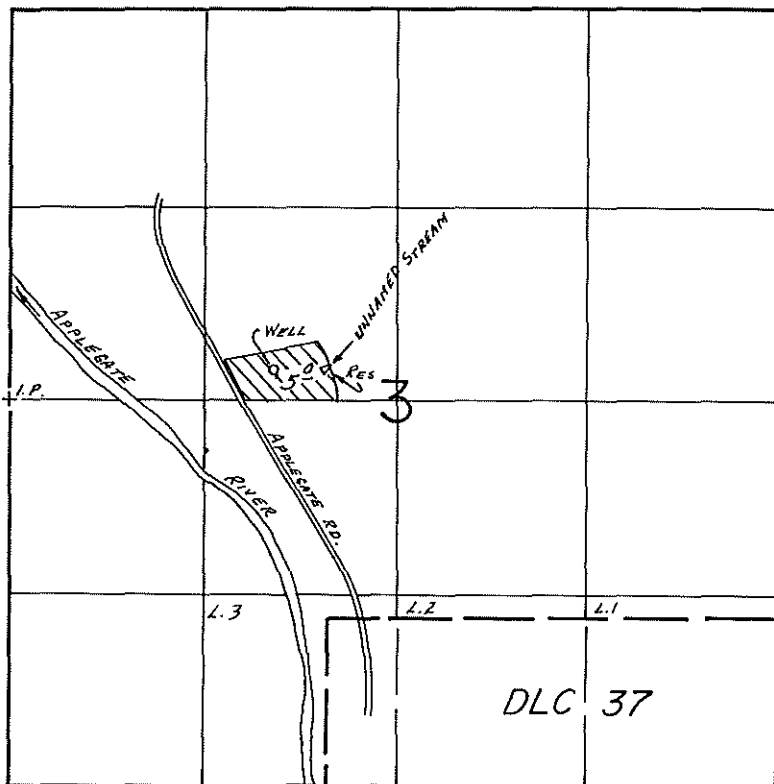

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.11206 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream and Richards Reservoir to be constructed under application No. R 55448, permit No. R6753

TR.B. APPLE GATE RIVER.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation of 5.0 ac.
