This form must be submitted to the Water Resources Department within one year of storage of water in the reservoir.

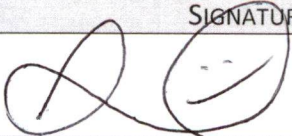

CwM-H2O, LLC is submitting the attached Claim of Beneficial Use for Transfers for Reservoirs Storing Less Than 9.2 Acre-feet on behalf of the permit holder, Mr. Benjamin McCune. The permit was for storage of up to 6.0 acre-feet for multipurpose use with a December 2021 completion date. This claim documents the developed extent of the reservoir, completed prior to December 2021, which stores about 1.25 acre-feet.
