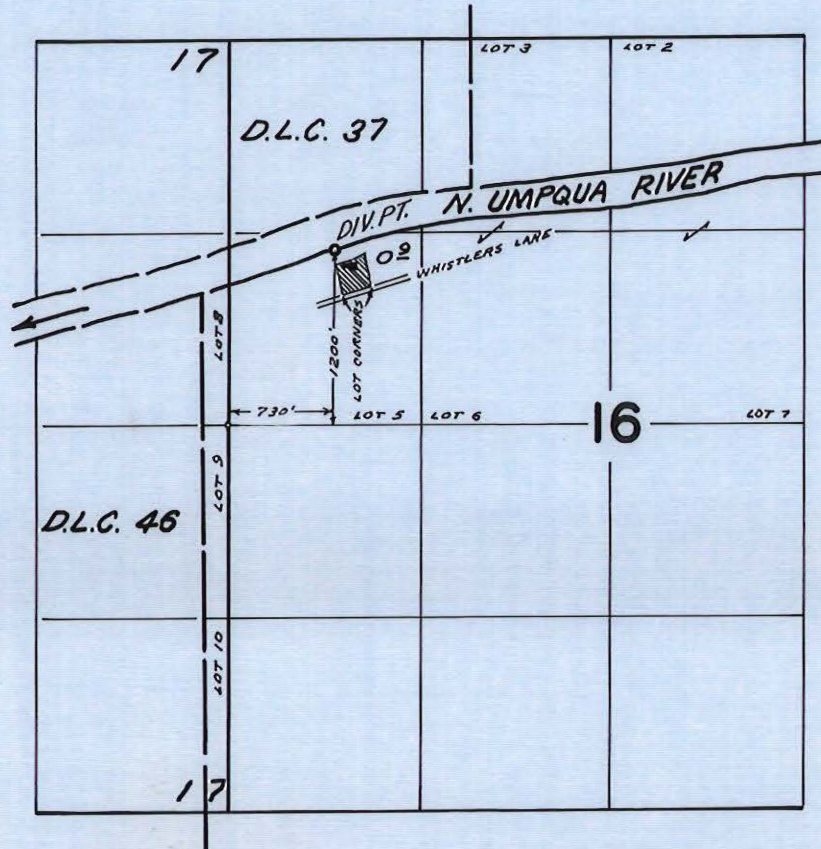

Proof of Appropriation of Water

ROBERT D. AND GLADYS M. WILSON

of **Box 80, Whistlers Lane, Roseburg**, State of **Oregon**,
has applied beneficially the waters of
North Umpqua River

a tributary of **Umpqua River** for the purpose of
irrigation of 0.9 acre

under Permit No. **32393** of the State Engineer, and that the use of said waters has been
completed under the terms of said permit; that the priority of the
right dates from **March 7, 1967**

that the amount of water for the purposes aforesaid, has been actually beneficially used in the
amount of
0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)**, Section 16, T. 26 S., R. 4 W.,
W. M. Diversion point located 1200 feet North and 730 feet East from W $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner,
Section 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated
during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is
as follows:

**0.9 acre Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 16
T. 26 S., R. 4 W., W. M.**

Land on which water is to be used is more explicitly described as being: **Lots
17 and 18 of Whistlers Homes, Flat B.**

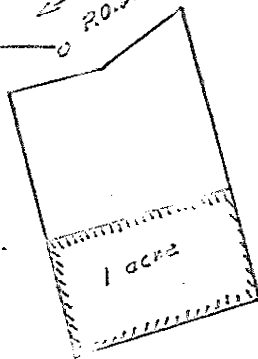

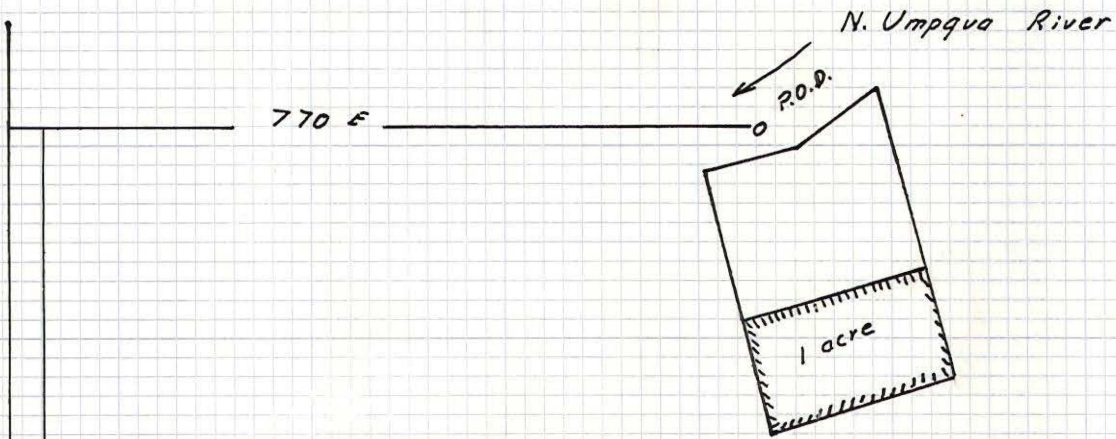
