I just wanted to let you know the status of this pump test since there was some confusion about the different files that this pump test was associated with. It looks like application G-14270, permit G-13123 was cancelled, but app G-15575, permit G-15278, app G-15730, permit G-15376 and app G-15959, permit G-15582 are all current. This pump test was done on a well that is correlated to all four of these files, which is why it was included in the COBU for the current files. The test itself is of poor quality, but I will talk to the hydrogeologist in charge of that area about it as soon as they are available. Let me know if you have any more questions.

Hull Lane Well is an artesian well. The well maintains 16psi while pumping. The water is pumped by a 75 hp electric motor with a shaft driven Cornell 5R-2 centrifugal pump through an 8" above ground pipe into an 10" buried steel mainline. There is a 10" mainline that runs North across Hull Lane running North along the east side of the house and barns approx. 300' then turns West and runs approximately 250' the turns North to the North line of the SW, SW of Sec. 20. This line has risers that run wheel lines to the East of the 10" main, and also runs several wheel lines to the West of the Mainline. There is one other buried 8" mainline that connects to the 10" mainline at the North line of Hull Lane and runs East along the north line of Hull Lane into the SE, SW of Sec 20, then North at the East line of the 4.5 acres being irrigated as tax lot 2900. The buried mainlines supply water to 2 wheel lines on the SE,SE of Sec 19 as well as one wheel line on the 4.5 acre parcel on the SE, SW of Sec. 20, TL 2900. There is very good coverage on this land from the well. In addition I counted 1840' of 3" hand line with 46 nozzles of 3/16" . I also counted 3560' of 4" hand line with 89 nozzles of 13/64 size. There is a spare 5" wheel line with 640' with 16 nozzles of 13/64 size, all are stored at the Northeast corner of the NE, NW of Sec. 29. The coverage of this property is exceptional.

This application (see also G-14270) proposes to use about 0.54 cfs from one well for primary irrigation of 43.6 acres. Based on the provided pump test, I have tentatively identified the well as UNIO 50833. The well is 1924 feet deep and produces water from a confined aquifer developed in basalt rocks of the Columbia River Basalt Group.

The well is about 3000 feet from the Grande Ronde River. The aquifer penetrated is not likely in hydraulic connection with the nearby reach of the river. There is no potential for substantial interference with surface water, based on the confined aquifer penetrated and the distance to it.

I recommend permit conditions 7B, 7E and 7J.

To monitor the effect of water use from the well(s) authorized under this permit, the Department requires the water user to make and report annual static water level measurements. The static water level shall be measured in the month of March. Reports shall be submitted to the Department within 30 days of measurement.

Measurements must be made according to the following schedule:

Before Use of Water Takes Place

Initial and Annual Measurements

The Department requires the permittee to submit an initial water level measurement in the month specified above once well construction is complete and annually thereafter until use of water begins; and

After Use of Water has Begun

Reference Water Level Determination

Following the first year of water use, the user shall submit one static water level measurement in the month specified above which will establish the reference level against which future annual measurements will be compared. The water user is not required to measure additional

water levels after the reference level has been determined unless required by the Director. The additional measurements may be required in a different month. If the measurement requirement is stopped, the Director may restart it at any time.

All measurements shall be made by a certified water rights examiner, registered professional geologist, registered professional engineer, licensed well constructor or pump installer licensed by the Construction Contractors Board and be submitted to the Department on forms provided by the Department. The Department requires the individual performing the measurement to:

- (A) Identify each well with its associated measurement; and
- (B) Measure and report water levels to the nearest tenth of a foot as depth-to-water below ground surface; and
- (C) Specify the method used to obtain each well measurement; and
- (D) Certify the accuracy of all measurements and calculations submitted to the Department.

The water user shall discontinue use of, or reduce the rate or volume of withdrawal from, the well(s) if annual water level measurements reveal any of the following events:

- (A) An average water level decline of three or more feet per year for five consecutive years; or
- (B) A water level decline of 15 or more feet in fewer than five consecutive years; or
- (C) A water level decline of 25 or more feet; or
- (D) Hydraulic interference leading to a decline of 25 or more feet in any neighboring well with senior priority.

The period of non or restricted use shall continue until the annual water level rises above the decline level which triggered the action or until the Department determines, based on the permittee's and/or the Department's data and analysis, that no action is necessary because the aquifer in question can sustain the observed declines without adversely impacting the resource or senior water rights. The water user shall in no instance allow excessive decline, as defined in Commission rules, to occur within the aquifer as a result of use under this permit. If more than one well is involved, the water user may submit an alternative measurement and reporting plan for review and approval by the Department.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed on this permit, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interferences.

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

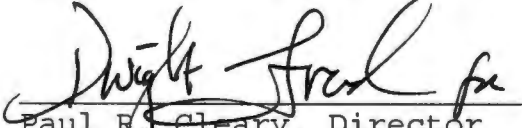

Proposed Final Order

Prior to issuance of a permit, permit recording fees in the amount of \$175.00 must be submitted to the Department. In order to expedite the processing of the Final Order and permit, you may wish to submit \$175.00 prior to the protest deadline of October 18, 2002. Please include your application number on your check made out to the Oregon Water Resources Department. If this fee is not paid prior to October 18, 2002, issuance of your permit will be delayed until all fees are paid.

Summary of Recommendation: The Department recommends that the attached draft permit be issued with conditions.

Application History

On AUGUST 6, 2001, ROSS A BINGAMAN submitted an application to the Department for the following water use permit:

- Amount of Water: 0.54 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS)
- Use of Water: IRRIGATION OF 43.6 ACRES
- Source of Water: A WELL IN GRANDE RONDE RIVER BASIN
- Area of Proposed Use: UNION County within SECTION 19 and SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST, W.M.

On March 8, 2002, the Department mailed the applicant notice of its Initial Review, determining that "The use of 0.54 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND from A WELL IN GRANDE RONDE RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 43.6 ACRES is allowable from April 1 through October 1 of each year." The applicant did not notify the Department to stop processing the application within 14 days of that date.

On March 26, 2002, the Department gave public notice of the application in its weekly notice. The public notice included a request for comments,

and information for interested persons about both obtaining future notices and a copy of the proposed final order.

No written comments were received within 30 days.

In reviewing applications, the Department may consider any relevant sources of information, including the following:

- comments by or consultation with another state agency
- any applicable basin program
- any applicable comprehensive plan or zoning ordinance
- the amount of water available
- the rate and duty for the proposed use
- pending senior applications and existing water rights of record
- designations of any critical groundwater areas
- the Scenic Waterway requirements of ORS 390.835
- applicable statutes, administrative rules, and case law
- any general basin-wide standard for flow rate and duty of water allowed
- the need for a flow rate and duty higher than the general standard
- any comments received

Findings of Fact

The Grande Ronde Basin Program allows IRRIGATION.

A WELL IN GRANDE RONDE RIVER BASIN is above the Grande Ronde River State Scenic Waterway.

The Groundwater Section finds, per OAR 390.835(9), there is not a preponderance of evidence that the proposed use of groundwater will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife.

The Department determined, based upon OAR 690-09, that the proposed groundwater use will, if properly conditioned, adequately protect the surface water from interference.

An assessment of groundwater availability has been completed by the Department's Groundwater/Hydrology section. A copy of this assessment is in the file. The proposed use of groundwater will, if properly conditioned, avoid injury to existing rights and the resource.

The Department finds that the amount of water requested, 0.54 CFS, is an acceptable amount.

The proposed well is not within a designated critical ground water area.

Conclusions of Law

Under the provisions of ORS 537.153, the Department must presume that a proposed use will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest if the proposed use is allowed in the applicable basin program established pursuant to ORS 536.300 and 536.340 or given a preference under ORS 536.310(12) (i.e. the use of water is human consumption or livestock), if water is available, if the proposed use will not injure other water rights and if the proposed use complies with rules of the Water Resources Commission.

The proposed use requested in this application is allowed in the Grande Ronde Basin Plan, or a preference for this use is granted under the provisions of ORS 536.310(12).

Water is available for the proposed use.

The proposed use will not injure other water rights.

The proposed use complies with other rules of the Water Resources Commission not otherwise described above.

The proposed use complies with the State Agency Agreement for land use.

No proposed flow rate and duty of water higher than the general basin-wide standard is needed.

For these reasons, the required presumption has been established.

Under the provisions of ORS 537.621, once the presumption has been established, it may be overcome by a preponderance of evidence that either:

- (a) One or more of the criteria for establishing the presumption are not satisfied; or
- (b) The proposed use would not ensure the preservation of the public welfare, safety and health as demonstrated in comments, in a protest . . . or in a finding of the department that shows:
 - (A) The specific aspect of the public welfare, safety and health under ORS 537.525 that would be impaired or detrimentally affected; and
 - (B) Specifically how the identified aspect of the public welfare, safety and health under ORS 537.525 would be impaired or be adversely affected.

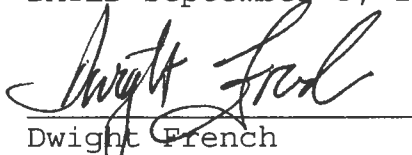
In this application, all criteria for establishing the presumption have been satisfied, as noted above. The presumption has not been overcome by a preponderance of evidence that the proposed use would impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

The Department therefore concludes that water is available in the amount necessary for the proposed use; the proposed use will not result in injury to existing water rights; and the proposed use would ensure the preservation of the public welfare, safety and health as described in ORS 537.525.

Recommendation

The Department recommends that the attached draft permit be issued with conditions.

Protest Rights and Standing

Under the provisions of 537.621(7), you have the right to protest this proposed final order. Your protest must be in writing, and must include the following:

- Your name, address, and telephone number;
- A description of your interest in the proposed final order, and, if you claim to represent the public interest, a precise statement of the public interest represented;
- A detailed description of how the action proposed in this proposed final order would impair or be detrimental to your interest;
- A detailed description of how the proposed final order is in error or deficient, and how to correct the alleged error or deficiency;
- Any citation of legal authority to support your protest, if known; and
- If you are not the applicant, the \$200 protest fee required by ORS 536.050 and proof of service of the protest upon the applicant.

- If you are the applicant, a statement of whether or not you are requesting a contested case hearing. If you do not request a hearing, the Department will presume that you do not wish to contest the findings of the proposed final order.
- If you do not protest this Proposed Final Order and if no substantive changes are made in the final order, you will not have an opportunity for judicial review, protest or appeal of the final order when it is issued.

Requests for Standing

Under the provisions of 537.621(6), persons other than the applicant who support a proposed final order may request standing for purposes of participating in any contested case proceeding on the proposed final order or for judicial review of a final order. A request for standing shall be in writing, include a statement that the requester supports the proposed final order, and a statement of how the requester would be harmed if the proposed final order is modified. The fee required at the time of submitting this request is \$50.00. If a hearing is scheduled, an additional fee of \$150.00 must be submitted along with a request for intervention. Forms to request standing are available from the Department.

Your protest or request for standing must be received in the Water Resources Department no later than **October 18, 2002**.

After the protest period has ended, the Director will either issue a final order or schedule a contested case hearing. The contested case hearing will be scheduled only if a protest has been submitted and if

- upon review of the issues, the director finds that there are significant disputes related to the proposed use of water, or
- the applicant requests a contested case hearing within 30 days after the close of the protest period.

The wells shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2006. If the water is not completely applied before this date, and the permittee wishes to continue development under the permit,

the permittee must submit an application for extension of time, which may be approved based upon the merit of the application.

Within one year after complete application of water to the proposed use, the permittee shall submit a claim of beneficial use, which includes a map and report, prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner (CWRE).

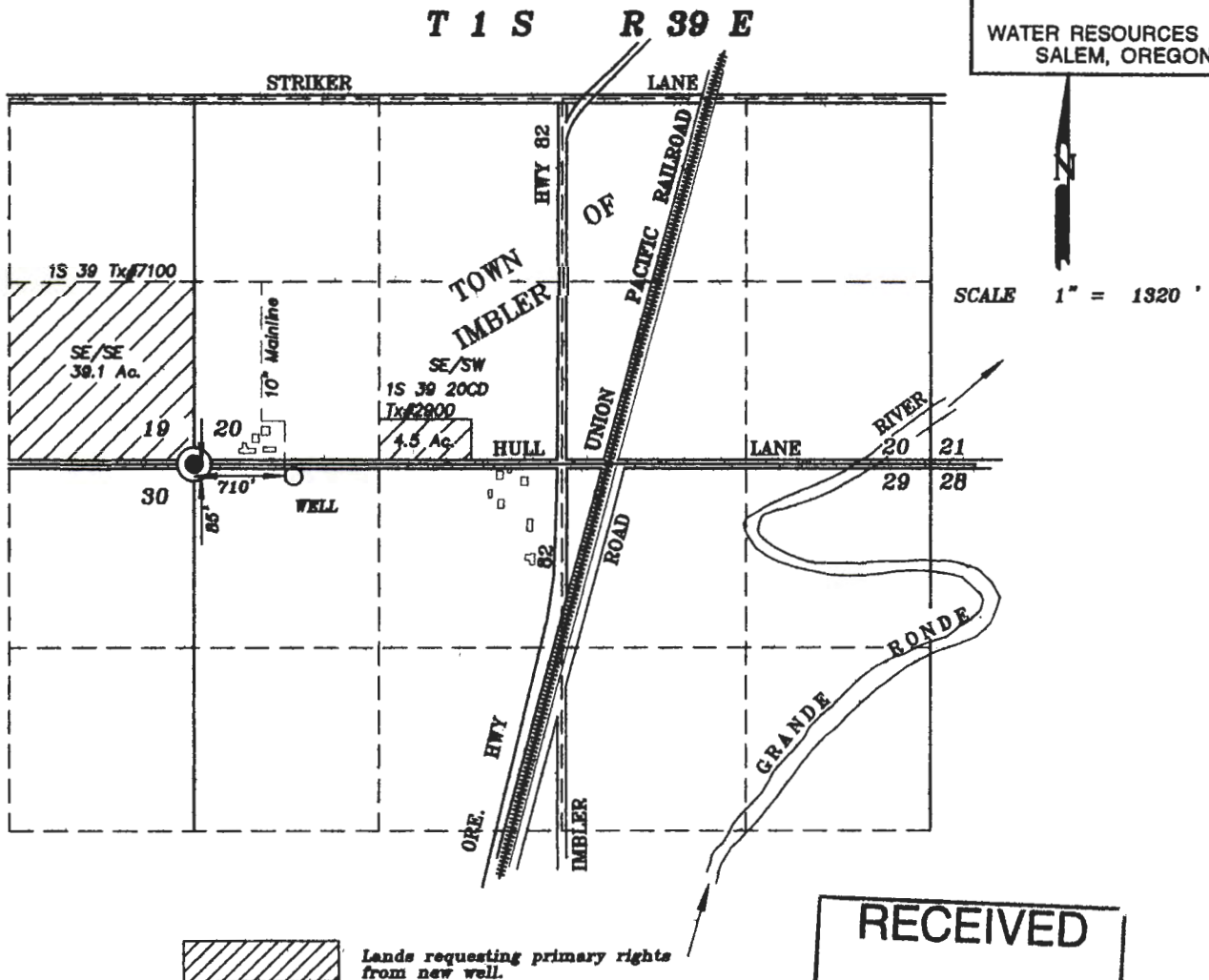

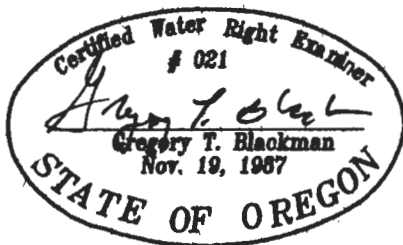

This application (see also G-14270) proposes to use about 0.54 cfs from one well for primary irrigation of 43.6 acres. Based on the provided pump test, I have tentatively identified the well as UNIO 50833. The well is 1924 feet deep and produces water from a confined aquifer developed in basalt rocks of the Columbia River Basalt Group.

The well is about 3000 feet from the Grande Ronde River. The aquifer penetrated is not likely in hydraulic connection with the nearby reach of the river. There is no potential for substantial interference with surface water, based on the confined aquifer penetrated and the distance to it.

I recommend permit conditions 7B, 7E and 7J.

The permit for the earlier file was issued on April 4, 1997, and included language requiring well construction to begin within one year of issuance. Therefore, it appears that the permittee failed to begin construction in a timely manner.

(c) Structures or works for utilization of the waters in accordance with the aforementioned classifications are also declared to be prejudicial to the public interest unless planned, constructed, and operated in conformity with the applicable provisions of ORS 536.310 and any such structures or works are further declared to be prejudicial to the public interest which do not give proper cognizance to the multiple-purpose concept.

(2) Water Quality: Rights to use of water for industrial or mining purposes granted by any state agency shall be issued only on the condition that any effluents or return flows from such uses shall not interfere with other beneficial uses.

(3) Power Development: Water rights acquired for hydroelectric power purposes utilizing the waters of the Middle Grande Ronde Basin shall be subordinate in priority to future beneficial uses of water except for hydroelectric power.

I have reviewed the above referenced file, Permit, Claim of Beneficial Use and Site Report (Report) and records of our office to determine if you have complied with the terms and conditions of the Permit.

Notwithstanding other concerns regarding the Report, Permit No. G-13123 contains the condition as follows:

"Actual construction of the well shall begin within one year from permit issuance."

The permit was issued on April 16, 1997. This would mean the actual construction of the well was to occur on or before April 16, 1998. In examining our records, actual construction of the well, from the well log states the well was started on May 1, 2000 and completed on January 6, 2001. If our records are correct, you have failed to begin actual construction of the well within the time limits allowed and your permit is not valid.

ORS 537.260 provides that: "Whenever the time within which any appropriation under a permit should have been perfected has expired and the owner of the permit fails or refuses within three months thereafter to submit to the Water Resources Director proof of completion of the appropriation as required by ORS 537.230 and 537.250, the Water Resources Director may, after 60 days notice by registered mail, order the cancellation of the permit."

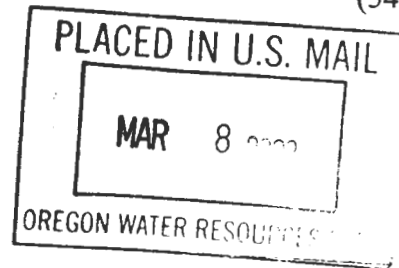

THIS IS NOT A PERMIT AND IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE AT THE NEXT PHASE OF PROCESSING.

This letter is to inform you of the favorable preliminary analysis of your water use permit application and to describe your options. In determining whether a water use permit application may be approved, the Department must consider the factors listed below, all of which must be favorable to the proposed use if it is to be allowed. Based on the information you have supplied, the Water Resources Department has made the following preliminary determinations:

Initial Review Determinations:

1. The proposed use is not prohibited by law or rule.
2. The use of water from A WELL IN GRANDE RONDE RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 43.6 ACRES is **allowable** under OAR 690-508-020(1), the Grande Ronde Basin Program.
3. The Department has determined, based upon OAR 690-09, that the proposed groundwater use will, if properly conditioned, adequately protect the surface water from interference.
4. The Department has also determined, based upon available data, that the use of groundwater in the amount of 0.54 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND for IRRIGATION OF 43.6 ACRES is **available**, and if properly conditioned, will not injure existing rights or the groundwater resource.
5. The standard irrigation season allowed for ground water sources, without the potential of surface water interference is from March 1 through October 31 of each year. **The**

applicant, however, requested an irrigation season from April 1 through October 1 of each year.

Summary of Initial Determinations

The use of 0.54 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND from A WELL IN GRANDE RONDE RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 43.6 ACRES is allowable from April 1 through October 1 of each year.

Because of these favorable determinations, the Department can now move your application to the next phase of the water rights application review process. This phase is where public interest factors will be evaluated.

Please reference the application number when sending any correspondence regarding the conclusions of this initial review. Comments received within the comment period will be evaluated at the next phase of the process.

To Proceed With Your Application:

If you choose to proceed with your application, you do not have to notify the Department. Your application will automatically be placed on the Department's Public Notice to allow others the opportunity to comment. After the comment period the Department will complete a public interest review and issue a proposed final order.

Withdrawal Refunds:

If you choose not to proceed, you may withdraw your application and receive a refund (minus a \$50 processing charge per application.) To accomplish this you must notify the Department in writing by **Friday, March 22, 2002**. For your convenience you may use the enclosed "STOP PROCESSING" form.

NOTE: An earlier permit (G-13123) issued for the well proposed under this application had a permit condition that the well construction shall begin within one year of issuance. The permit was issued April 4, 1997; however it appears the well was not constructed until May 2000. Permit G-13123 may be at risk for cancellation if the well was not constructed in a timely manner. This information *does not* affect application G-15575. If you have any questions about Permit G-13123, please contact Jerry Sauter in the Water Rights Division at (503)378-8455 extension 274.

If A Permit Is Issued It Will Likely Include The Following Conditions:

1. Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:
 - A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.
 - B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
2. To monitor the effect of water use from the well(s) authorized under this permit, the Department requires the water user to make and report annual static water level measurements. The static water level shall be measured in the month of March. Reports shall be submitted to the Department within 30 days of measurement.

Measurements must be made according to the following schedule:

Before Use of Water Takes Place

Initial and Annual Measurements

The Department requires the permittee to submit an initial water level measurement in the month specified above once well construction is complete and annually thereafter until use of water begins; and

After Use of Water has Begun

Reference Water Level Determination

Following the first year of water use, the user shall submit one static water level measurement in the month specified above which will establish the reference level against which future annual measurements will be compared. The water user is not required to measure additional water levels after the reference level has been determined unless required by the Director. The additional measurements may be required in a different month. If the measurement requirement is stopped, the Director may restart it at any time.

All measurements shall be made by a certified water rights examiner, registered professional geologist, registered professional engineer, licensed well constructor or pump installer licensed by the Construction Contractors Board and be submitted to the Department on forms provided by the Department. The Department requires the individual performing the measurement to:

- (A) Identify each well with its associated measurement; and
- (B) Measure and report water levels to the nearest tenth of a foot as depth-to-water

- below ground surface; and
- (C) Specify the method used to obtain each well measurement; and
- (D) Certify the accuracy of all measurements and calculations submitted to the Department.

The water user shall discontinue use of, or reduce the rate or volume of withdrawal from, the well(s) if annual water level measurements reveal any of the following events:

- (A) An average water level decline of three or more feet per year for five consecutive years; or
- (B) A water level decline of 15 or more feet in fewer than five consecutive years; or
- (C) A water level decline of 25 or more feet; or
- (D) Hydraulic interference leading to a decline of 25 or more feet in any neighboring well with senior priority.

The period of non or restricted use shall continue until the annual water level rises above the decline level which triggered the action or until the Department determines, based on the permittee's and/or the Department's data and analysis, that no action is necessary because the aquifer in question can sustain the observed declines without adversely impacting the resource or senior water rights. The water user shall in no instance allow excessive decline, as defined in Commission rules, to occur within the aquifer as a result of use under this permit. If more than one well is involved, the water user may submit an alternative measurement and reporting plan for review and approval by the Department.

3. Use of water under authority of this permit may be regulated if analysis of data available after the permit is issued discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of the right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.
4. The priority date for this application is AUGUST 6, 2001.

The water source identified in your application is in an area in which an Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plan is being developed. These plans are developed by the Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA) with the cooperation of local landowners and other interested stakeholders. These plans help make sure that current and new appropriations of water are done in a way that does not adversely harm the environment.
